Dear Cousin Fannie:
Your letter of June 2^d was rec'd
today and I regret to hear
of Budd's embarrassment. It
would be a pity for the place
to be sacrificed, and I hope
he will find some one who will
be able to lend him the money
to repay Miss Shelton. Even if
he should have to get the
amount from the B.O.B. Acct^{ts}
it would be better than to lose
it. I wish I were in a
position to aid you in this
difficulty, but like many other
people in these hard times
cash is very scarce with me. I
am hard poor, and find it
the most difficult thing in the
world to realize in cash or any
thing. If I could spare the
money, I would certainly help

 Budd's friend whom he went to
 see should be unable to help him,
 I am sure the B. & O. A. can
 do so & the money would then
 have to be repaid monthly at
 about \$12⁰⁰ or the \$100⁰⁰. He would
 still have the right to repay the
 loan in full at any time, if
 he should desire.

Dixie is sick in bed but desires
 me to express her sympathy, also,
 along with mine, and to send
 her love. Don't give up the
 ship; it is a long time till the
 29th of June, and I hope &
 believe Budd's energy & resourceful
 ability will devise some way ^{out} of the
 difficulty.
