The design of the Bibb Chapel continued the English Gothic tradition as requested by the vestry. Although church records do not indicate who the architect was, its design is modeled after St. James-the-Less in Philadelphia which was the work of architect Richard Upjohn, a member of the Ecclesiological movement in the United States.

The interior space, containing one large rectangular room, reflects exactly the exterior forms of the chapel. The roof is framed with large spread timbers in a hammer-beam truss arrangement similar to

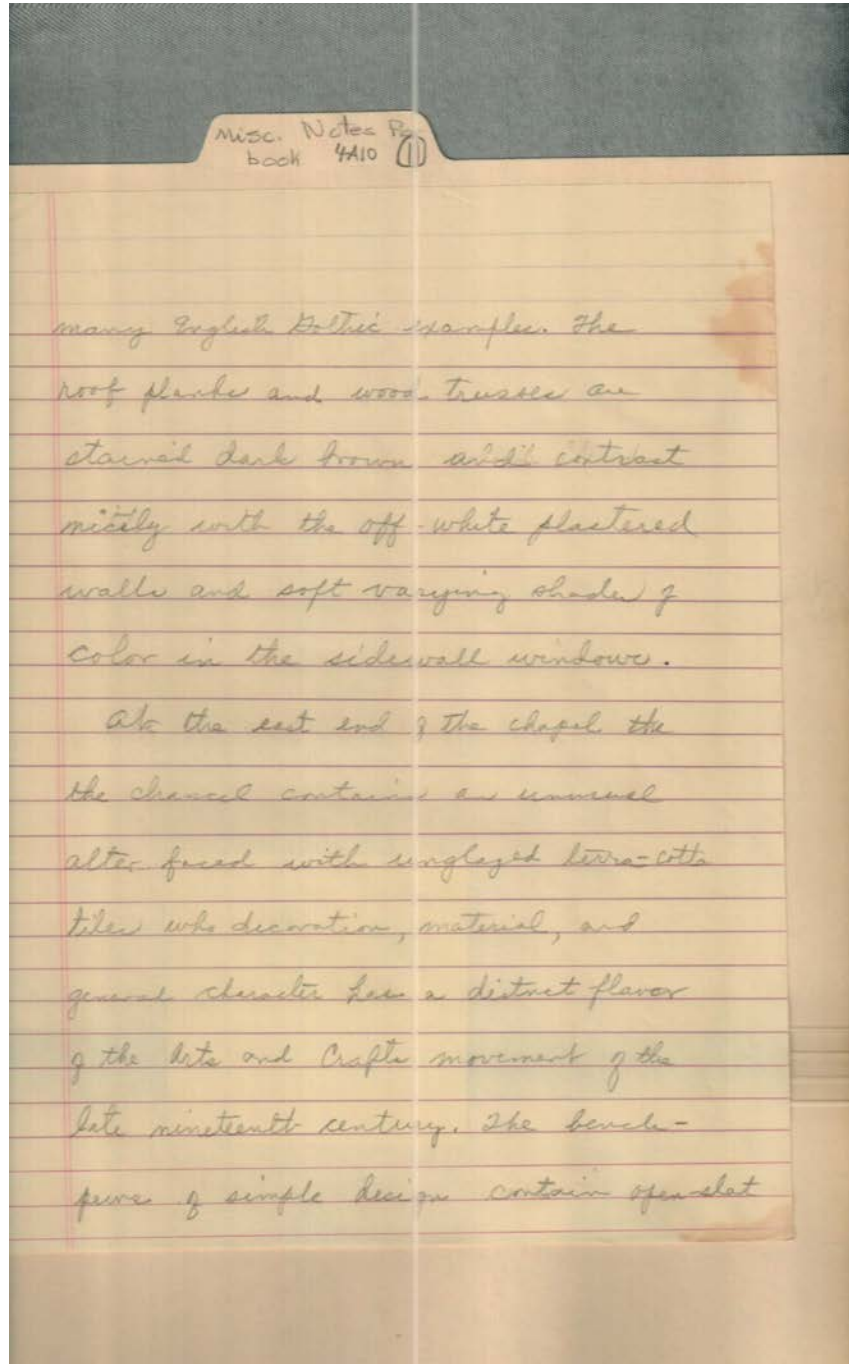

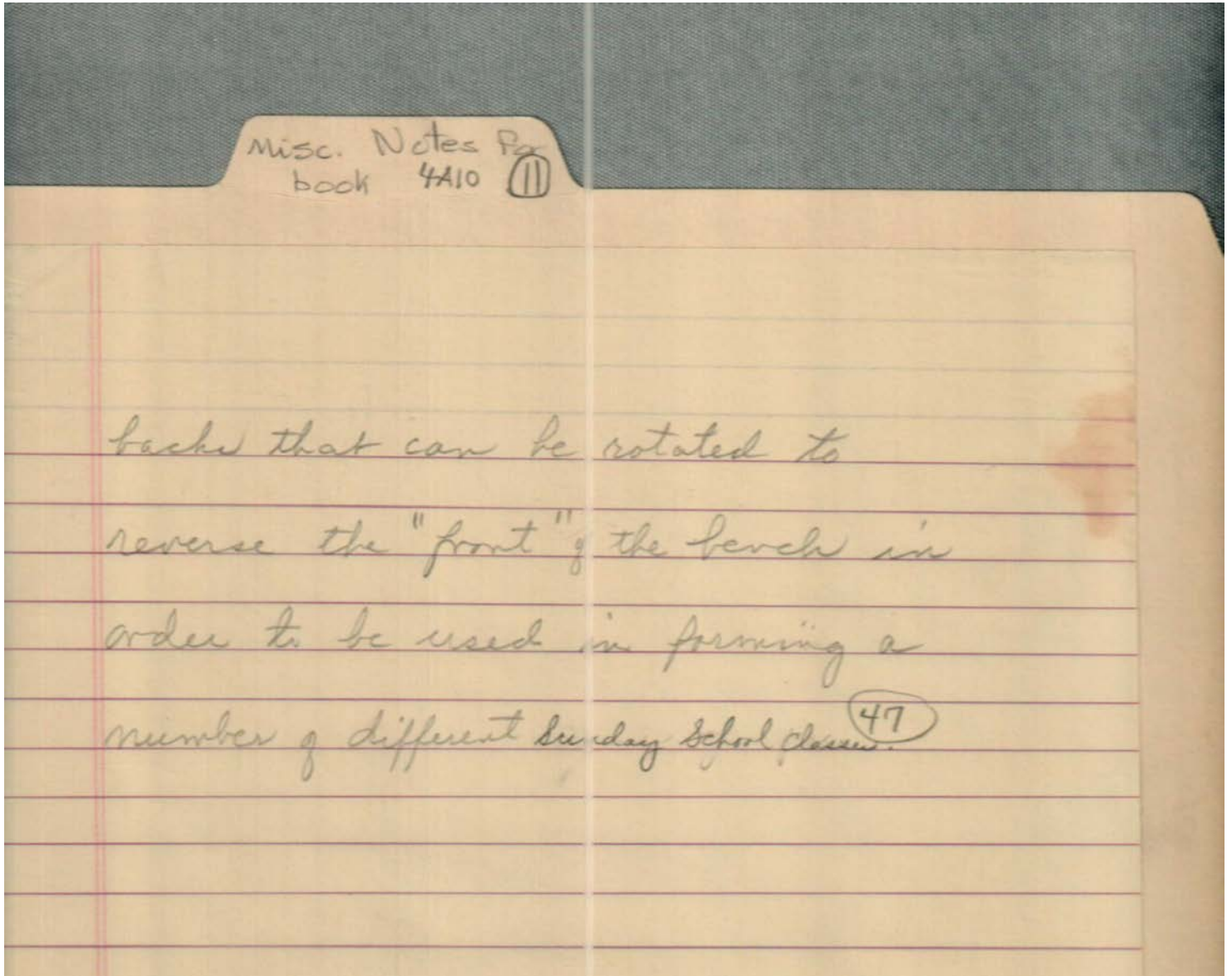

Jewish Reform Church. From this small beginning  
the Huntsville Hospital grew to maturity  
in the twentieth century. Through the  
years the Church of the Nativity continued  
to support and render services to the

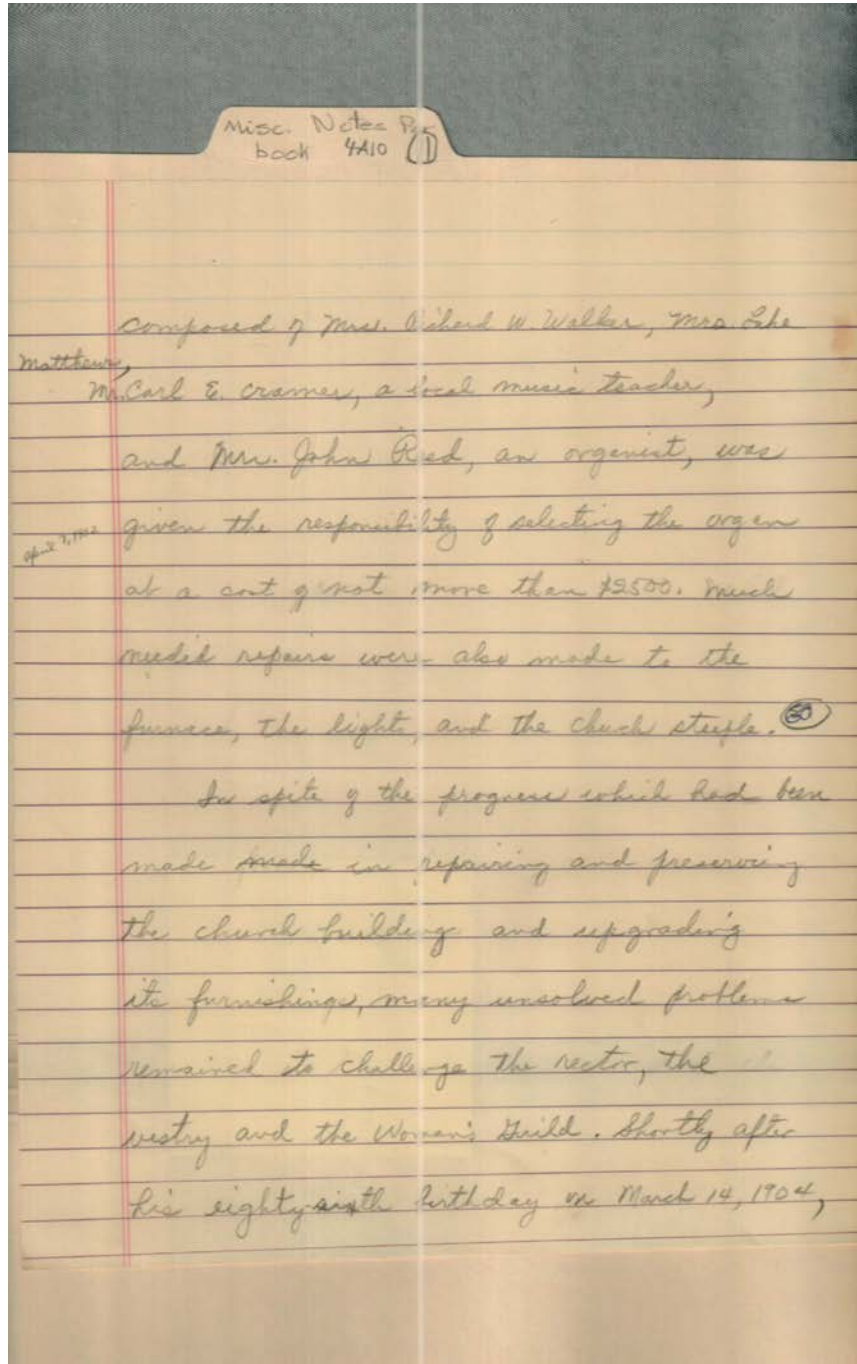

Banister requested that the vestry employ an assistant minister to aid him in performing the various duties required of the rector of the Church of the Nativity. <sup>(61)</sup>

Even at his advanced age he was still able to conduct the services on Sunday, but it was difficult for him to travel to Scottsboro and other congregations in the area. Since the death of Mrs. Banister, the position of church organist had not been filled on a satisfactory basis, and there was some dissatisfaction among members of the choir. funds to meet the vestry's <sup>annual</sup> obligations

assistant rector. Since the possibility of raising enough money to pay two full salaries, the vestry asked Barister if he would be willing to have his salary reduced from \$1300 a year to \$600 in order to be able to pay Claybrook the \$1200 which he

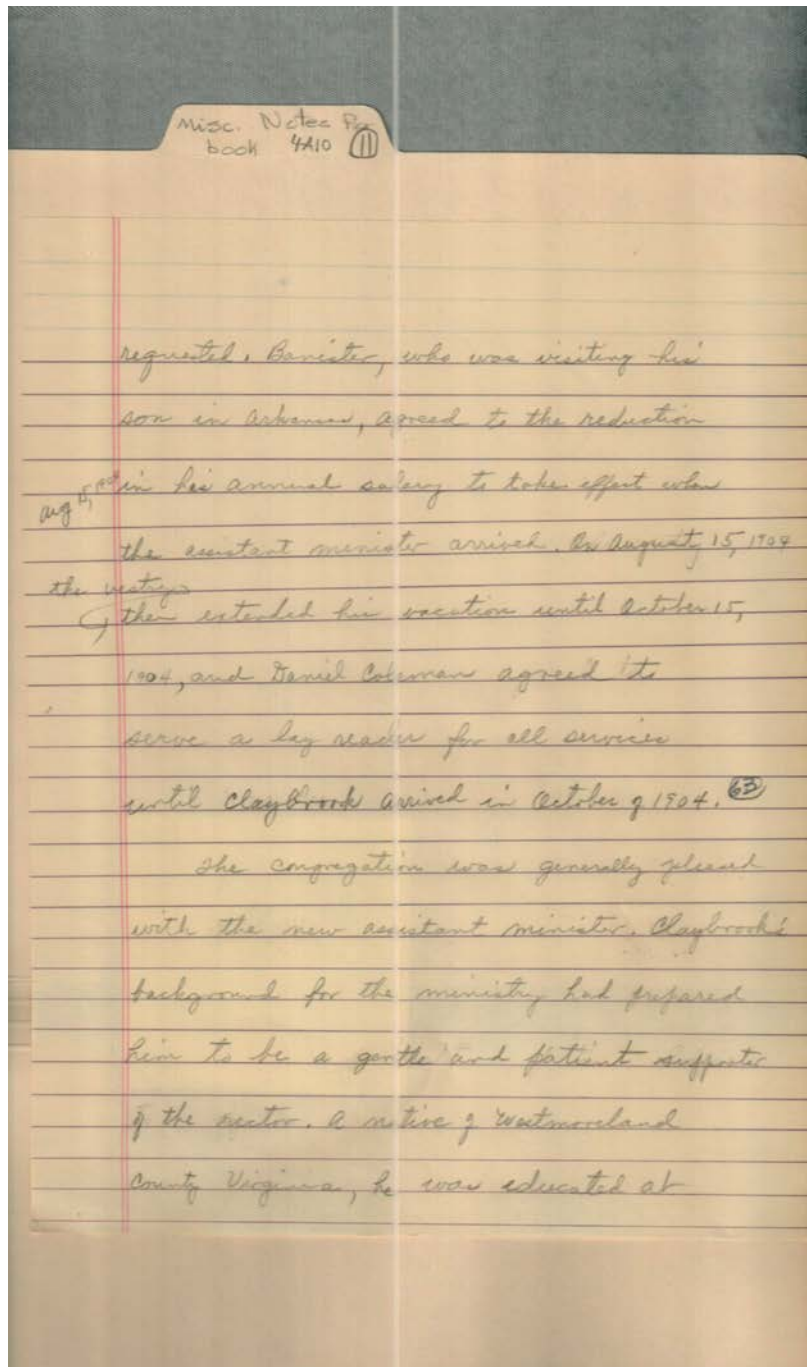

In response to this letter of resignation  
the vestry voted to make Banister rector  
Emeritus and to award him all the  
back pay due at the time of his retirement.  
Members of the vestry signed a note at  
the First National Bank to make this  
payment possible. They then voted to name  
Claybrook the full time rector with  
a salary of \$4500 to begin January 1, 1906 and  
to pay an annual stipend of \$300 <sup>to Banister</sup> beginning  
on the date of his retirement August 5, 1905. (6)
