U. S. GOVERNMENT AWARDS — ACADEMIC YEAR 1955-56

Authorized by Public Law 584 (79th Congress) — The Fulbright Act

Under the auspices of the Department of State and the Board of Foreign Scholarships

Description of Awards

The awards offered are exclusively for university lecturing and for research at the post-doctoral level.

Ordinary awards are made for the full academic year, although in exceptional circumstances applications will be considered for research for periods of not less than six months, or for lecturing for a semester or for the full period of an established summer school.

Awards may be made for only one country and arrangements will be made for those selected to be affiliated with an institution of higher learning abroad.

Awards under the Fulbright Act are made in the currency of the host country. Awards for lecturers and research scholars usually include:

- Round trip transportation for the grantee (provision is not made for the transportation of accompanying dependents);
- A maintenance allowance which may be adjusted to take into account the expenses of up to four accompanying dependents;
- A small supplemental allowance for travel in the host country and books or equipment purchasable abroad.

Maintenance allowances are calculated on the basis of living costs in the host country and therefore differ from country to country in dollar equivalents. In terms of purchasing power, they are approximately equal.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be U. S. citizens.
- Those applying for lectureships are expected to have at least one year of college or university teaching experience in the U. S. or abroad.
- Applicants for research awards are expected to have a doctoral degree from a recognized institution of higher learning in the U. S. or abroad **at the time of application**, or recognized standing in their respective professions. Candidates for the doctoral degree or those expecting to obtain it in the normal course of their training should apply to the Institute of International Education, 1 East 67th Street, New York City.
- Specialists in such fields as library service, social work, adult education, nursing education and museum and art gallery methods may apply for either lecturing or research awards and will be considered eligible if they have completed their formal undergraduate and postgraduate training and have been established in their professions for several years.

Other Countries

FULBRIGHT AWARDS for 1955-56 for the countries in which the academic year begins in the spring or early summer were listed in an announcement issued in March 1954. Closing date for mailing applications under this competition was April 15. The countries included were: AUSTRALIA, BURMA, CEYLON, INDIA, NEW ZEALAND, PHILIPPINES, THAILAND, THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA.

REFERENCE SERVICE REPORT

INQUIRY: Records relating to the early history of Madison County, Alabama; and correspondence of Return J. Meigs, particularly in relation to the Indian cessions of 1803-1816.

Report: A search among the records of the General Land Office now in the National Archives has not revealed any information relating to the early history of Madison County, Alabama. It is entirely possible that local records in Alabama would contain more information concerning Madison County than official records of the General Land Office in the National Archives. It is suggested, therefore, that the inquirer communicate with the Alabama Department of Archives and History, War Memorial Building, Montgomery, Alabama, in regard to this matter.

Return J. Meigs was agent to the Cherokees from 1801 to 1822 and also served as financial agent of the War Department in Tennessee during approximately the same period. The field records of the Cherokee Agency during the period of Meigs' incumbency were very carefully preserved and are now among the older records of the Bureau of Indian Affairs in the National Archives. However, these records, which comprise some five or six thousand documents, are not arranged according to subject matter. A preliminary search of the records of the Cherokee Agency for the years 1801-1802 has disclosed some fifteen documents, bearing Meigs' signature, which relate to Indian cessions and use of Indian land. It is apparent, therefore, that the segregation of all of Meigs' correspondence relating solely to Indian cessions would be a difficult and time-consuming task which the limited staff of the National Archives is unable to undertake at this time. The National Archives, however, has filmed as part of its microfilm publication program records of the Cherokee Indian Agency for the period 1801-1835. Positive prints (reproduced from a master negative copy) of correspondence and miscellaneous records of the Cherokee Agency for the years 1801-1816 can be furnished for \$38.00.

Record copies of the letters sent by the Secretary of War relating to Indian matters in this period also have been filmed as part of the National Archives microfilm publication program.
