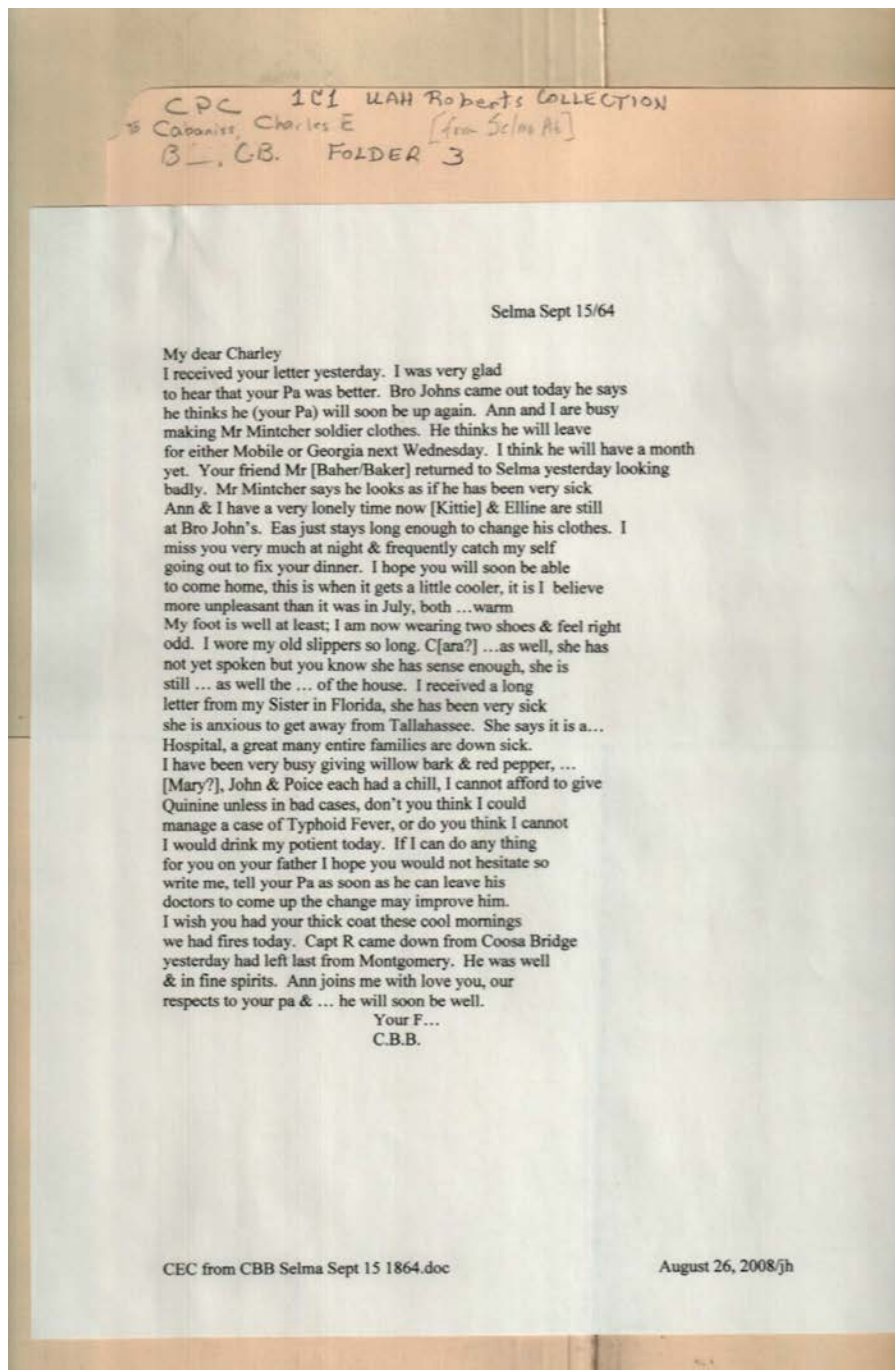

Selma Sept 15/64

My dear Charles

I received your letter yesterday I was very glad
to hear that you had written. The John came out today he says
he thinks he (you) will soon be at again. Ann & I are busy
making Mr. Mintcher add his clothes he thinks he will leave
for either Mobile, or Georgia ^{Monday} I think he will have a month
yet. Your friend Mr. Baker returned to Selma yesterday looking
badly. Mr. Mintcher says he looks as if he had been very sick.
Ann & I have a very lovely time now. Kittie & I have an idea
at the John's, he just stay long enough to change his clothes. I
miss you very much at night, & frequently wish my self
going out to fix your dinner. I hope you will soon be able
to come home, this is when it gets a little cooler, it is better
now more unpleasant than it was in July. About my feet
My feet is well at last. I am now wearing two shoes. I feel right
old. I wear my old slippers as long. Love keeps well. She has

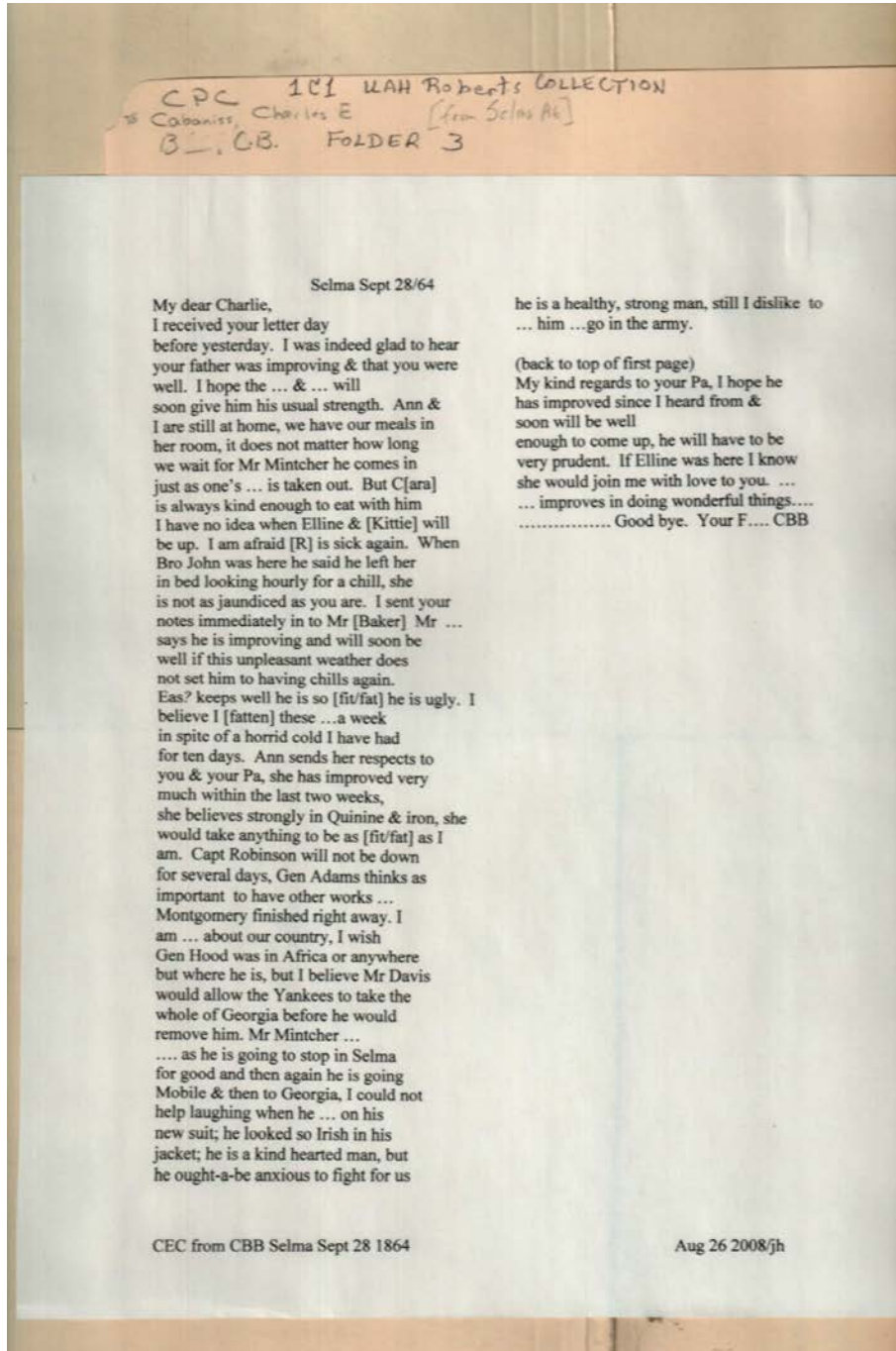

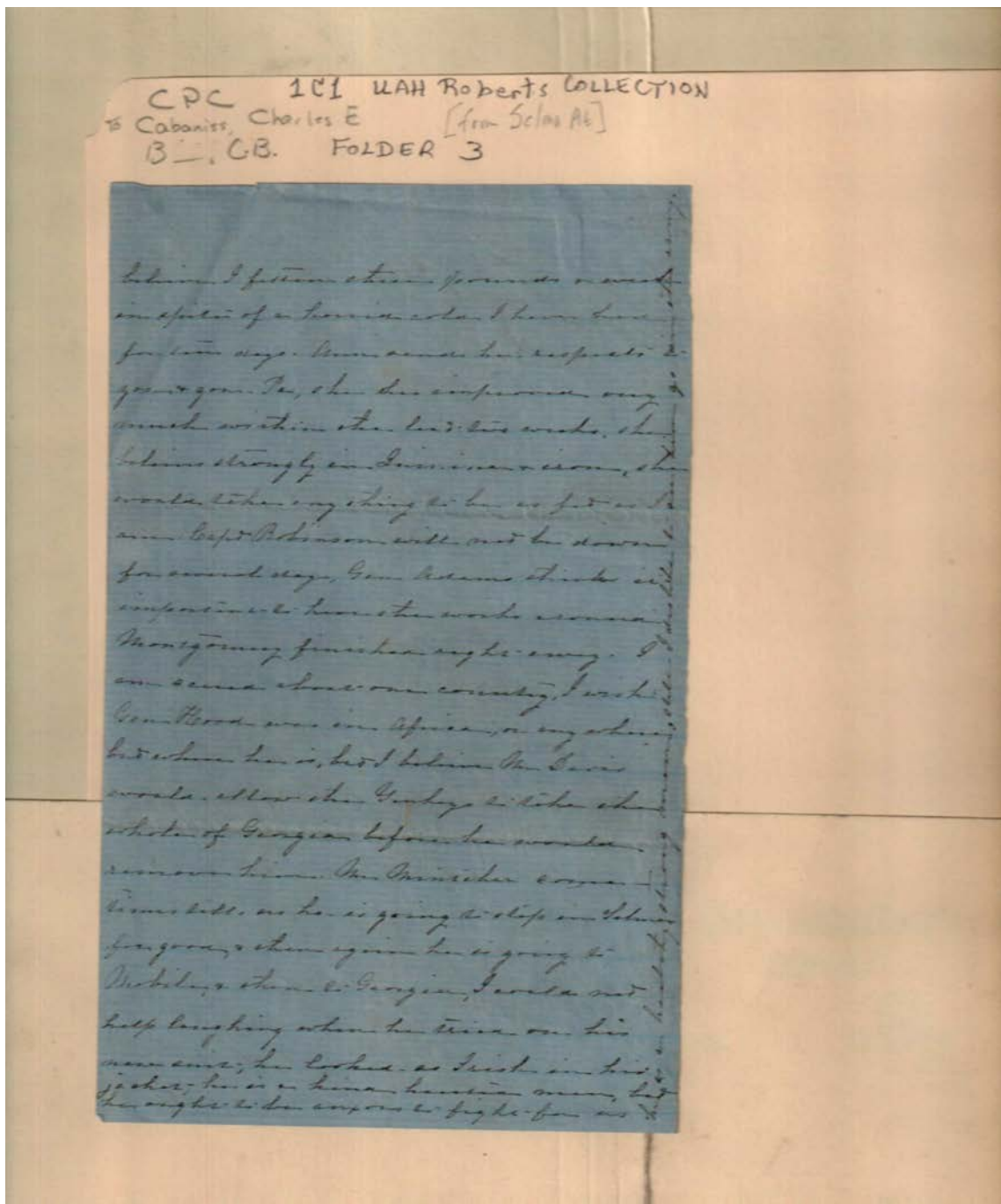
