SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT

The Huntsville city school system expects to expand more in 1959 than it did in 1958, and this will mean adding more than one extra classroom a week.

Dr. Raymond L. Christian, school superintendent, said that despite a rapid building program, the system had not been able to keep pace with enrollment increase demands.

By the time the year ended, enrollment was up to 13,177. The total in 1956 was 5,200, showing a growth of around 3,000 pupils a year.

The board of education offices now are housed in a modern, new \$71,000 administration building.

Money is the main need, Dr. Christian points out. During the coming year, he hopes to complete a new elementary school, for which ground is already broken on Monte Sano, and make additions to five schools which will amount to more than 60 new classrooms, four lunchrooms and space for related facilities.

A 10-classroom modern school at Whitesburg opened shortly after the first of the year.

To meet the demands of expanding Huntsville, the city system added 109 classrooms during the year in new schools and expansion of existing facilities. However, three old schools were abandoned, giving a net classroom gain of 77.

As an idea of the growth of the system since 1956, the teacher total now is 440 compared with 180 then, and the number of schools jumped from nine to 18.

"Despite this growth," said Dr. Christian, "we have no double sessions."
