This Indenture, made and entered into, this the
fifteenth day of March 1875 between C. P. Cabaniss
of the County of Madison and State of Alabama
of the first part, and Washington Reaves of said
County and State of the second part -
Witnesseth, That in consideration of
advances made and to be made in actual
necessary clothing, Bacon, Corn, and one
certain Sorrel Mule, with white nose about eight
years old (bot of J. S. Powell) by the said Cabaniss
to the said Reaves, during the current year
1875, at the request of the said Reaves in
Amount not to exceed four hundred
dollars, for the purpose of enabling
the said Reaves and his family, and his
hired help to cultivate about forty acres
in Cotton about thirty acres in corn and
about five acres in Oats & Mullet in all
say seventy five acres of land rented
of said Cabaniss, Successfull, and to gather
early and house secure the same,
The said Reaves hereby obligates himself
to pay, or cause to be paid to the said Cabaniss,
the said four hundred dollars or all such
advances as he the said Cabaniss may make
to the said Reaves during said year, On
or before the first day of January next
1876, and to keep said mule in good condition
and not over work her, or use her except for
farm purposes. And now being willing
and desirous to secure the said Cabaniss

advances, as he the said Cabaniss may make
his family, & the said Washington Reaves
hereby sell bargain and convey to the said
Cabaniss One dark brown Mule, two Sorrel
Mules, one two horse wagon team, Plow and
plow gear, all of which are owned by me
and the entire crop of Cotton, Corn, Godder,
Oats, & Millet to be raised on the said
Seventy five Acres of land, to hold
and Control until all such advances
are paid, Now if the said Reaves or
his agent pays or causes to be paid, all
advances made to him by the said
Cabaniss On or before the first day of
January next 1861, then this contract
is to be void, Other Wises to remain in
full force and effect.

Now the Condition of the above obligation
is, that if the said Reaves or his agent
fails to pay said advances, or indebted-
ness when due, to the said Cabaniss or
his agent, then the said Cabaniss or his
agent he the right and power to take
in to his possession all said property
and crop of Cotton, Corn, Godder, Oats,
& Millet, and after giving ten days
public notice in writing by posting same
in three public places in said County shall
proceed to sell on the premises on which
said crops to be raised or made to which
said Reaves lives at public outcry to the highest
bidder or by private sale at the option
of said Reaves or his agent all of said
property and crop of Cotton, Corn, Godder,
Oats, and Millet or as much thereof as
will pay in full all of said advances and
indebtedness that may be due said Cabaniss
and cost of said sale if made at public
outcry or otherwise the surplus of any to
be turned over to the said Reaves or his agent
