That Where as the said C. P. Cabaniss, has this day
and date above written Rented to the said Alex
Carmichael his tract of Land known as the
Eason quarter situated about five miles North
West of Huntsville Ala and containing two hundred
and eighty acres more or less, about one
hundred and twenty or thirty acres of which
is improved and in condition to cultivate for
the current year 1875 for the sum of
Three hundred Dollars to be to be paid
out of the proceeds of the first sale, made
of the Cotton and Corn to be raised on said
land the current year and to be paid on
or before the first day of January 1876
The said Carmichael agrees to sow and plant
and cultivate well a sufficient portion of
said land in Cotton and corn to insure
the payment of above mentioned sum of
money and not to remove any portion of
said Cotton or corn from the premises without

However there shall be sufficient cotton and corn raised on said land and premises to pay said rent. The said Carmichael further agrees not to abuse said premises nor suffer it done by any tenants he may put upon it or any person else, to cut no young hickory, or cedar for any other purpose than repairs & permanent improvements of said place and to use no lumber suitable for rails or boards except to repair any fencing that may be necessary on the premises and to use as far as practicable down and dead timber for fire wood for himself and tenants and no timber to be carried off of the ~~place~~ premises. In case of scarcity of water from the well at the house for said Carmichael and his tenants, and their stock the said Cabaniss agrees to have the stock well cleaned out and to furnish what nails may be required to keep up the fencing houses &c and to aid as much as practicable in the general protection of said place.
