1864—First location on South Side Square when Alabama was only 45 years old. Note the steeples of Episcopal and Presbyterian churches in background.

1897—Finds the Van Valkenburgh and Matthews partnership in their new building on the corner of Church and Jefferson Sts. (Gardner's present location.)

LATER—Relocated to rear of building (where present Mason Furniture Co. now stands) and renamed the firm as HUNTSVILLE TRANSFER & BUILDING MATERIAL COMPANY.

1923—Because of growing pains, moved in this building—still standing—at the corner of Church St. and Holmes Ave.

1969—Occupying our present location since 1929, the firm still remains in the family and popularly known as just—"VAN VALKENBURGH'S".

HAS ONLY EXISTED FOR 41 YEARS
OF OUR STATEHOOD. BUT IT LOOKS
TO PLAYING A BIG ROLE FROM HERE ON.**

The Alabama State Docks Department is more than 100 years younger than the State of Alabama, but the idea of its support and the related river systems began long before Alabama became the 22nd state in the Union.

The French arrived in 1699 and got the first permanent foothold in what came to be Alabama. DeSoto had marched across Alabama earlier, but the Spaniards were looking for gold, not necessities. The French, who came by sea, came to stay. They stayed between 1700 and 1810, early pioneers moved southward up the river valleys from Mobile, and river Americans came by land from the original 13 colonies. When Andrew Jackson defeated the Creek Confederacy of Horseshoe Bend in 1813, inland Alabama was safe for settlement. Cotton became the crop, and cotton went to England via the river and the Port of Mobile.

In the 1820's, great dams and locks began to appear on Alabama's Tennessee River. Locks and dams made the Warrior-Tombigbee navigation. The Chattahoochee became a slack-water route from Phenix City to Gulf. And the inland docks at Phenix, Decatur and Marietta on the Tennessee River, at Phenix City, Etahale and Columbus on the Chattahoochee in Jordan, Demopolis, Tuscaloosa and Cordova on the Warrior-Tombigbee, and at Bayou La Pate on the Mississippi Canal.

Today, there's inland dock facilities after Alabama ready-made industrial sites, geared to large movement of bulk cargo or designed to store soybeans or grain, or both.



Today, the Port of Mobile handles exports and imports for the state's industrial and agricultural economies, and the Alabama State Docks has played an important role in the development of a new iron and steel complex at Thunderbolt.

Today, work is progressing on the great dams on the Alabama River. Soon, the Alabama will be wide open all the way to Montgomery.

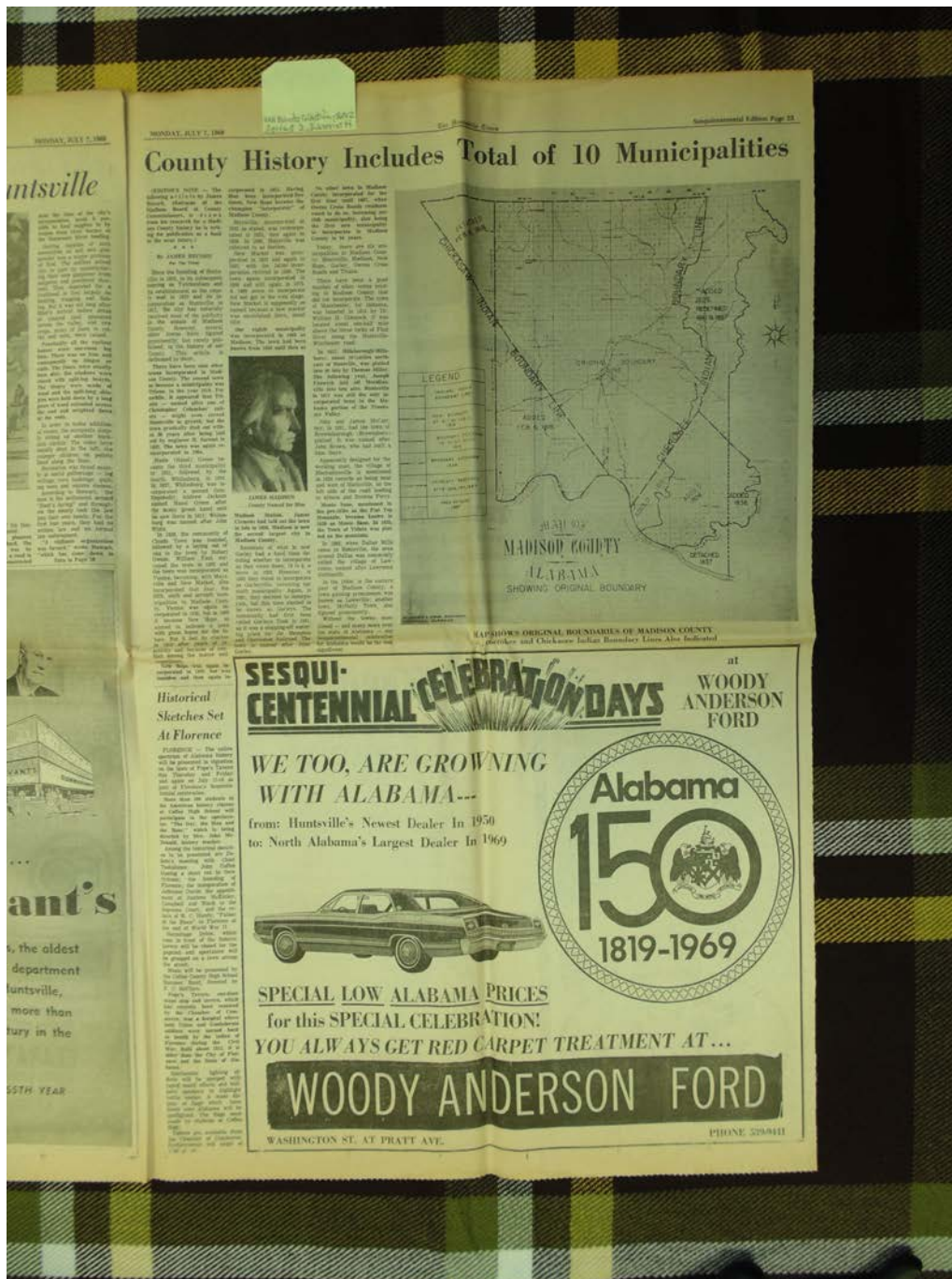

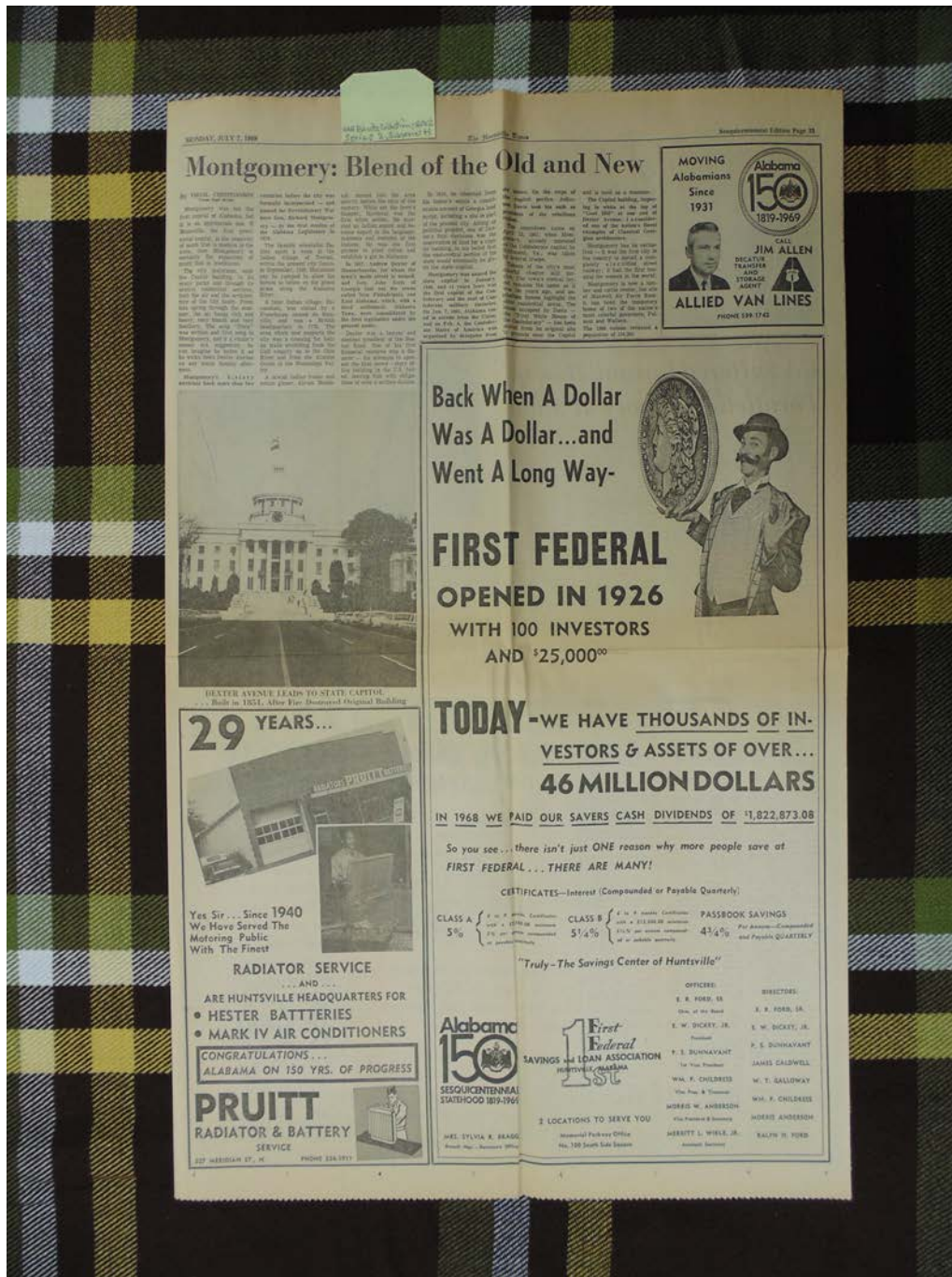

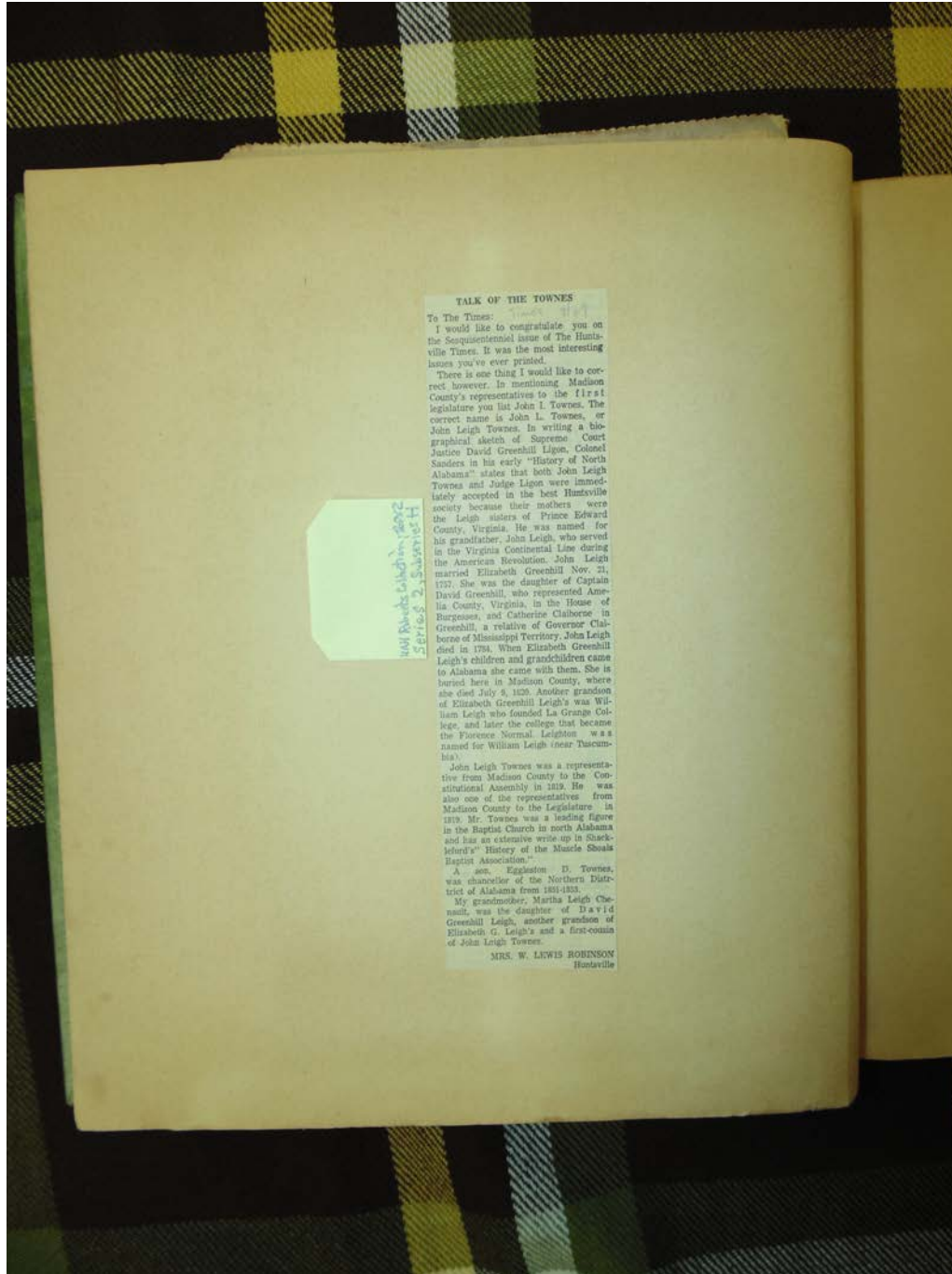

TALK OF THE TOWNES

To The Times: I would like to congratulate you on the Septennial issue of The Huntsville Times. It was the most interesting issues you've ever printed.

There is one thing I would like to correct however. In mentioning Madison County's representatives to the first legislature you list John I. Townes. The correct name is John L. Townes, or John Leigh Townes. In writing a biographical sketch of Supreme Court Justice David Greenhill Ligon, Colonel Sanders in his early "History of North Alabama" states that both John Leigh Townes and Judge Ligon were immediately accepted in the best Huntsville society because their mothers were the Leigh sisters of Prince Edward County, Virginia. He was named for his grandfather, John Leigh, who served in the Virginia Continental Line during the American Revolution. John Leigh married Elizabeth Greenhill Nov. 21, 1777. She was the daughter of Captain David Greenhill, who represented Amelia County, Virginia, in the House of Burgesses, and Catherine Claiborne in Greenhill, a relative of Governor Claiborne of Mississippi Territory. John Leigh died in 1794. When Elizabeth Greenhill Leigh's children and grandchildren came to Alabama she came with them. She is buried here in Madison County, where she died July 9, 1829. Another grandson of Elizabeth Greenhill Leigh's was William Leigh who founded La Grange College, and later the college that became the Florence Normal. Leighton was named for William Leigh (near Tusculum's).

John Leigh Townes was a representative from Madison County to the Constitutional Assembly in 1819. He was also one of the representatives from Madison County to the Legislature in 1819. Mr. Townes was a leading figure in the Baptist Church in north Alabama and has an extensive write-up in Shackelford's "History of the Muscle Shoals Baptist Association."

A son, Eggleston D. Townes, was chancellor of the Northern District of Alabama from 1861-1873.

My grandmother, Martha Leigh Chenault, was the daughter of David Greenhill Leigh, another grandson of Elizabeth G. Leigh's and a first-cousin of John Leigh Townes.

Alumni Get Challenge From Chief

The leaders of the alumni of the University of Alabama are to challenge a broad vision of what the university has done and what it can do, Dr. David Mathews, president of the University of Alabama in Tuscaloosa told an alumni gathering Wednesday night at the Carriage Inn.

Mathews, the youngest major college president in the United States, said that the real burden of the alumni of "maintaining the institution as it meets the changes of today falls as heavily on the alumni as it does the institution."

Addressing several hundred alumni at the Carriage Inn, Mathews told them of ways that they could be proud of the university and of things that must be done if the institution is to survive in the changing world.

"You can take pride that the university is above the average as a teaching institution," Mathews said. He told the alumni that the university is "potentially" encouraged by the number of young family members that have been recruited in the last several years.

Mathews said that innovative programs at the main campus are indications that the university is moving forward. He told the alumni of a new honors course in computers that was started this year. "A math professor came to me and suggested that we begin a program in computers with undergraduate learning 'in great' computers," the professor said. "To speak computers in today's university may be like speaking Latin in a medieval university."

The program has not been expanded for another term, he added. The young president also told the group that they could be proud of the university's success in the state, he said that the programs of the university spread from the Gulf

Coast in Galveston in Houston and encompass all fields of work.

"There has been a reevaluation of serving the state with service programs and searching down to common level to help solve problems," he said. "We are living in a time when every profession is changing rapidly. People want more out of life. They want to think of more than just the day-to-day activities of life."

Mathews said that if the University of Alabama were to recognize its ambitious then it must have the people trained at the highest levels.

"We have enough people making the minimum wage and just beyond," said Mathews. "But we must have more people of the higher levels, at the PhD level." He said that of the 2,000 PhD's in the South last year, only 125 were from Alabama. "We cannot make

this academic imbalance in the state."

Mathews said that the whole of change that are sweeping across the campuses of the land will sweep also across the University of Alabama campus and that there is danger in the stilling of the people.
