line. Mr. Munger has been trying to get Mr. Knowles out there  
since he has been under. Poor Mr. Knowles has been  
sick several times since I left so has been unable to go  
that. That would be expected to get off. Today when she  
has so glad to hear about Virginia's success in that. I wish  
I could be himself. Poor old Willie, he is going to get for me. It  
was a long and a very long time. But it is like  
his ungrateful ways to all. Yours etc. etc.
