I regret very much ~~to~~
to learn that you are compelled to give a lease
or deed of trust upon my property. You know
all that I am worth in your hands - & all of
money loaned you will therefore not fail to
put my claims in & be sure that they are
covered - I send them by Septimus - also I
send some claims which I hold against
you as agent for sister Martha & children
It is needless to suggest to you the situation
of her & children - you know it & under
the circumstances they should be protected
for this deed I know is to secure you
security - ~~not~~ recollect that I am bound
for every cent you owe them & if
you fail to secure them I as your security
shall have it to pay - by neglecting to
take security of you for mine of their
negro bonds ~~as~~ as my respects - because
your security my self therefore because
I put them in - I had not time to make up
the interest - the date can be mentioned in
and - you are owing Patton Donegan the
note for borrowed money dated 27 July 62
due that date for 350⁰⁰ - you owe them a note
of 155⁰⁰ dated & due 4 July 1863 assumed for

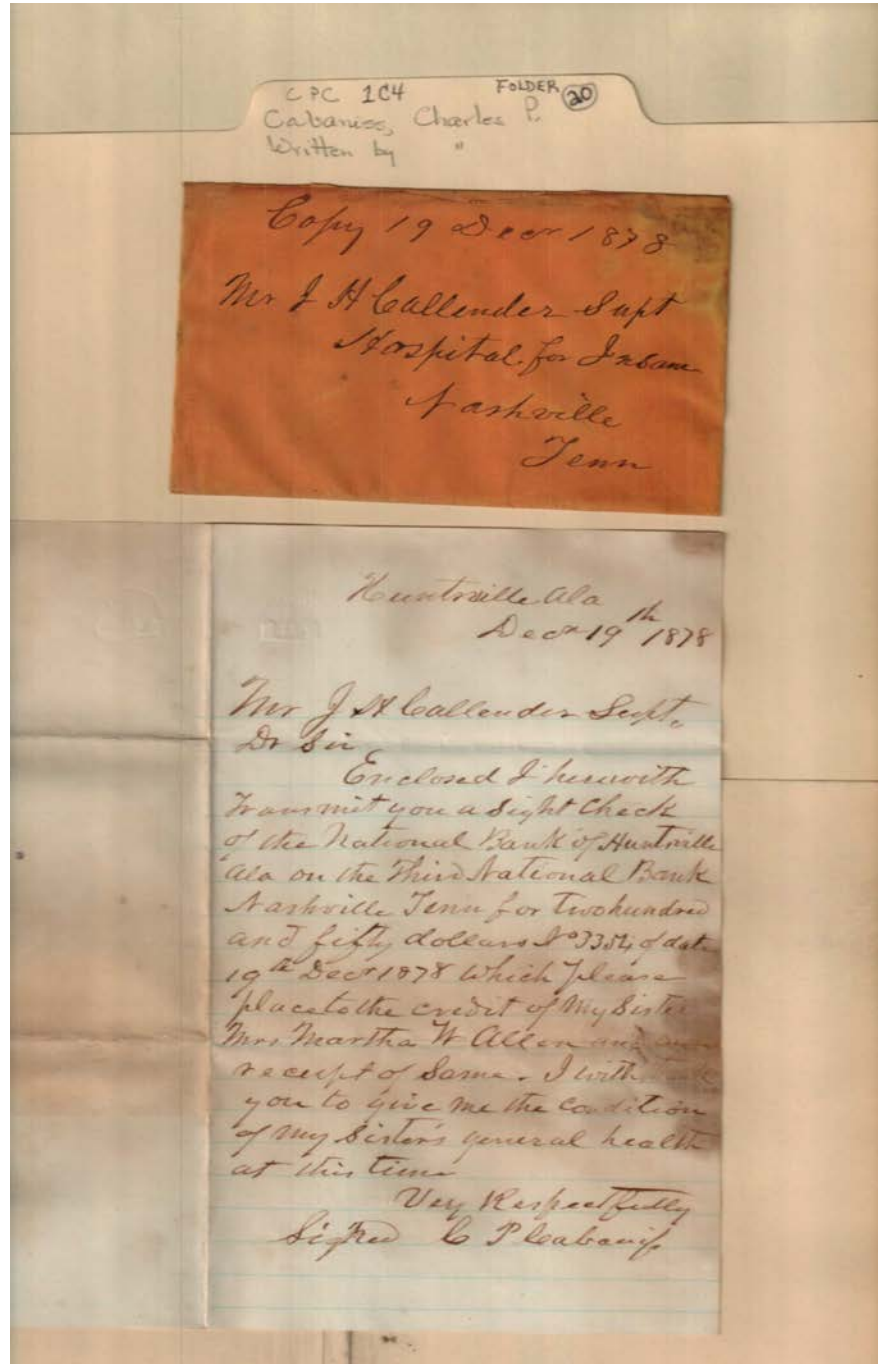

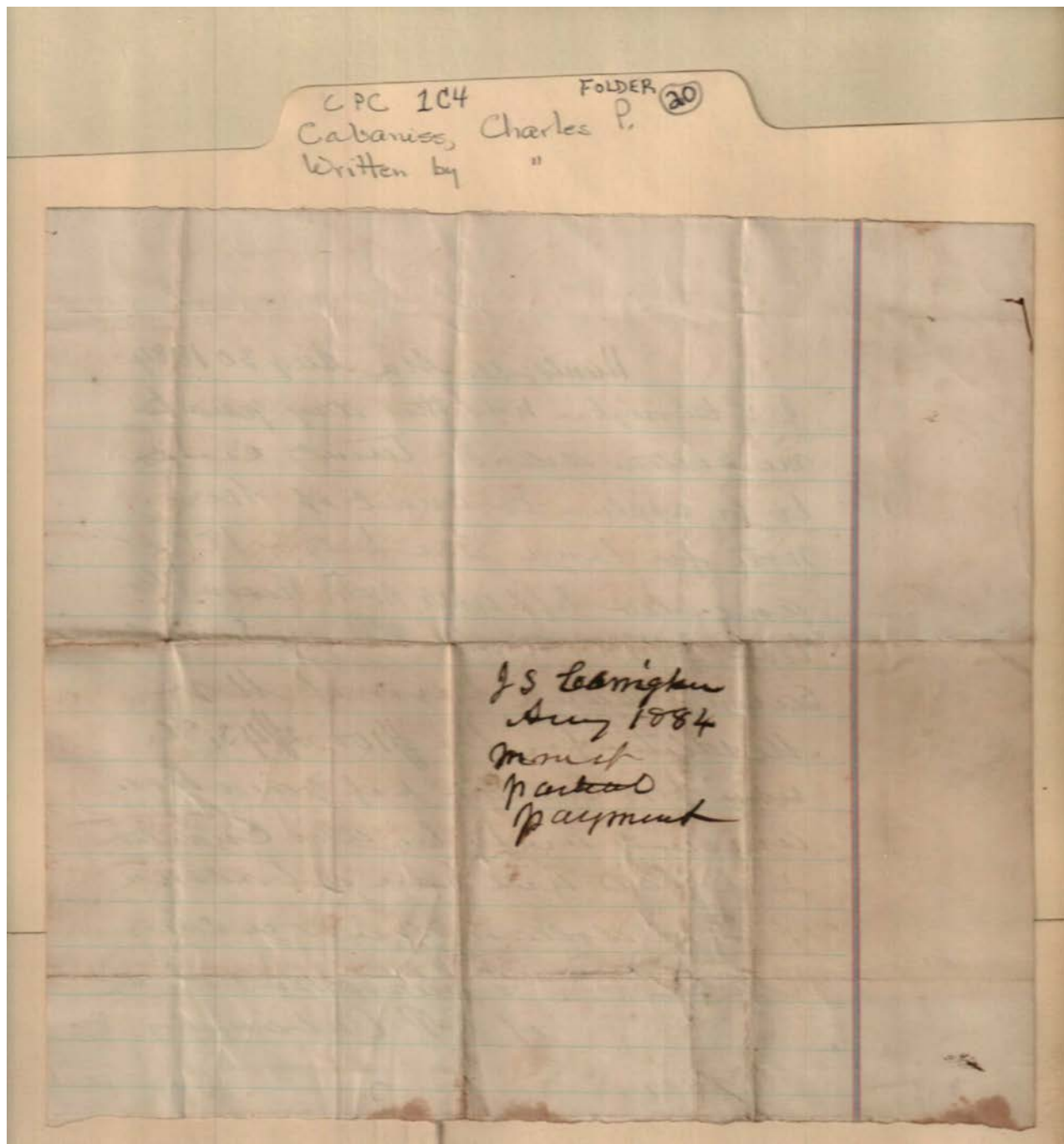
