The Wheeler Basin Regional Library was the first organization in the state to use the National Council on Aging's Humanities Programs. The response has been excellent from senior citizens who have participated in these programs during 1979 and 1980. Participants have repeatedly requested units on the South. Since the National Council on Aging's Programs do not include units on the South, a new program has been designed especially for the older rural residents of the library's region. Nutrition sites in the three counties will serve as meeting places for the new programs as they have for previous humanity programs. See Appendix A for letters from the local Councils on Aging supporting these programs.

This program will define some of the myths about rural Southerners both black and white, explore the origins of these myths, consider how and why these myths have been perpetuated, and review what is happening to these myths today.

Unless a rural Southerner travels, he is usually unaware of the way others may view him. If he is aware of the myths, he rarely understands why they exist. Examing these myths will help the participants to see why others perceive rural Southerners in these stereotyped roles and what truth there is in the stereotyping.

B. Describe the format of the program and give a schedule of activities. This program will be conducted in small discussion groups. There will be five sites located in rural Limestone, Lawrence and Morgan Counties which will participate in this program. There will be one session per week at each site. The program will run seven weeks.

SESSION ONE: IDENTIFICATION OF THE MYTHS

Ms. Dotzheimer will introduce the program, deposit the materials to be used during the sessions, and discuss the various myths.

SESSION TWO: HISTORIC ORIGINS OF THE MYTHS

Dr. Frances Roberts will discuss with the participants some of the origins of the myths.

SESSION THREE: THE RURAL SOUTHERNER IN NONFICTION

Ms. Dotzheimer will lead a discussion of nonfiction writings by Southerners that influenced the myths.

SESSION FOUR: THE RURAL SOUTHERNER IN FICTION

Ms. Dotzheimer will lead a discussion of fiction written by Southerners that perpetuated the myths.

SESSION FIVE: THE RURAL SOUTHERNER IN FILMS

Ms. Sandra Sherman, using film clips, will discuss with the participants the influence of films in spreading the myths about the rural Southerner and the new myths the films have created over the last twenty years.

SESSION SIX: THE OLD SOUTH AND THE NEW

A tour of antebellum Huntsville, a picnic, and a tour of the Alabama Space and Rocket Center will end the unit.
