The Methodist have had a dinner & supper & called to raise money for their new Church. The Presbyterians are at work too & Friday night the Flower Sunday is to be enacted over at the Seminary. Well, Charley, they tell me a celebration is coming again. I am wondering if you won't come home. If so I want you to try & get some Quilts & bring home with you. & some slips to patch.
