your little city. I like him very much, considering our short acquaintance. There is quite a number of your Acuteville Boys here this session. Several of them are boarding here with Col. Smead. Mr Carr's school has gone completely down. He has turned his house into a boarding house for students; but I do not think that he has yet got any boarders. Mr S. S. Savage's father has moved to Ch-silla for purpose of educating a son. Heard him preach this morning down in town. His sermon was, I thought, a very good one. I thought he did not make it as interesting as it might have been made. I also attended Dr McGuffey's Lecture, on the Bible, this morning. It was very fine, as it usually is. There are several of our old acquaintances back here this session. There are 3 or 4 new students here from your town. They are full-blooded Yankees I understand. I am this year trying the schools of Moral Philosophy, Math & History & Literature. A new course almost entirely. I went out to "Lover's Rock" with Mr S. Walker. We liked the place very tolerably well. I am still boarding at Col. Smead's. It is a much better boarding house than the one we had last session.

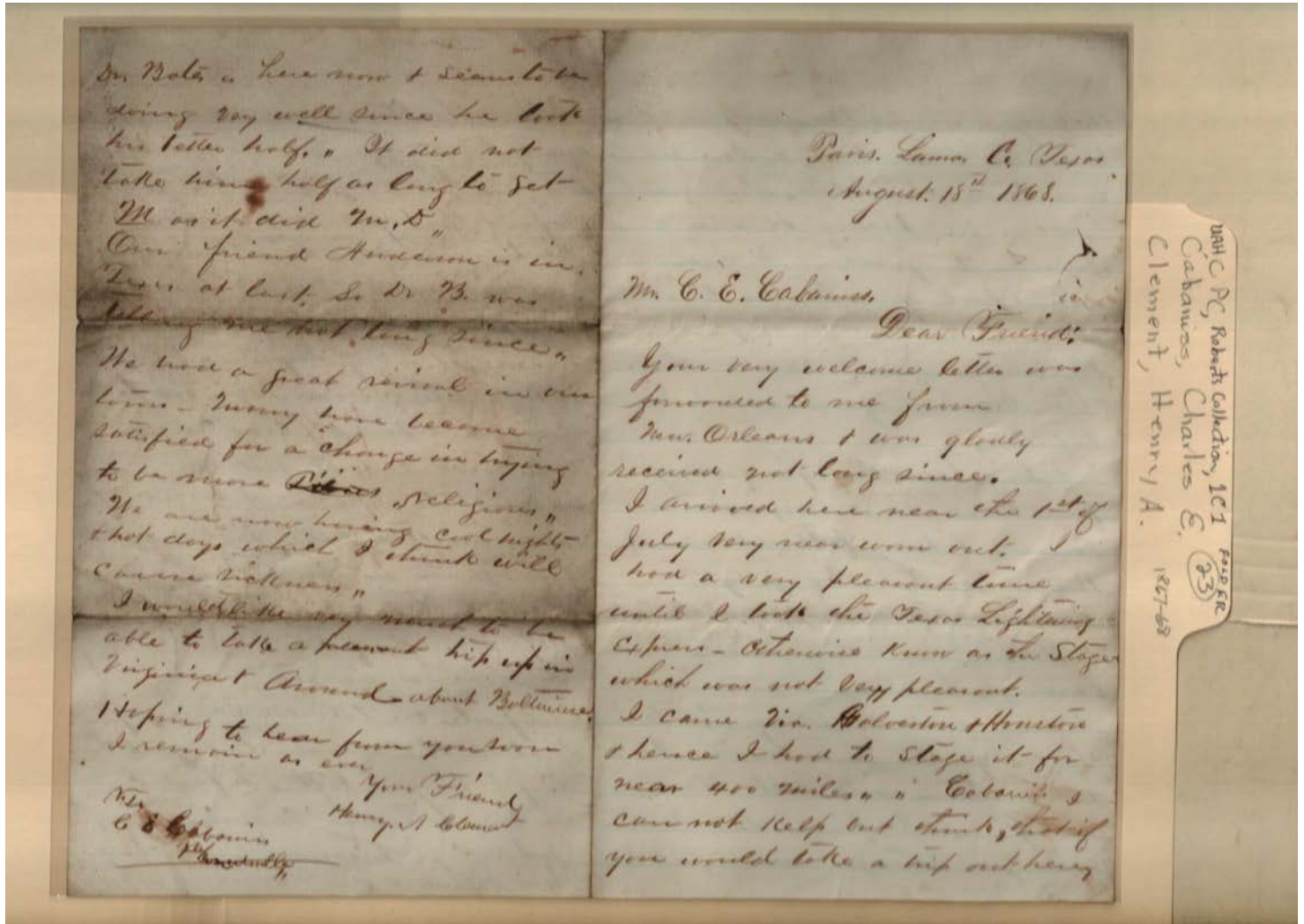

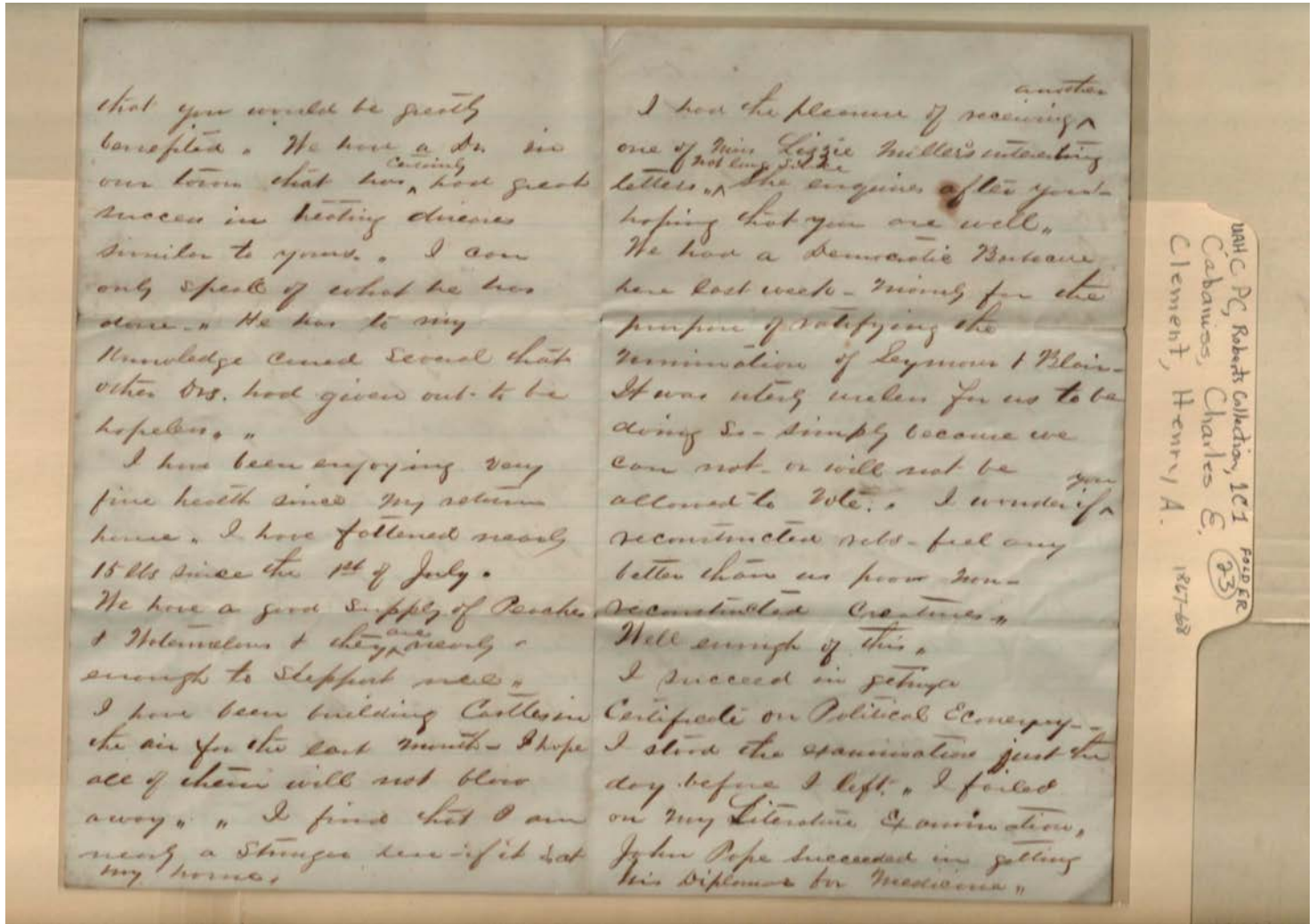
