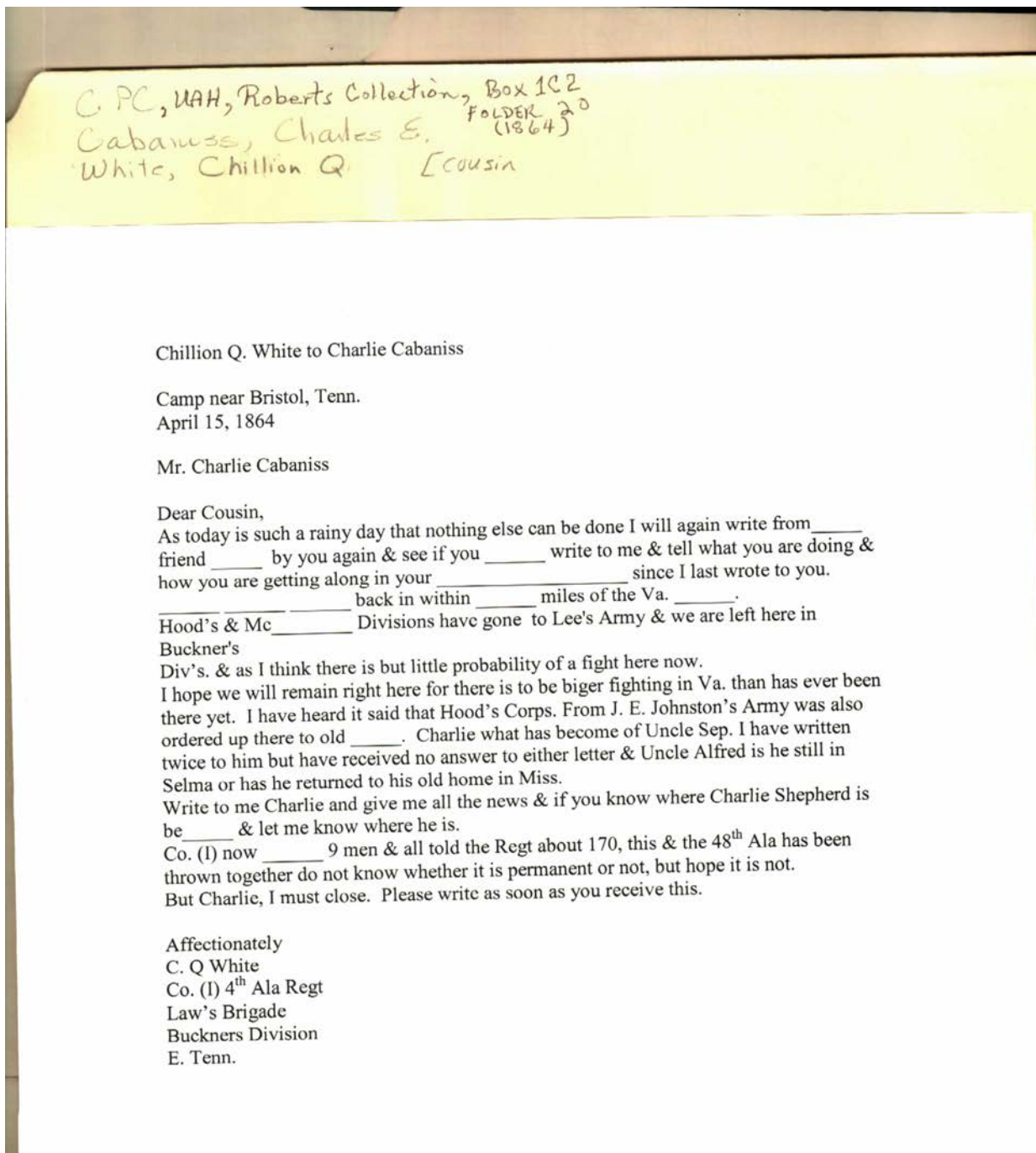

Chillion Q. White to Charlie Cabaniss

Camp near Bristol, Tenn.  
April 15, 1864

Mr. Charlie Cabaniss

Dear Cousin,

As today is such a rainy day that nothing else can be done I will again write from \_\_\_\_\_ friend \_\_\_\_\_ by you again & see if you \_\_\_\_\_ write to me & tell what you are doing & how you are getting along in your \_\_\_\_\_ since I last wrote to you.

\_\_\_\_\_ back in within \_\_\_\_\_ miles of the Va. \_\_\_\_\_.  
Hood's & Mc \_\_\_\_\_ Divisions have gone to Lee's Army & we are left here in Buckner's

Div's. & as I think there is but little probability of a fight here now. I hope we will remain right here for there is to be bigger fighting in Va. than has ever been there yet. I have heard it said that Hood's Corps. From J. E. Johnston's Army was also ordered up there to old \_\_\_\_\_. Charlie what has become of Uncle Sep. I have written twice to him but have received no answer to either letter & Uncle Alfred is he still in Selma or has he returned to his old home in Miss.

Write to me Charlie and give me all the news & if you know where Charlie Shepherd is be \_\_\_\_\_ & let me know where he is.

Co. (I) now \_\_\_\_\_ 9 men & all told the Regt about 170, this & the 48<sup>th</sup> Ala has been thrown together do not know whether it is permanent or not, but hope it is not. But Charlie, I must close. Please write as soon as you receive this.

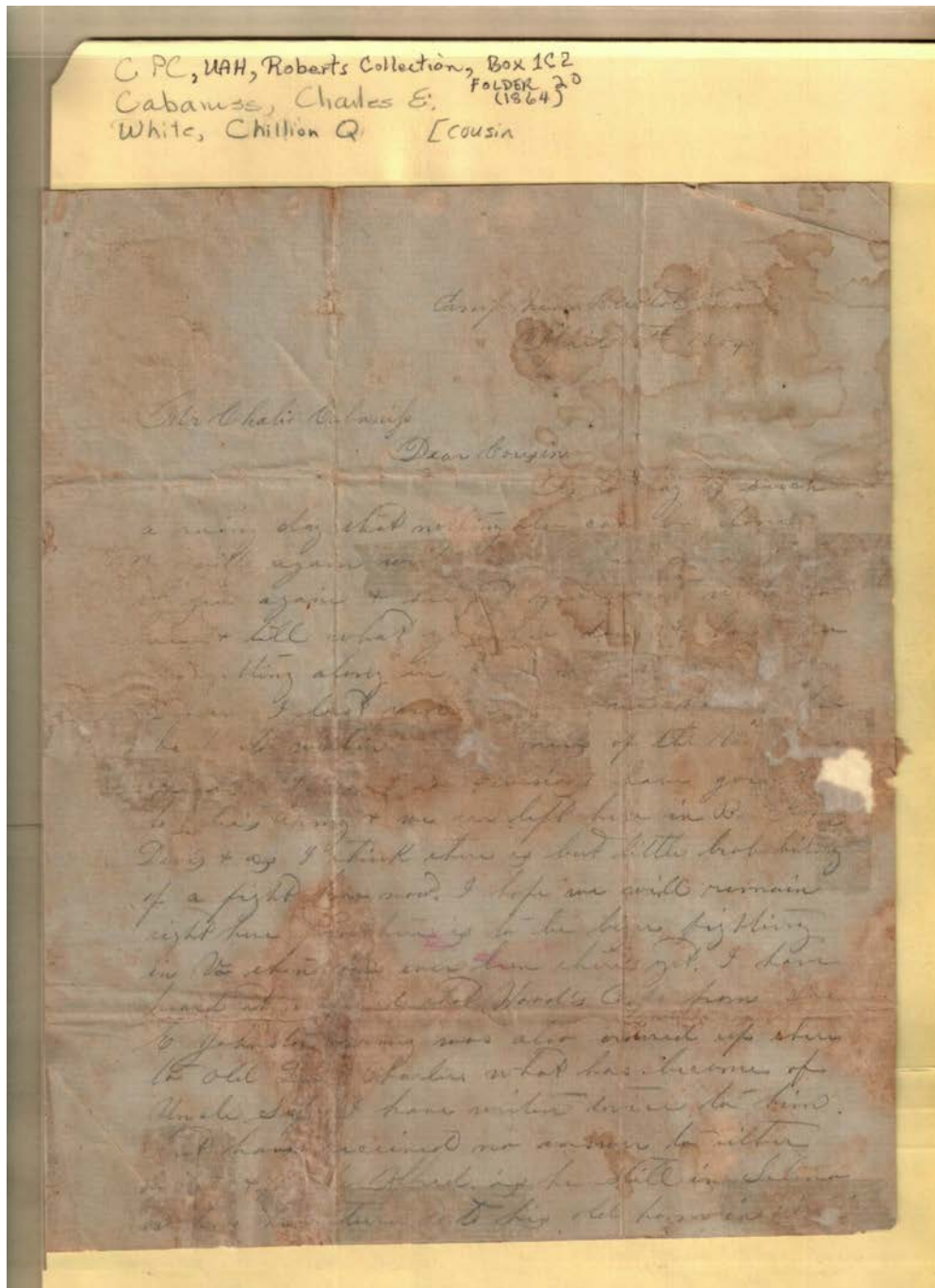

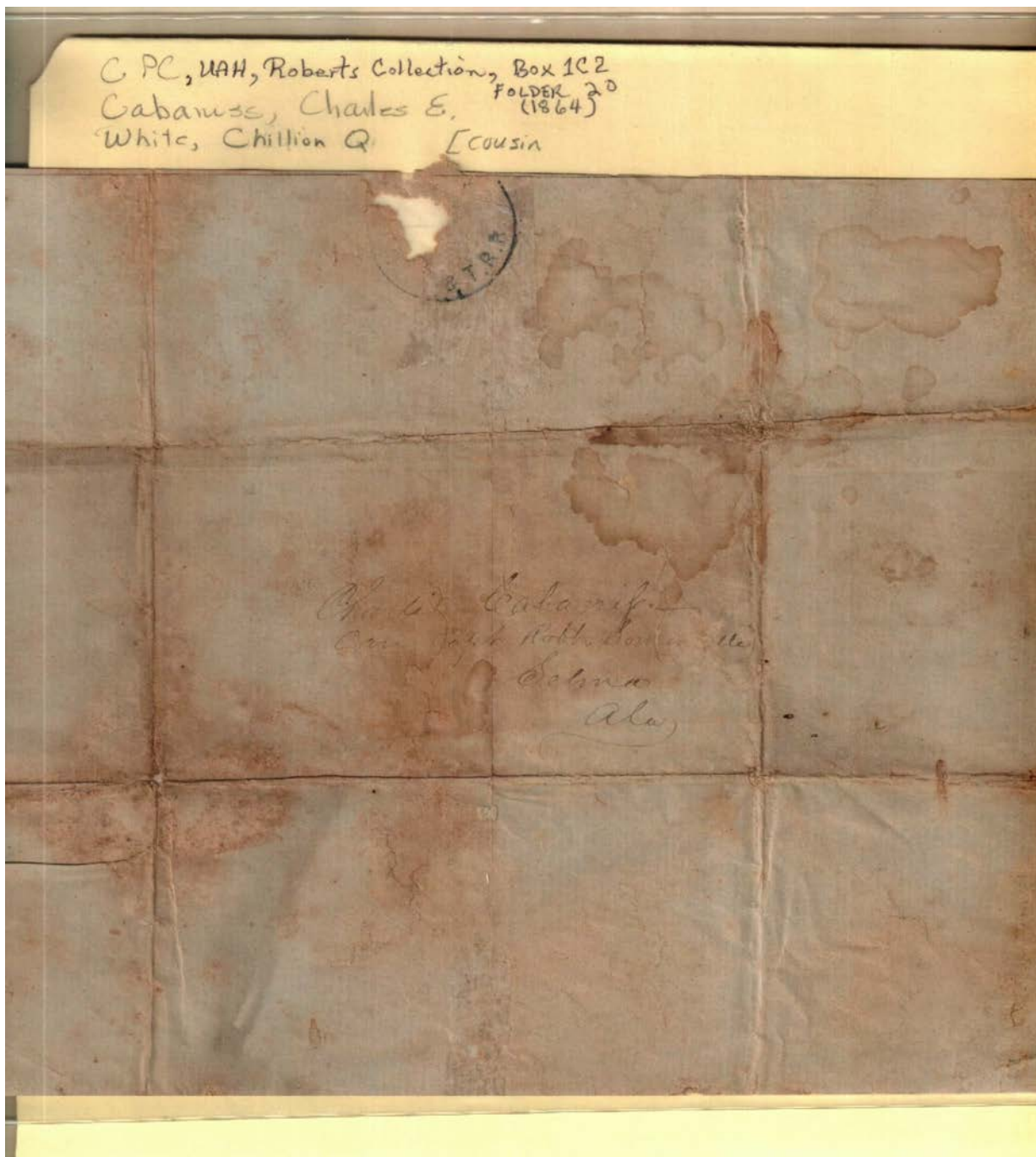
