Let us go to the highest official authority for this information. From the reports of the census of 1890, we may learn the average value per acre of farm products in all the States. The figures compiled by the census statisticians were for 1889. The average for the whole country and for the different sections were as follows: 6 76 7 18 And with the increased price of cotton this ratio becomes much larger in favor of the South. What do you think of that? The average annual value of farm products in the South is greater than the average of all the rest of the country, greater than the average of all the great agricultural States of the Central West, greater than the average of the expensively maintained irrigated farms, orchards and gardens of the far West, and surpassed only by the average of the enormously rich and populous Eastern and New England States, where agriculture has its highest development. FARM LAND STILL ADVANCING Farm lands in the United States have risen in value more than 38 per cent since 1900. This is the average rise for the whole country. In the South Central States the increase has been 40%, in the Western States 40%, in the South Atlantic States 36% and in the North Atlantic States 13%.
