Dear Charlie

As I have nothing of interest to communicate, I write you a few lines, to let you know that we are all in tolerable health - Willie recovered from the chills (which were slight), Budd had a few of them, but he got well enough to enjoy his birth day dinner of yesterday which was quite a good one - Frank McClung and Charles & Levin, & Miss Mary White were with us - Mrs. Shepherd & Miss Sallie set out two weeks ago for Montgomery and made the trip safely reaching there Wednesday evening - We expect them back about the last of the or first of next week - The frosts of last Wednesday morning did no serious injury in this country - I believe the cotton suffered most - Our large bed potatoes were considerably injured - but the others were not touched by the frost - Can you explain the philosophy of it - You remember that soon after the potatoes were cultivated in the large bed, we covered them, tops & all, with forest leaves - but when this frost came, the vines had struggled through that covering (not so thick as it should have been) & attained a height of ten

or twelve inches above the bed of leaves.
Do the leaves attract the frost? My recollection
of the theory of frost as I taught when I
was at school is - that the radiation of heat
from the ^{surface of the ground} into the cold air, proceeds of a cold clear
night until the temperature of the air is
so much reduced that a deposit of moisture
is made which is dew or frost according
to the degree of reduction of heat in the at-
mosphere near the surface - But if that
be the ^{true} theory, why will not the leaves prevent
the radiation of heat from the surface beneath
and thus prevent the frost? The thought just now
occurs to me that perhaps the leaf may not be
a good conductor - that whilst the leaves at
the bottom of the bed may keep the potatoes
warm - those at the top receiving no heat from
those at the bottom, become as cold earlier
in the night than the surface of the ground
elsewhere than under the covering, hence
the frost was heavier upon the surface
of the leaves than upon the uncovered sur-
face of the ground - There is a peach
tree in one corner of the bed - The vines
under that were not injured - I suppose
that the heat radiating from the surface
of the leaves were reflected by the foliage
of the tree so as to prevent the reduction
of heat necessary to a deposition of frost.
