to my life and preserved it in more than ordinary health, would very soon terminate it, but such are my multiplying and increasing animal infirmities and mental cares, that if it were practicable I would put Chauniere to market, and spend my very few remaining days in frugal retirement.

Whilst I am writing this letter, my Granddaughter Evelyn Byrd (who has been an inmate of our house ever since she left her mother) received a communication from her Brother Paul in Ohio, acquainting her with her father's very recent demise. Evelyn is a very good girl and I have no doubt has all the feelings of an affectionate daughter upon the occasion, but it is pretty well ascertained that children ever received from parents fewer evidences of paternal affection than the late C. W. Byrd, and no death in the state of Ohio would be so little lamented or who when living was as much despised. No good quality was ever attributed him, a kind of cold prudence existed, and not long before his decease gave a proof to the injury of his children of the feebleness of his intellect and bigotry.

He had become some time since a member of the Blasphemers Shakers society. His youngest son William was likewise not only a member of the same society, but has been I think not less than two years resident in their town in Mercer which is not more than twelve miles hence.

William is I doubt not sincere in his inversion an amiable and in manners polished young man, but is by no means master of argument to defend the ill advised step he has taken. By the laws of the society, every member divests himself of all private property, of which William gives up I suspect not less than from one to two thousand dollars.

If my authority is good and I have no reason to question it, the Father had received his dividend of his mother's estate in whole or part, Five Thousand dollars which was relinquished to the Shaker treasurer, and a further sum of two thousand it said has been added to it. It is however supposed to have been only a loan perhaps.

I have a gratification in saying that your Aunt enjoys as good health as she has for the last two years, but I should betray good folks should I flatter myself with the continuance of our temporal union much longer. To be so would be a donation from the order of nature--the consideration that its depreciation probably will soon take place is an alloy to the little comfort I have in my old age, altho I do not covit death.

I do not consider it as an evil, both our animal and pecuniary powers are too much decayed for performing the arduous duties of our station from which I cannot devise any mode of relief. We can find it only in death, the sure refuge of all sublunary cares and miseries. I must confess that my sufferings have been chiefly by anticipation, but I fear they cannot but befall me if my mortal course continues much longer.
