





If you think it but I will send this cloth to you to you and let you have the coat made then. There are but 8 yds. Of the cloth, but Mrs. T. thinks it will make a coat for you & one for me. In the sack you will find a white linen coat of mine, which you can wear if it will suit [you]. There is also a gingham coat, but I presume it is too large for you. I am [sad] to learn that the shoes are too small for you. It it possible I will get you some leather in Marshall, but I doubt my ability to do so, fear it is not there. I expect to go there in a few days. I have had dyarrhea for several days past, but am well today.
