Phil Anderson, son of Edward Anderson and Lincoln graduate from the class of 1951 gives us the following comment on life at Lincoln School:

Patriotism and acceptance of Civic responsibilities were an integral part of the educational process at Lincoln and this was especially evident during World War II. Many graduates served in the Armed Forces. Drives were conducted for collection of materials in short supply such as paper and tin. The Boy Scouts were also very active in this. Emphasis was also given to the U.S. Savings Bond program and purchase of savings stamps. Assembly programs for the school body were held several times a week. Patriotism was not forgotten in these and no student could have left Lincoln without knowing the song "You are a Grand Old Flag" or "America". Miss Georgette Graham was the music teacher at this time.

The school was consistently one of the leaders in the area in contributing to the American Red Cross..

Graduates of school have chosen varied careers including law, science, education, religion and Business. In recent years graduates of Lincoln High School have served in such positions as President of the City Council (Kenneth Johnson), President of the Huntsville Chamber of Commerce (Ray Pearman), and U. S. Attorney for North Alabama (Macon Weaver).

Mr. E. G. Maples became Lincoln's third principal and held this position from 1944-46. Mr. Maples was succeeded by Mr. Hammond Carpenter, 1946-48, and Mr. Elmon H. Brown, 1948-52. As indicated, Mr. Anderson returned to Lincoln and was principal 1952-55.

When Mr. Anderson returned in 1952, the school had become a junior high. Lincoln's last senior class was the class of '51. Grades 10, 11, and 12 were consolidated as part of the new Butler High School for the 1951-52 school year. Lincoln remained with grades 1-9 until 1960. The 1959-60 school year saw the last junior high class, as students from both Lincoln and Rison Jr. High were zoned to Lee Junior High School.

In 1918 William Lincoln Barrell of Lowell Mass. purchased Abingdon Mill and transformed it into a large textile center of all concrete construction named Lincoln Mill Village. Phillip Peeler served as an ^{its} outstanding superintendent from 1934-1953.

Built in 1929 this school ^{became} served as the central core of community life until 1956 when Lincoln Village was annexed to the city of Huntsville. Edward W. Anderson served as its principal for 27 years. Many of its graduates became local and state leaders.

The mill stopped operation in 1957 and burned in 1980.

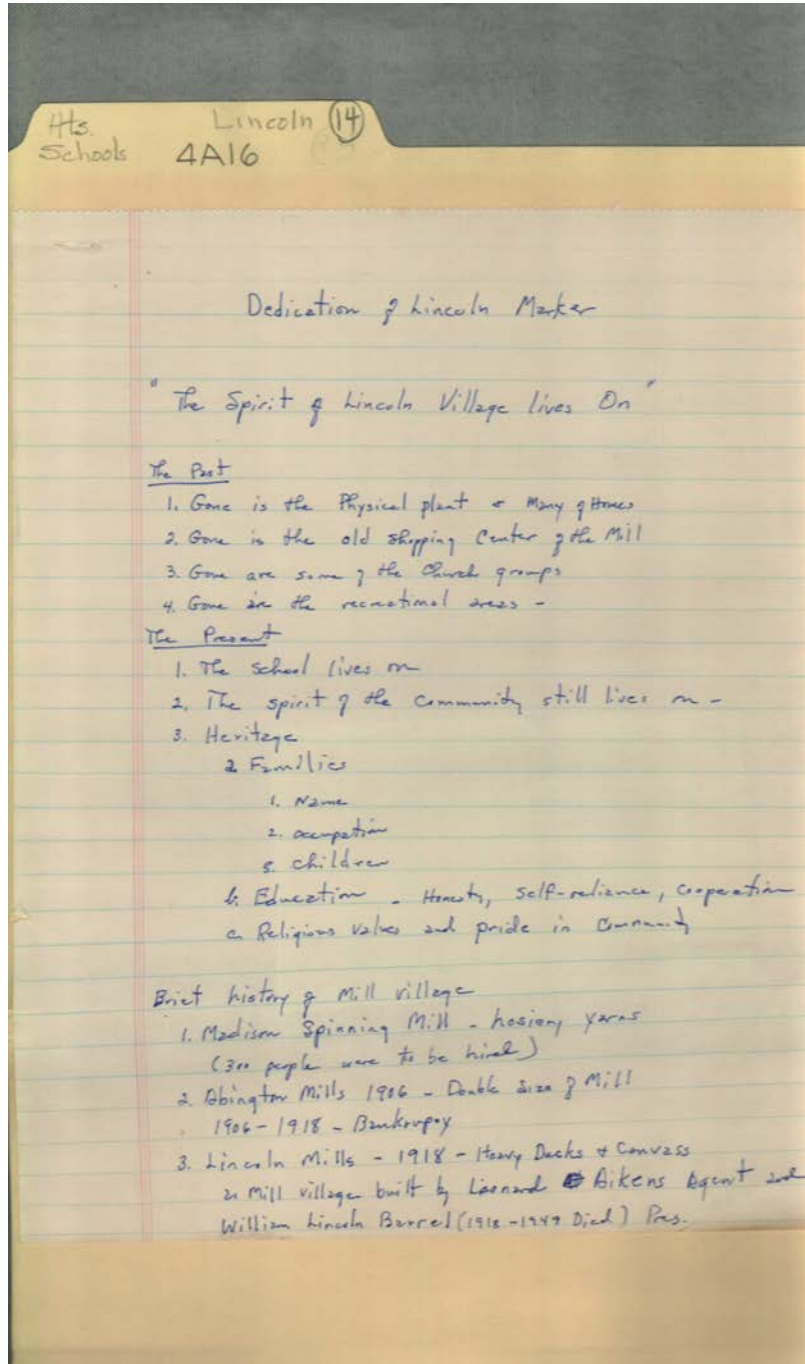

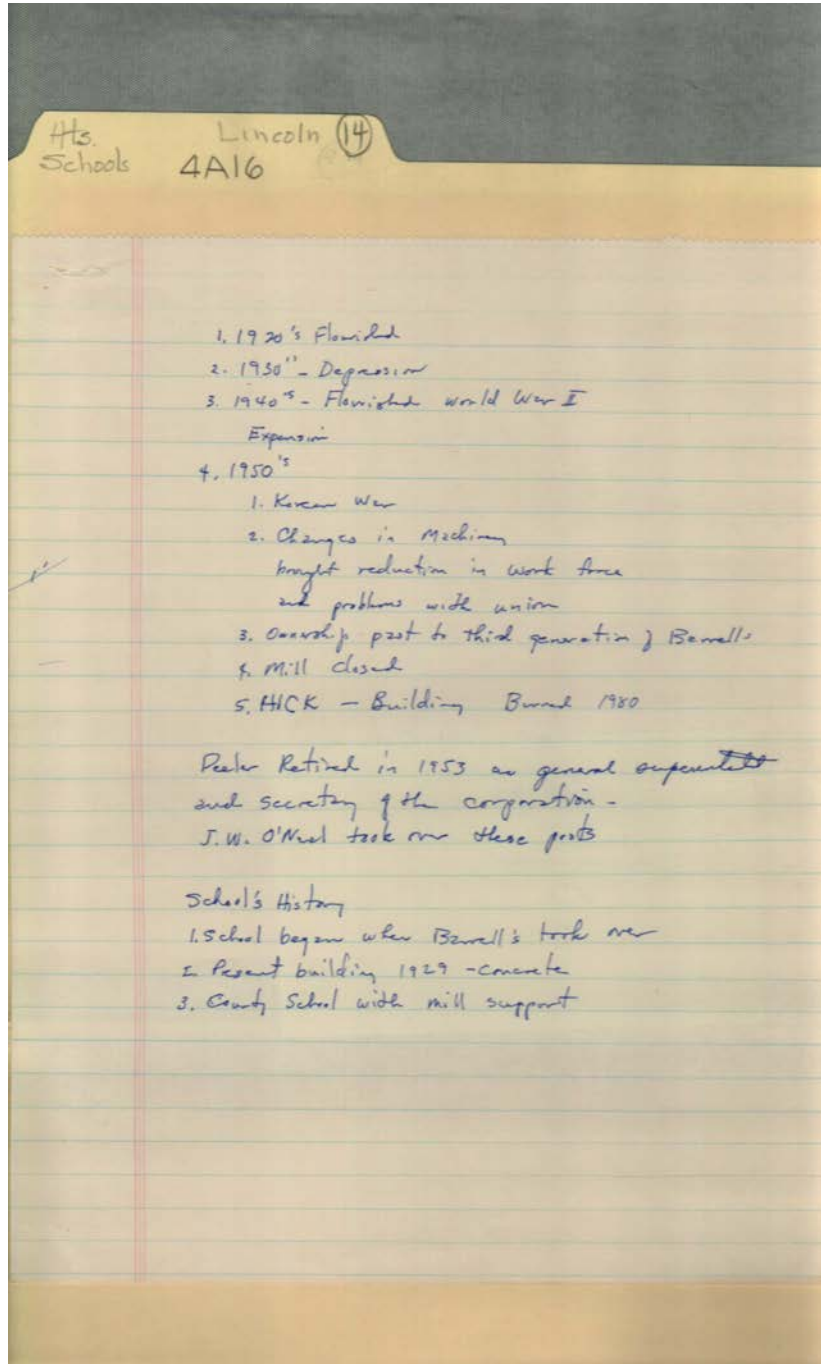
