Not only did these students write and study the meaning of good citizenship, but they put it in practice in the classroom, on the campus and in various activities. Learning by doing, was their slogan.

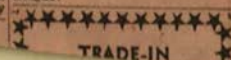
An outstanding unit class activity was the study of "Care and Kindness to Animals". Their affections were put in practice on "Pup", a dog belonging to Bobby
