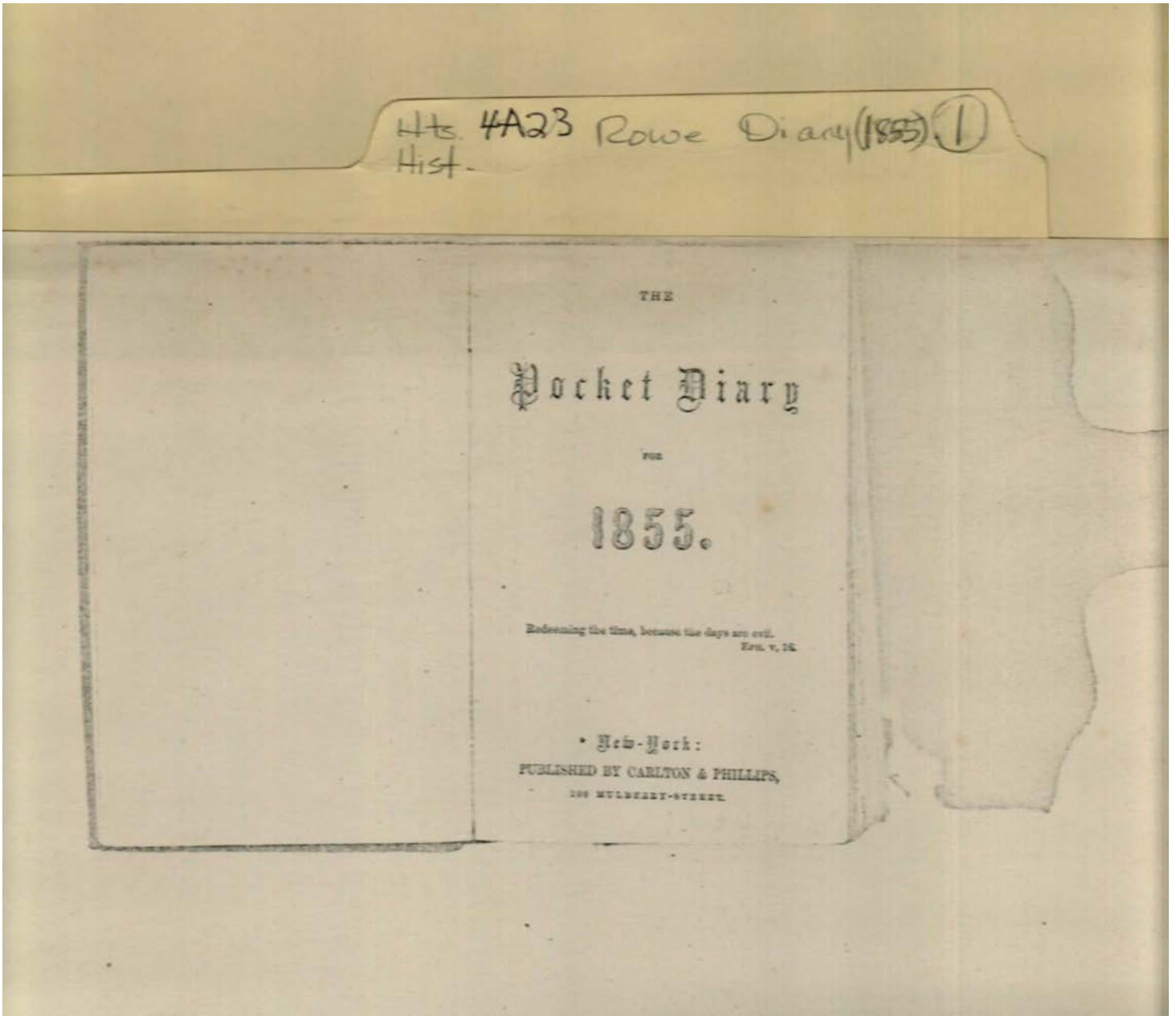

**APPROPRIATIONS FOR 1854.**—The General Missionary Committee, the Board of Managers, and the Synods, at a joint meeting, made the following appropriations for the service of the mission during the year 1854:

The appropriations for the Domestic missions amount to \$25,043; and for the Foreign Missions, \$79,021, making a total of \$104,064.  
**Domestic Missions:** for the English mission, under the care of the several annual conferences, \$12,750; Indian missions, \$1,200; German missions in the United States, \$4,510; Swedish, Norwegian, Welsh, and French missions in the United States, \$12,580; contingent for missions in the Chinese in California, \$1,000; anti-slavery expenses, \$312.  
**Foreign Missions:** for Liberia, \$21,337; China, \$12,000; Germany, \$10,000; France, in aid of the Methodist missions, \$5,000; Norway, etc., \$1,000; Russia Agent, \$1,000; to renew the mission in Madagascar, South America, \$1,000; to commence a mission in India, \$1,000; to commence a mission in the East, \$1,000.  
The contributions to the missionary treasury during the year 1853 amounted to \$103,427.
