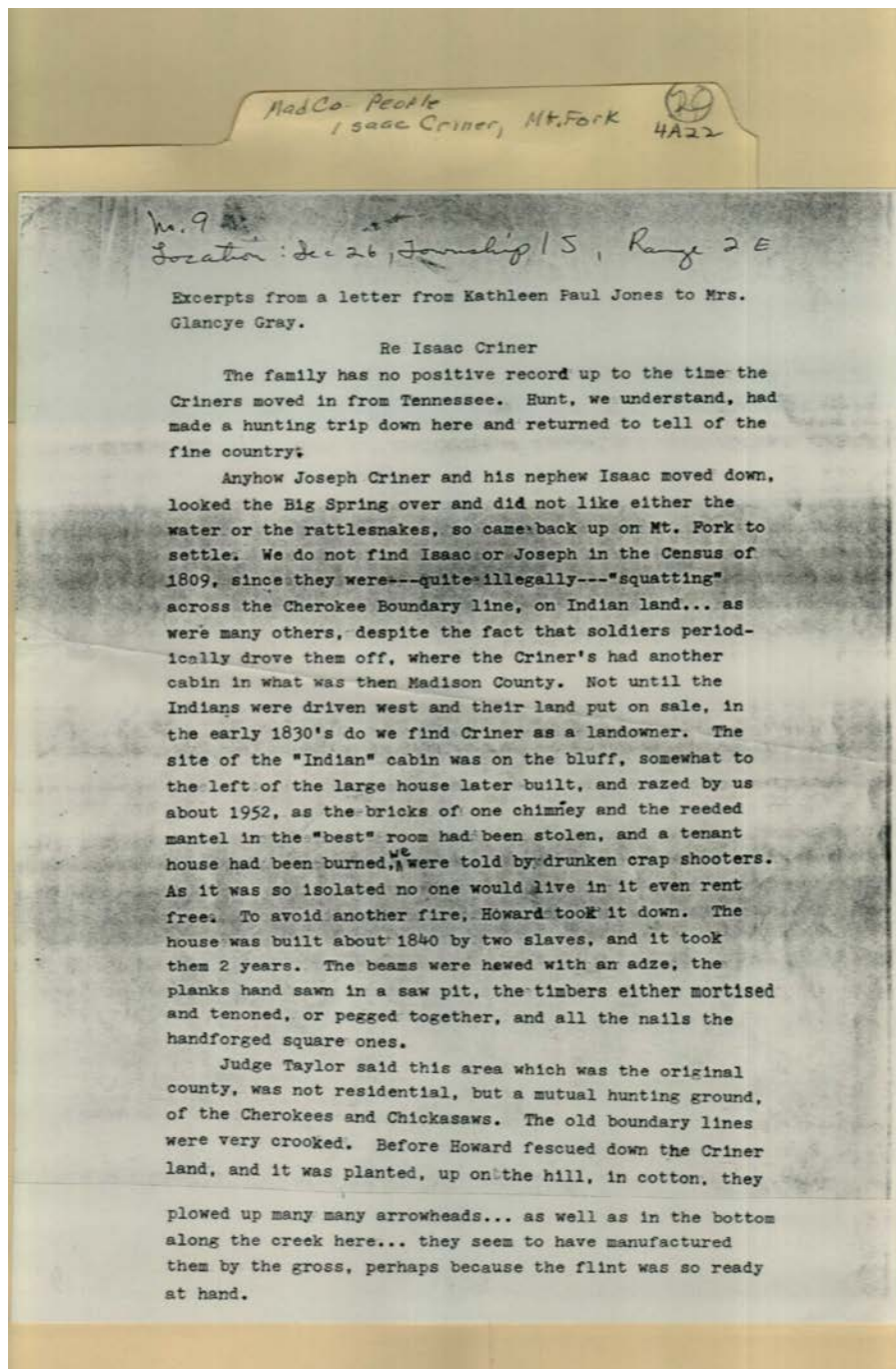

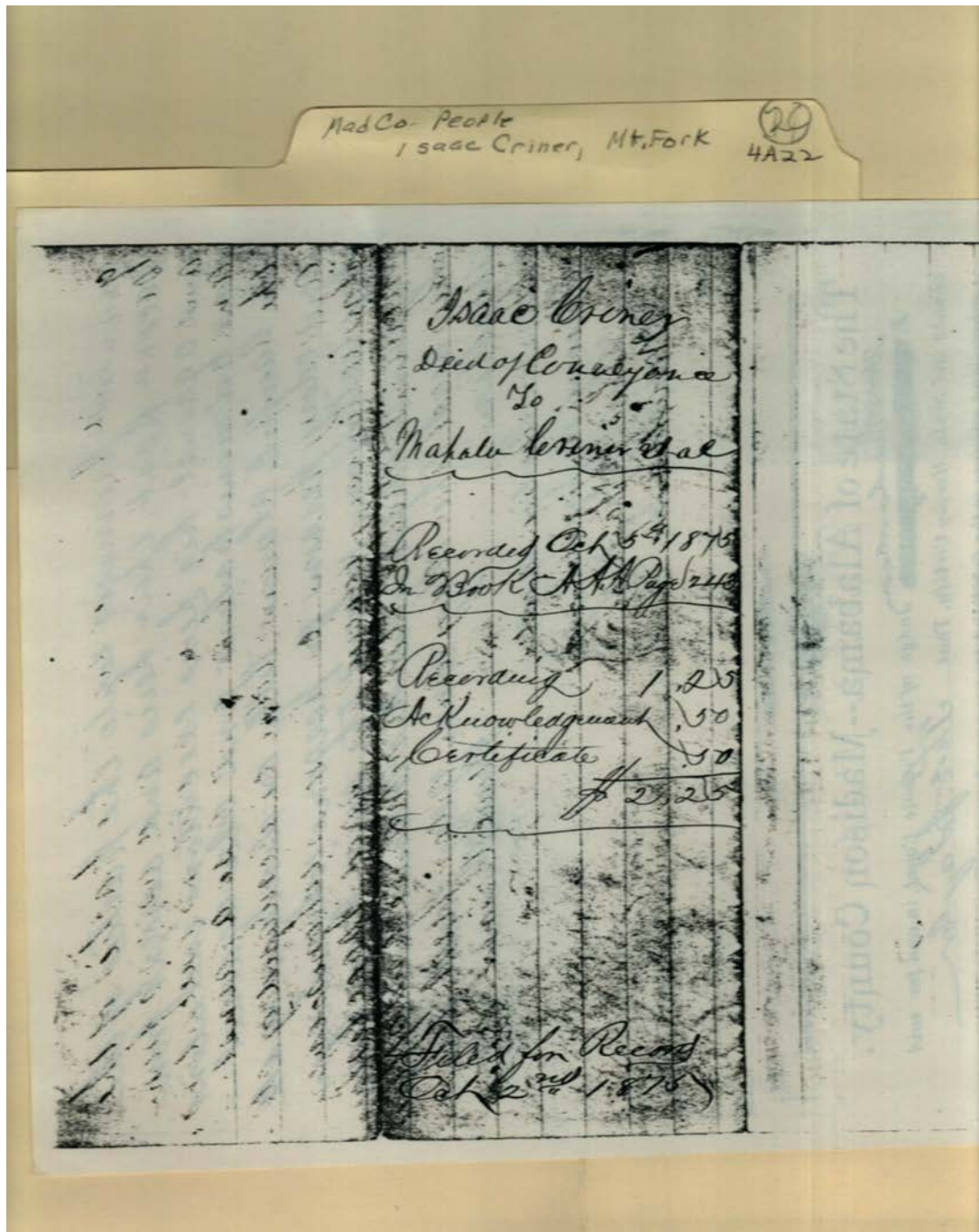

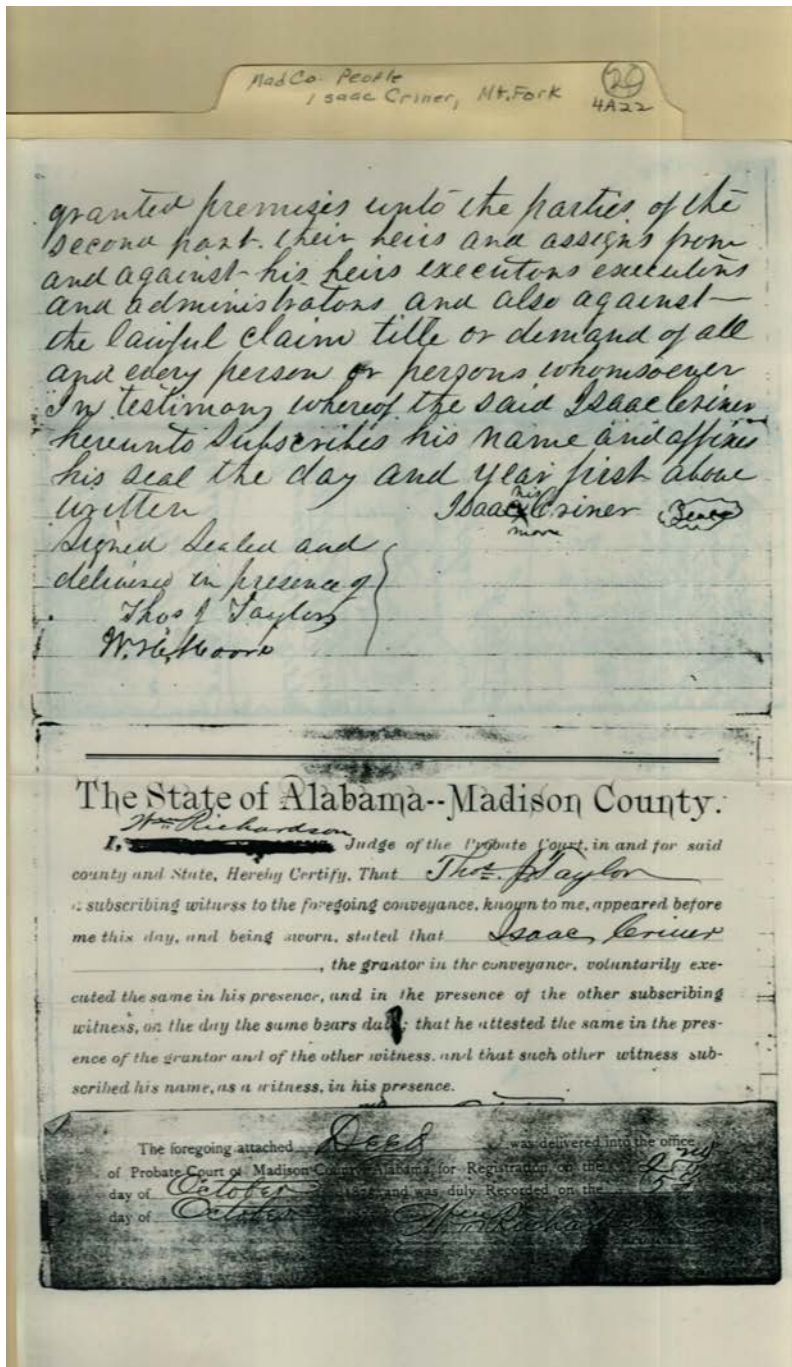

This Indenture made this the twenty second day of September in the year 1878 between Isaac Criner of the County of Madison State of Alabama of the one part and the parties hereinafter named of the County and State aforesaid of the other Witnesseth that whereas the said Isaac Criner is desirous that Mahala Criner and Almira Criner his daughter and Clara D. Moore Evalena Moore and Nancy E. Moore children of his daughter Martha Woodson Moore deceased shall have the place on which he lives and whereas in order that justice may be done the other heirs of said Isaac Criner. The said homestead has been valued by a distinguished party which valuation has been fixed at thirty five hundred dollars. Now therefore in consideration of the premises and with the express understanding that the parties above named shall be charged in the distribution of his estate among his heirs at law each with their proportion of value of said homestead as above mentioned, I hereby give grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said Mahala Criner an undivided third interest unto the said Almira Criner an undivided

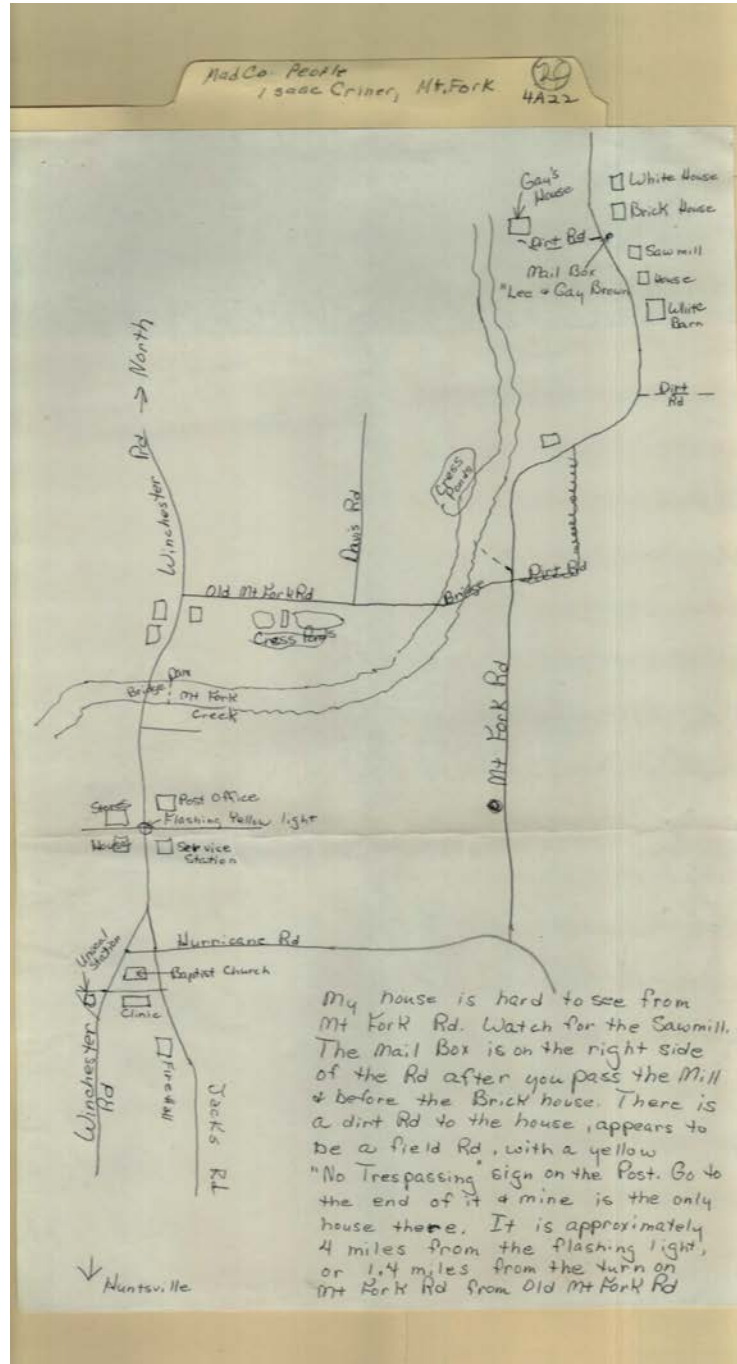

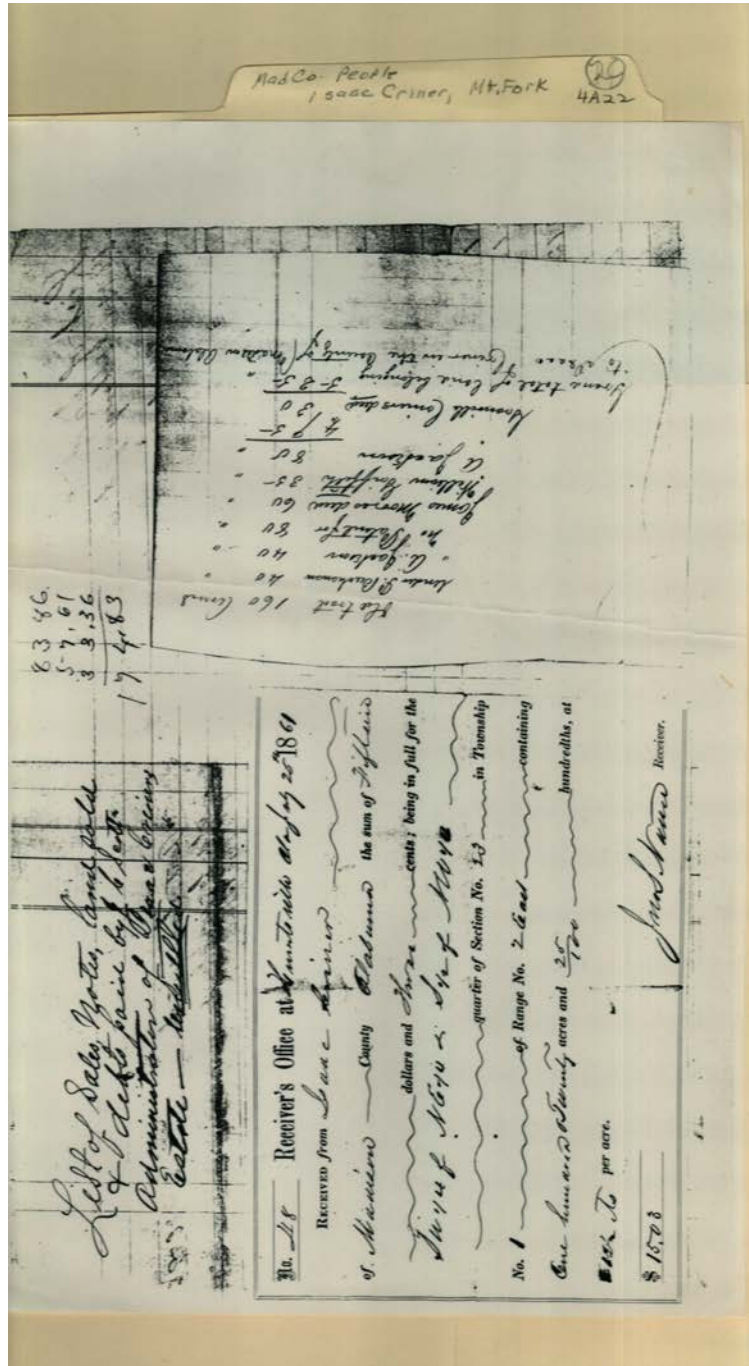
