Howard C. Jones of New Market, Alabama, a former resident of Huntoville, and received valuable information but little bearing directly on the Moore home.

I was quite thankful, then, when Mr. Brannon suggested that I write to you for I hoped that you might provide me with a part of my work that I sadly lacked. It seems that the rather disappointing later years of Gabriel Moore's life caused him to be much forgotten in Alabama and there is little written about him. Also his private correspondences have been lost or quite probably destroyed so that sources for my search are very few. Therefore any information that you might have on Governor Moore would be most helpful to me and your making the same available to me would be heartily appreciated.

May I venture to ask a few direct questions that might be a guide to the sort of thing I am after. First, do you know anything of Governor Moore's home; where it was located; what it looked like; or what finally happened to it? Further, have you any information on the home of Gabriel's brothers Edward & Matthew Redd, who followed their brother into the Huntoville area? Do their homes still stand. Also do you have any information bearing directly on Gabriel's life in Huntoville? Is there anything on his short marriage to Miss Callen and how did it effect his standing in Huntoville.

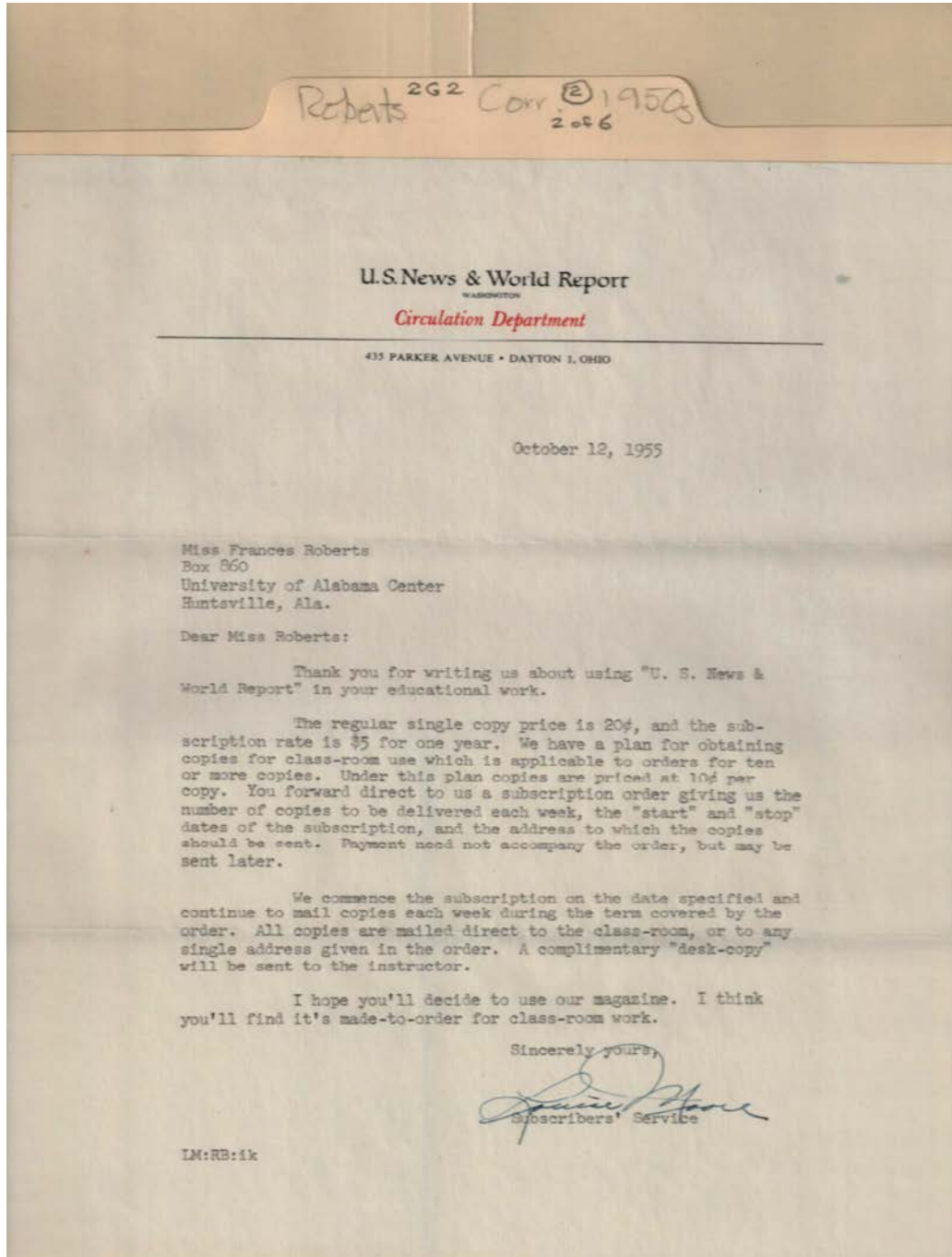

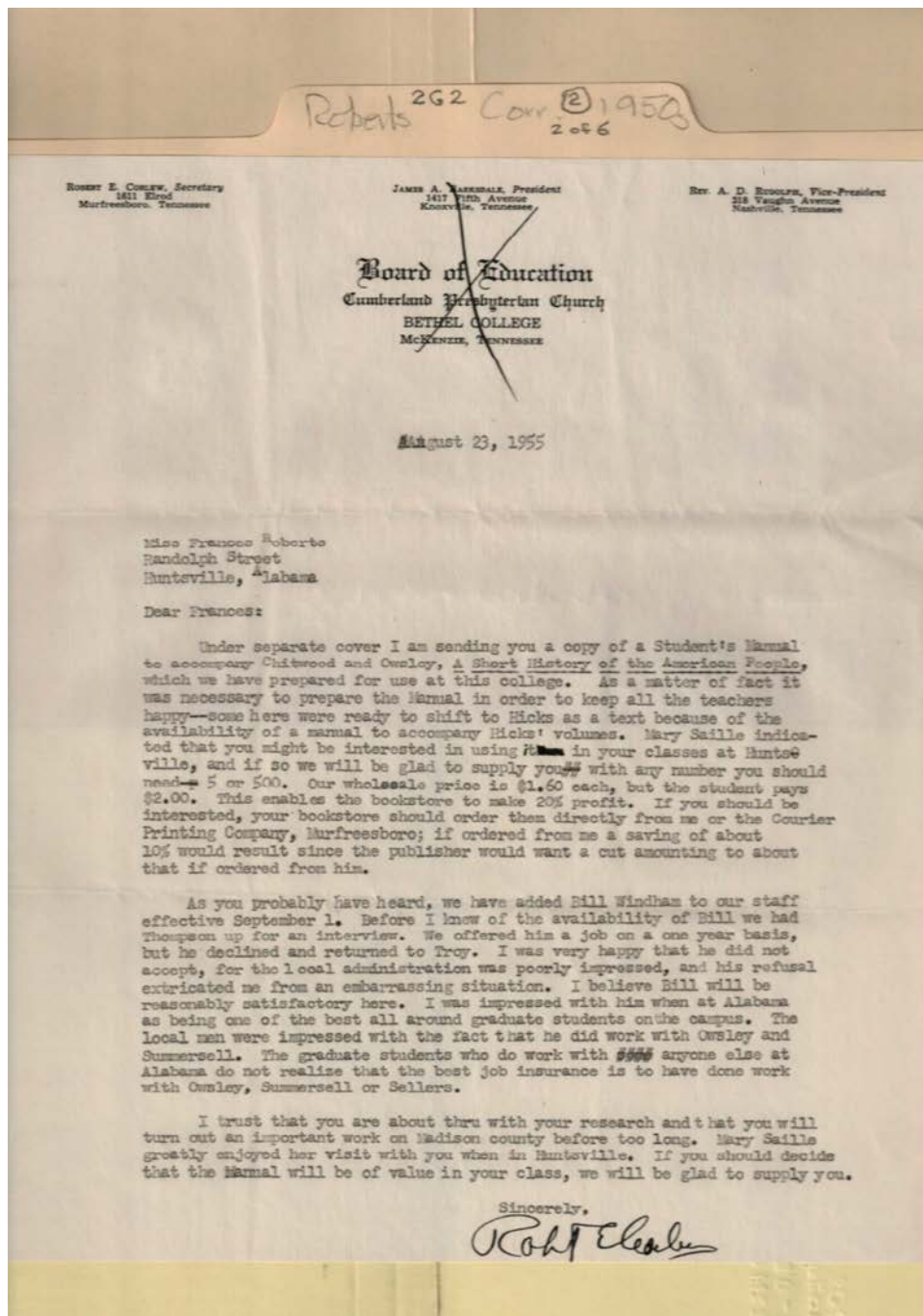
