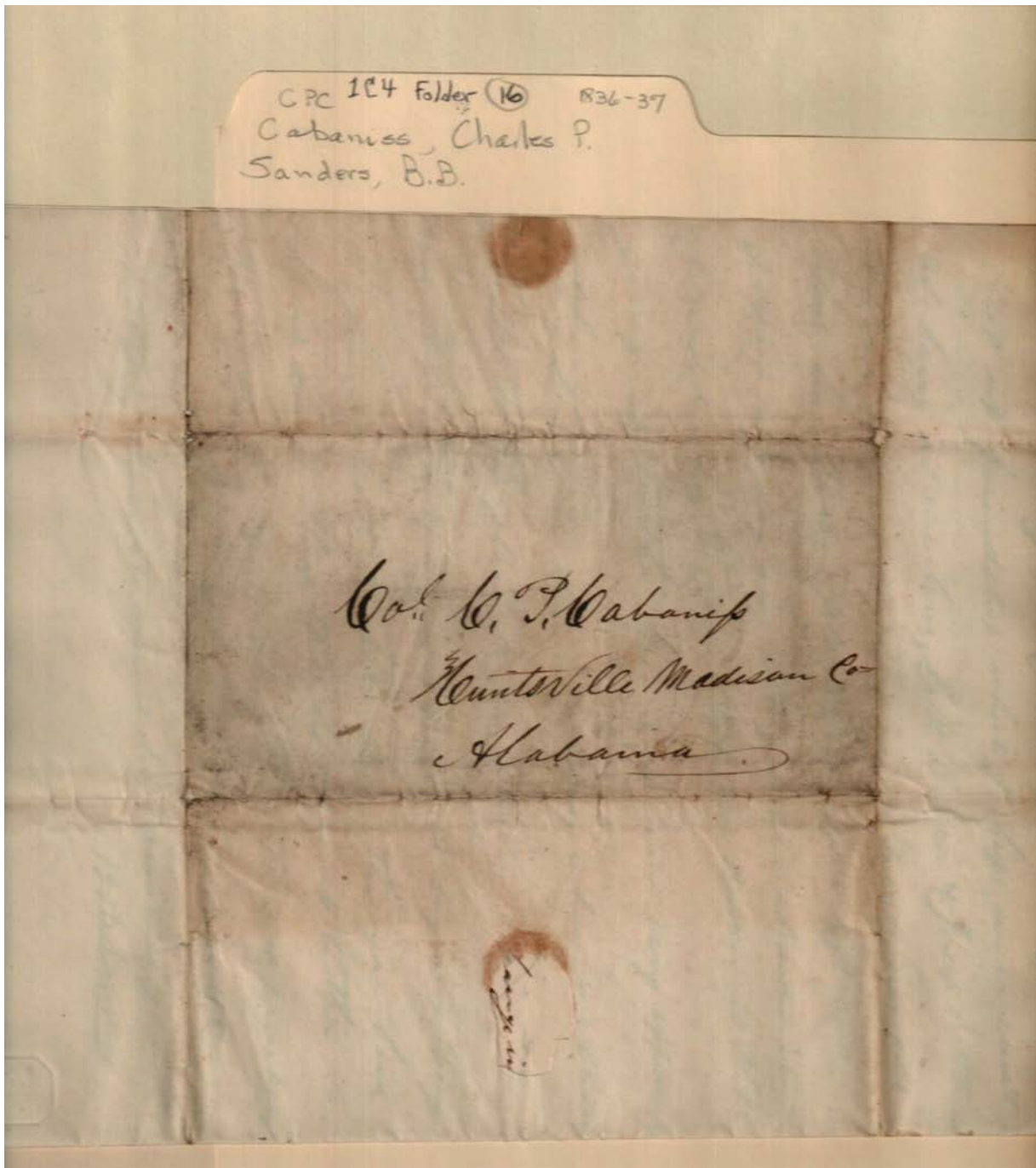

imperfect good healthy I am in better health than
you ever saw me I weigh 165 or 70 I am
quite fat and unwell I have a great deal of writing
to do if I would do it I have to keep G. H. Davis
Shop Books while he is gone to Mississippi
and if he likes that country he will want
me to keep his Books the next year and
if he does I shall have as much writing to
do as I can attend to, I keep the Books up
fasting or very near I have not got through
the day Book adding and I have got a great
many acct to draw off we are selling goods
slow for the time of the year but I still
hope and look for better times.

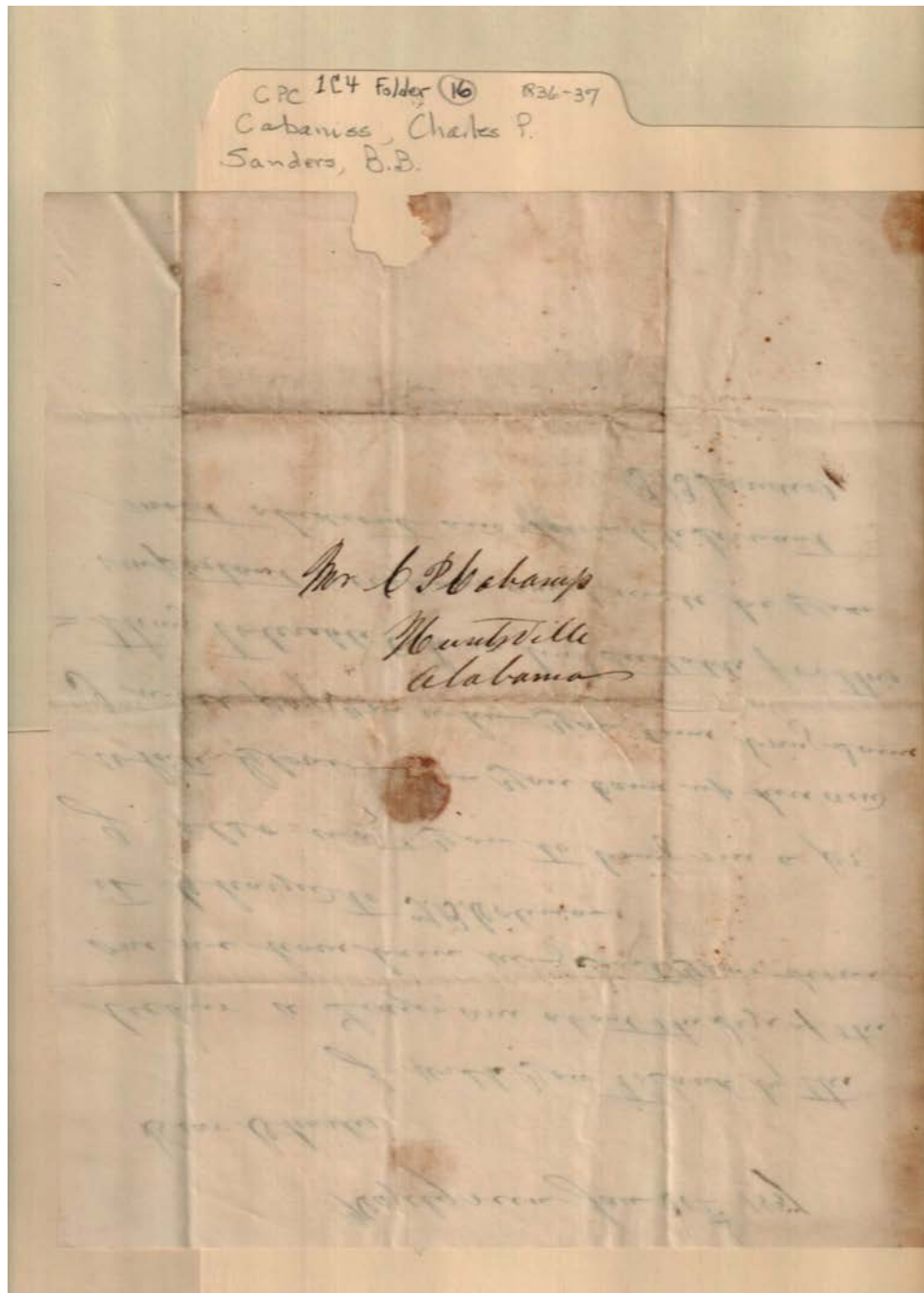
