MONTE SANO

is 1,100 feet higher than Huntsville and there is a difference in temperature of between five and ten degrees. On it is located a large hotel that cost \$150,000. Besides the hotel there are many summer houses, some of them of sandstone, and many of them quite pretentious dwellings. We expect to have the electric cars to the top of the mountain by next summer, and confidently believe we will have a summer resort second to none in the South when it becomes better known. High altitude, cool, invigorating atmosphere, pure water, beautiful scenery, shady walks, beautiful drives, are the advantages it offers. There are six miles of good drives on top of the mountain.

The following beautiful tribute to Monte Sano, was taken from a series of letters, descriptive of Huntsville and Madison County, written by Hon. Wendell C. Warner of Yorkshire, N. Y., and published in the Wyoming County Herald at Arcade, N. Y., some years ago:

"No wonder that a few hours spent in driving up and down the beautiful streets of Huntsville made me fall in love with the pretty southern city. And standing over it, keeping eternal watch, is Monte Sano, the last of the Cumberland Mountains, the silent peak lifting its head 1,100 feet above the valley. It forever points to the long range of mountains extending in dark, tumbled masses to the southern boundary of New York. From its highest height there is a beautiful view of lower peaks with fertile sweeps of snowy cotton fields and waving seas of corn. Here and there a little hamlet hides under the trees. Down below the hot breath of summer may sweep the land, but on Monte Sano the breezes forever pass by on cool wings. It has watched the comedy of peace and the tragedy of war, and holds untold secrets in its deep, rocky bosom."

MADISON COUNTY

The Banner Agricultural County of the State. The eastern part of the County is hilly with rich stretches of valley; the middle is rolling, and the western part is almost level or slightly rolling. Most of the soil is red clay loam with red clay subsoil, the formation known as Hagerstown Clay Loam, which is one of the most productive soils found anywhere. This red clay extends from a depth of ten to forty feet, but sometimes a loose chert stone formation is found.
