

Roberts-Corr. 267 P7 Query Cabanis Near Whitesburg, So Side Tenn. Copy Jany 11th 1865, at night. Brig Genl P.D. Roddey, Gen1; I have met with several persons today, who have crossed the River within the last few days, all of whom concur in stating that, the 4th Army Corps, commanded by Genl Wood (U.S.)¹, is at Huntsville, from Decatur, on Friday and Saturday. Of these facts I entertain no doubt. One of these persons, Mrs. Bailey., (Sister of Adjt Moore, of Paterson's Command in your division)² who left on Saturday, states the two RR Engineers had told her, at her mother's house, that Steadman's Command³ would commence moving that day to Chattanooga. Charles Callan, who left Hunts' a few days ago, says that Steadman's Corps was at Huntsville. He new nothing of it's moving up the road, but says a soldier, who crossed the R.R. above Huntsville, on Sat or Sunday, told him that he saw two trains, heavily loaded with troops go up the road. Mrs. Bailey and Callan both say that there is a very large force at and near Huntsville, estimated at not less than 20,000. That there is not now a large Cavalry force. But Callan says that, in the early part of last week, and before the arrival of the 4th Army Corps, there was a large Cavalry force encamped a few miles West of Huntsville, that Thos. Bibb, who lived in the vicinity of their Camp, went to Huntsville for a guard, the Commandant said he could have a guard, but that the Cavalry would leave in a day or two. He, Callan, says he heard that they came from the direction of Athens and returned that way, and that they were going to East Port; but he had no personal knowledge of these facts.
