In the obituary notice of your
deceased wife published in The Churchman of the 30th
it is mentioned that she was the daughter of "the late Com-
modore James F. Miller". A gentleman of that name was
the intimate and much beloved friend of my father's eldest
brother James B. Cabaniss who died (in Nov 1826
many years prior to my birth) - within a year or two
after his return from Harvard University. A corres-
pondence was kept up between them until my uncle's
death, and my Aunt Mrs S. A. H. White the only surviving
sister of my uncle yet preserves a profile likeness
of Mr Miller - She and my father the only sur-
viving brother, are desirous of learning something
of the history of their brother's friend; and for
their gratification I write to ask that you will
be so kind as to furnish any information that
you may have in relation thereto by letter addressed
to me at the place -

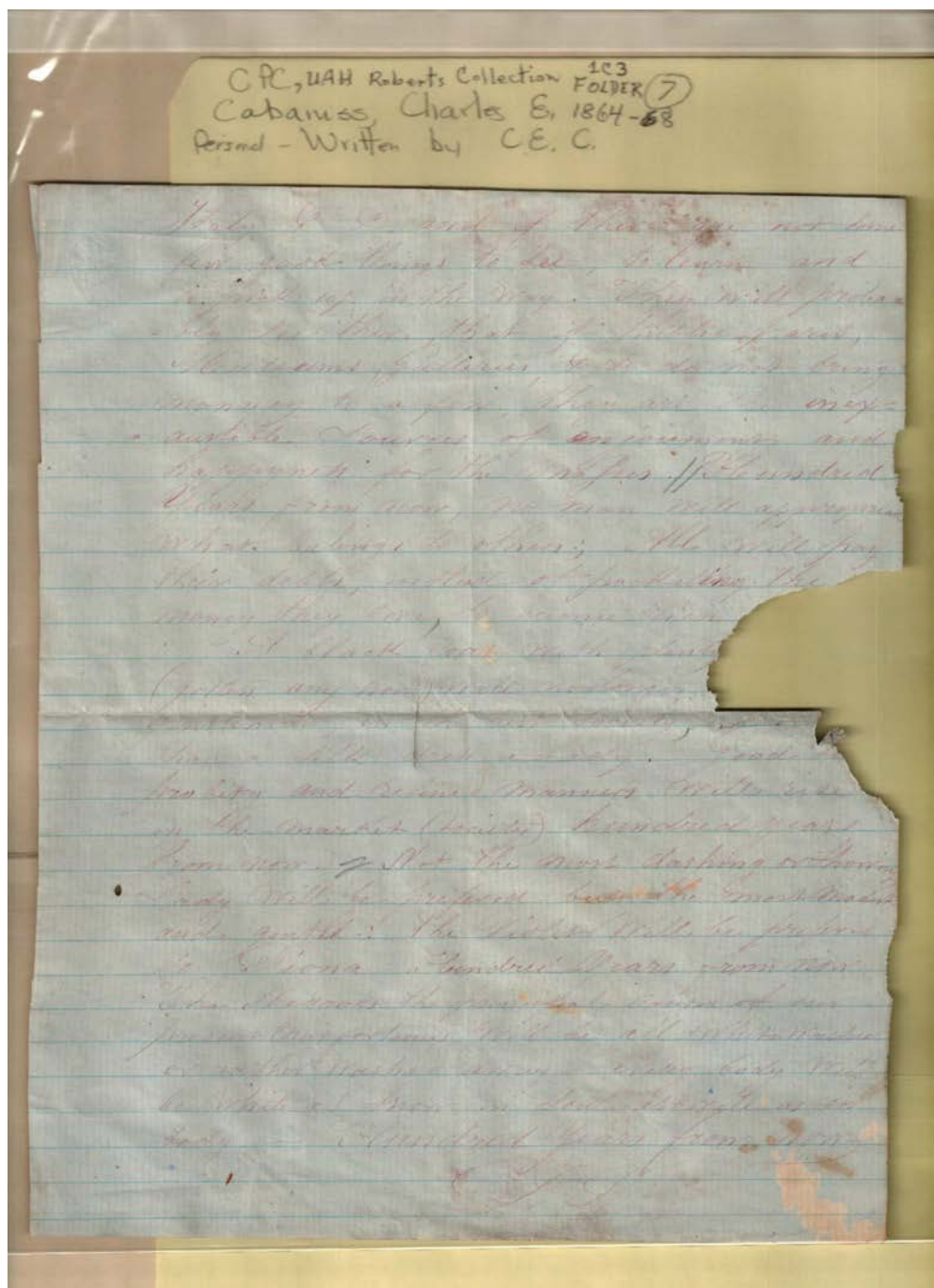
1864

 can be trusted.

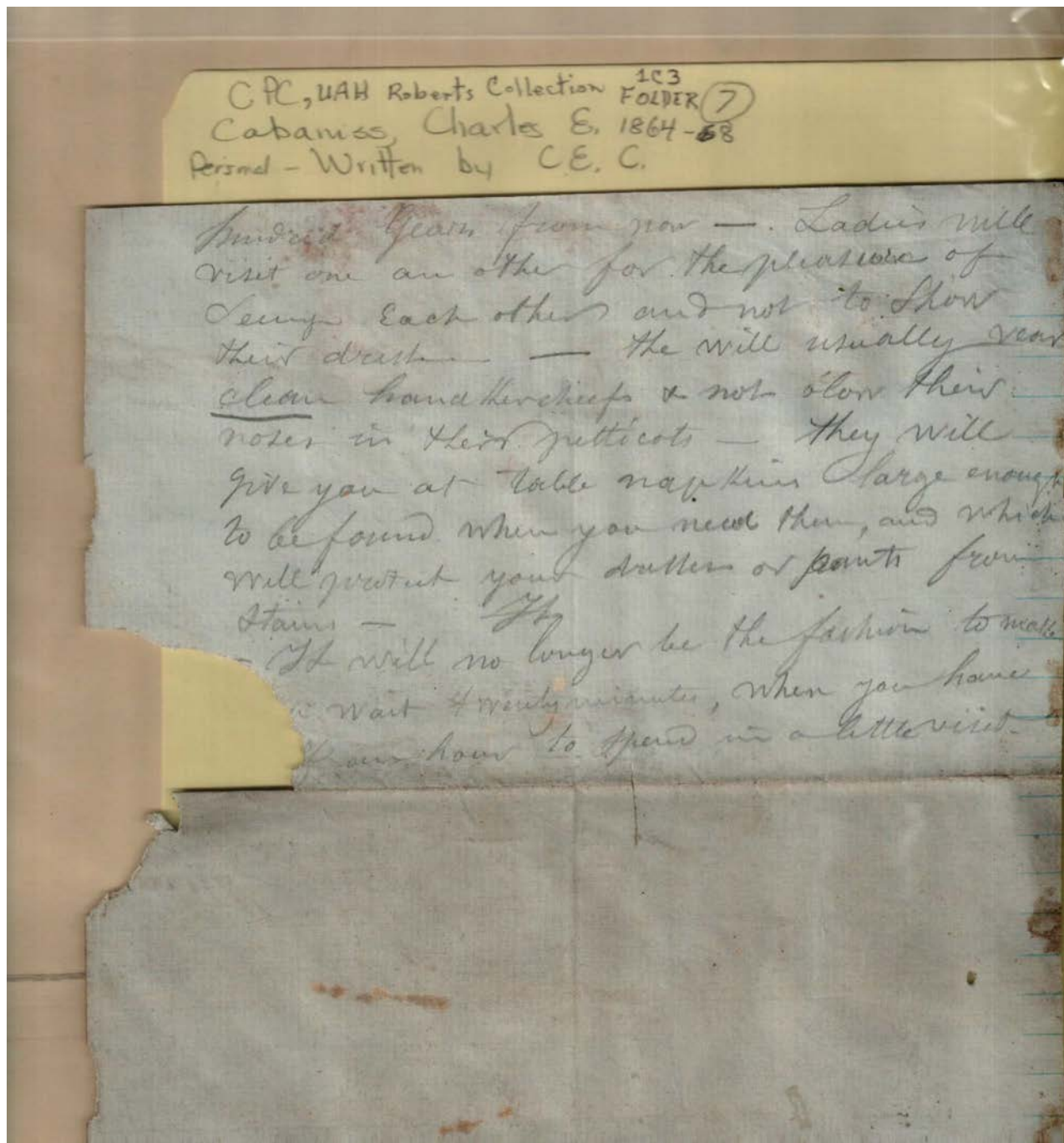
