overn different, and, in short, the stream of history would have cut different channels. Queen Elimbeth was too much a creature of her own age to pull this political rabbi; out of her hat. But our own Revolutionary forefathers did commit the nation to this way did commit ine nation to this way of government, and those who played the double role of organiz-ing the Church as well as the nation, jave the same system to the Church. From the highest to the lowest levels of Church government, the laity have a privileged and decisive GIRLS FRIEN

serve as a vestry; that is, they are vested with the people's authority. The next organizational level is the Diocese. Here again we see rep-resentative government at work. resentative government at work. Each parish and mission sends lay delegates as well as their elergy to their annual Diocesan Convention.
