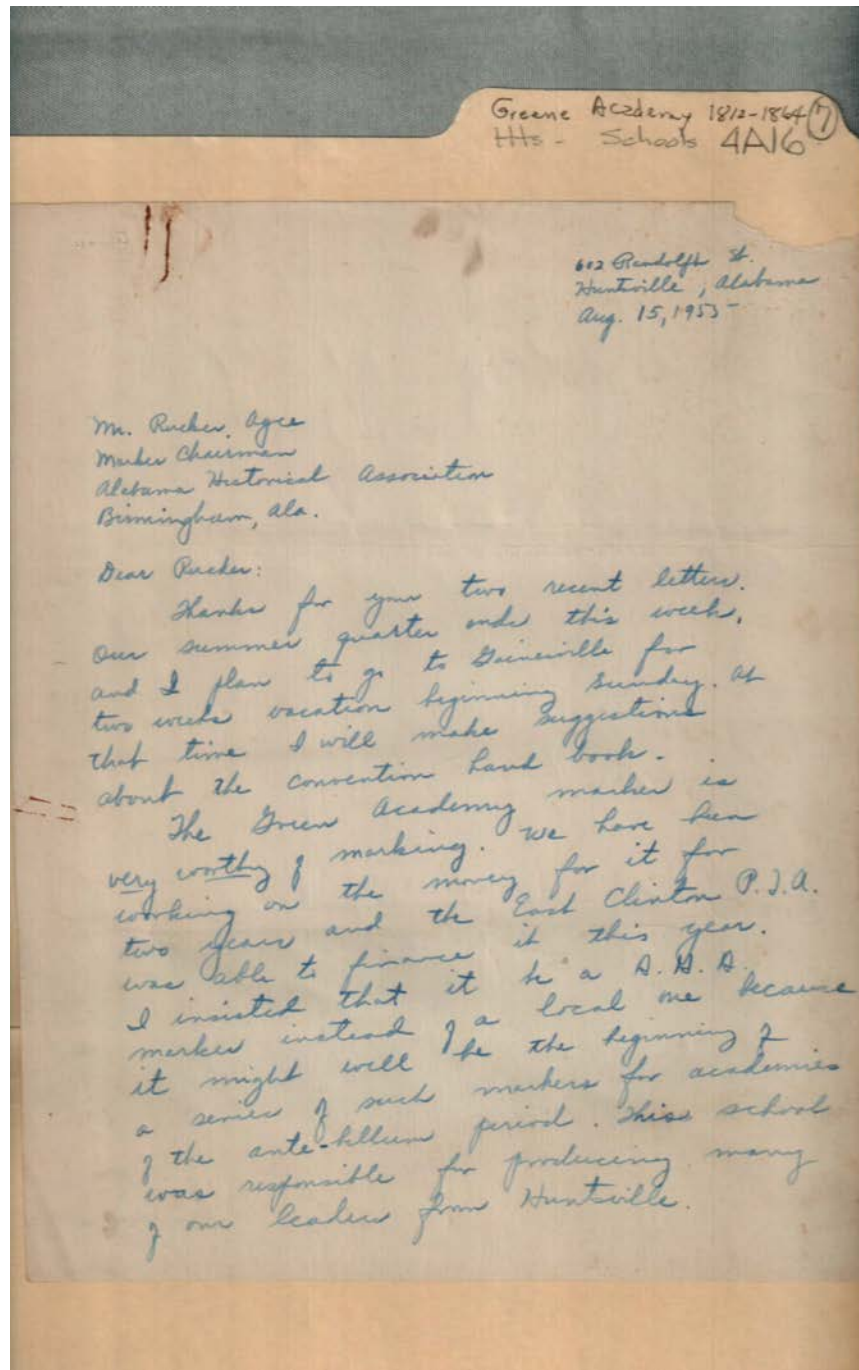

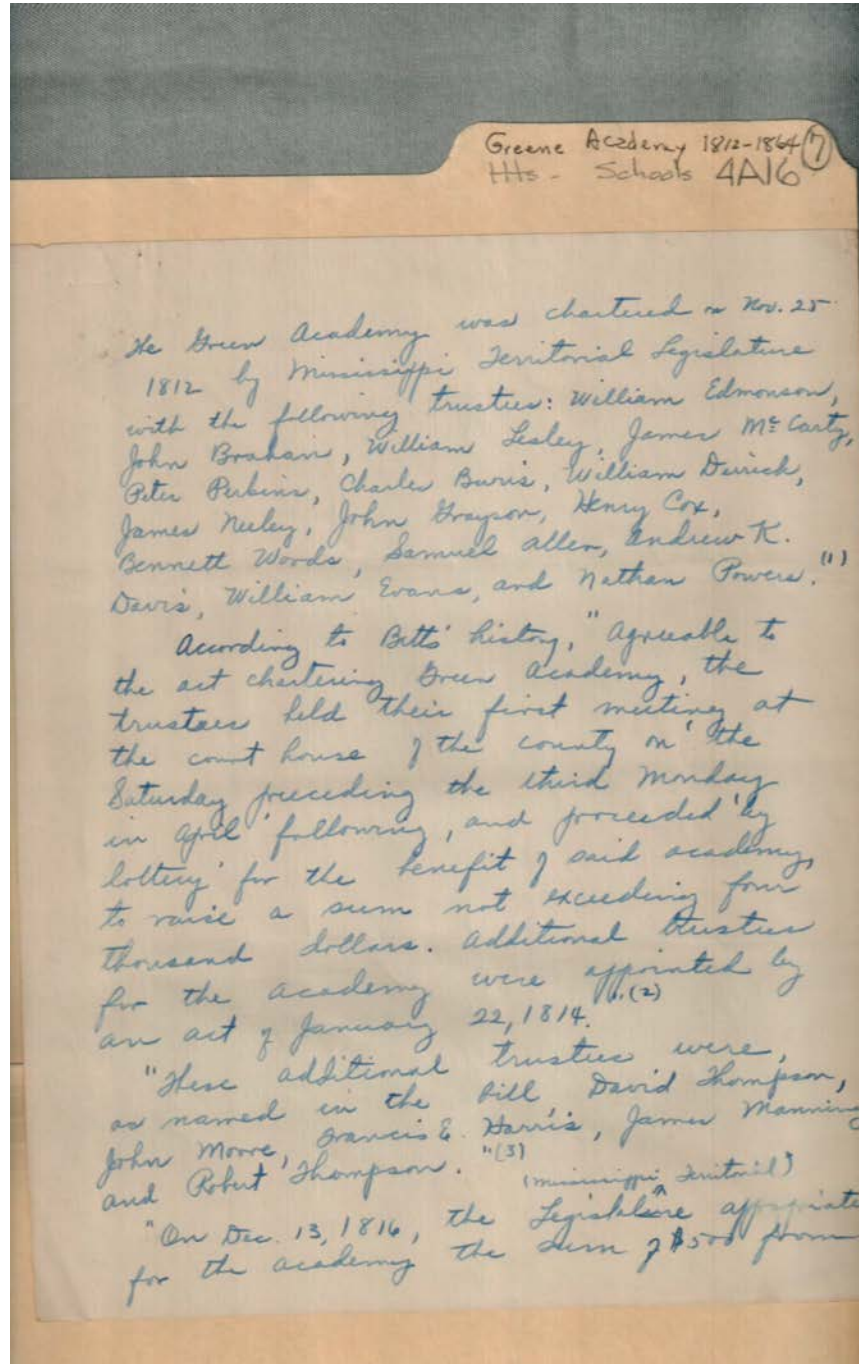

the funds of the Territorial Treasury. This, and the other moneys raised by lottery for the construction of academy buildings, remained unemployed for some time; the business of housing the institution not being completed till 1819, presumably from a lack of adequate funds." (A)

"The aid necessary for the erection of buildings was provided by the ^{Provisional} Territorial Legislature, by act of Nov. 21, 1818 whereby the "Planters and Merchants' Bank at Huntsville was authorized to increase its capital stock, and sell at public auction shares of the same, ninety per cent of the profits or excess arising from such sales to come to the benefit of the Academy. By the same act, Lemuel Mead, Henry Chambers, Henry Minor, John M. Taylor, Clement C. Clay, and John Williams Walker were designated as additional trustees." (B)

other moneys on hand, was employed - after a brief time - in the construction of academy buildings, on the lot now occupied by the city school of Huntsville, on the northeast corner, at the intersection of East Clinton and Calhoun Streets. "(6)"

"Though without buildings of its own during these years, Green Academy had been doing good work in the field of education. For a long number of years it was the only institution affording advanced education, in the northern part of the State. Here most of the prominent men in this part of the country were trained. It was virtually without competition and had no peer in its field of service till the State University was established and was well under way." (7)
