First  
The Party of the first part Rents to  
the Parties of the second part for term  
Eighteen hundred and eighty nine, this  
Place formerly known as Cassin's quarter  
embracing the North west quarter of section  
sixteen Township three range one west  
and some fifteen or twenty acres of section  
fifteen section thirty adjoining said section  
fifteen. To wit. In all say the hundred and  
eighty acres One hundred and forty  
of which is supposed to be cleared  
for the sum of two hundred dollars for  
which the Parties of the second part have  
executed their note to the Party of the first  
part bearing date with this instrument  
and payable on or before the first day of  
November next

Second  
The Party of the first part is not to pay  
for any repairs which may be necessary  
for the comfort & protection of said lands  
in making a crop thereon

Third  
The Parties of the second part are to  
cut all cut which timber as the Party  
of the first part may designate and to  
leave as much timber as shall be necessary  
themselves except for permanent improve-  
ments that may be necessary for their own  
comfort & protection of the crop that  
may be raised upon said premises and  
to suffer no other person or persons to use  
any timber for any purpose what so ever  
belonging to or adjoining said land owned  
by said Party of the first part and to  
take good and special care of the said  
premises generally Forth



McGaha of the second part have this day  
executed to and in favour of the said C.P. Cabaniss  
of the first part their note bearing date of same  
as this article of agreement and payable  
on the 15th day of 1860, That the said  
Hughes and McGaha are to use  
all of the fence rails now on the said  
described lands in repairing the out-  
side fence, on the West and North  
sides of said cleared land, commencing  
at the South west corner of the cleared land  
closing up the openings in the hedge now  
on the West side of said land to the North  
West corner of said land and right up and repair  
the fence on the North side of said  
land from the North West corner of same to  
Perce's or Davison's land - & so far  
in that direction as there may be rails  
to do so. and if not rails enough to  
make up said line of fence to the said  
Davison's land, the said C.P. Cabaniss  
of the first part is to have the balance  
of the fence on the North side of said  
cleared land made in time to protect  
the crop, say to said Davison's land  
The said Hughes and McGaha  
are to use none of the second part are not  
to settle but one family and a sufficient  
number of labourers on said land to culti-  
vate the same, and are not to use themselves  
or suffer any other person to use the  
timber on said lands except for firewood  
and permanent improvements that may  
be necessary and not to cut down cedar or  
Rail timber for firewood to use due and  
proper diligence to keep off of the lands  
belonging to the said C.P. Cabaniss of the first  
part all intruders and to take good care  
of every thing belonging thereto and  
not to enclose any portion of said land  
except by consent of the said C.P. Cabaniss
