THE CHURCH SCHOOL REPORT

The Church School program continued its activities with much vigor during the year 1958. We held a series of intensive teacher training meetings in August and September and our staff teachers responded most favorably this year in the Fall. The formation of St. Thomas' Mission affected both our teaching staff and a large number of pupils enrolled in Church School. We still have some vacancies to be filled among our teachers after the transfer of ten to the Mission. The figures given below will reflect the status of the Church School. Our present enrollment is 254 pupils, ages three years through the twelfth grade. Our officers and teachers number 41, including teachers for the three adult groups. There is an average attendance of about 45 adults in these classes. Average attendance remains about 185 pupils, while attendance at the Family Service is some 150.

Activities for the year included giving to local needy families at Thanksgiving and Christmas, the Easter and Christmas Festivals, and our support of Mission work through the Mite Box Offering at Easter. We have provided class room space for a Special Class for handicapped children under the supervision of the Huntsville Ministerial Association.

Perhaps our greatest need is for parents and adults in the Parish to realize that the Church School is their job too. Our teachers have done an excellent job, but cooperation from the home is essential.

Missionary Report. August 1835

From Bishop Otey Communication.

May 5th 1835. In a letter addressed to you a few days ago from Elkton, I indicated an intention to give you some account of my visit to Huntsville, Alabama, as soon as I shall return home. I cannot I believe, better fulfil that intention than by giving you an extract from a private journal I kept of my proceedings.

Friday the 2nd April, left Elkton in the stage for Huntsville, at which place I arrived by night Saturday 25th. Sent for the Rev Mr Robertson, the Episcopal minister, this morning, who resides at a short distance from town. From Mr. R. I learned that he had the preceding evening, reached home after an absence of several weeks and had not therefore received the notification of my intended visit. In consequence all of our arrangements and notice for service had still to be made. The Presbyterian house for worship was obligingly tendered to our use by the Rev Mr Allen for Sunday and we accordingly gave notice that our services would be conducted at that place.

Sunday 26th. Prayers were read by the Rev. Mr Robertson in the morning, afternoon and <sup>at</sup> night, on each of which occasions I preached to large and attentive congregations. In the morning I baptized the

the infant child of Mr. Robertson, and at night confirmed one person. There were I understand some other persons desirous of confirmation were prevented by sickness, and by absence from town (not having been informed of my coming) from availing themselves of this opportunity. The Rev. M. R. in the employ of the Domestic and Foreign Missionary Society, has been laboring here for some time past under many discouragements not the least of which is the want of a suitable place for conducting the public worship of Almighty God. He has at one time to occupy the Theater and at another the Masonic Hall; thus having to struggle with the reasonable and unreasonable prejudices which many have in worshipping in such places.

Monday 21<sup>th</sup> Today I availed myself of an opportunity which presented itself of urging of some of the citizens the propriety of making an effort to build an Episcopal Church in Huntsville. I was happy to find that the proposition was listened to with favor, and attention especially by Judge Smith and Doctor Samuel Breck to whose ready and liberal cooperation in forwarding the undertaking will owe many thanks. 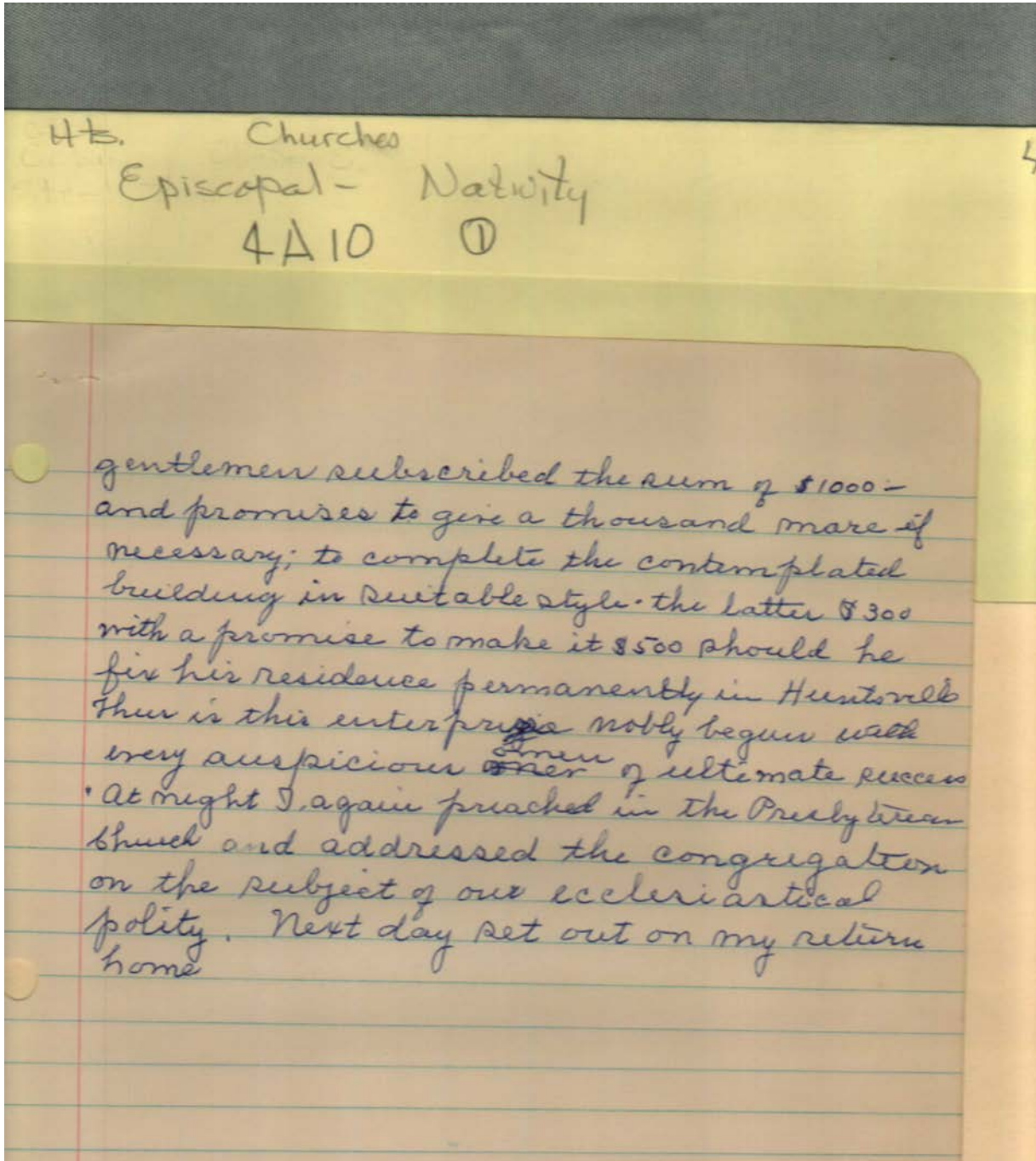

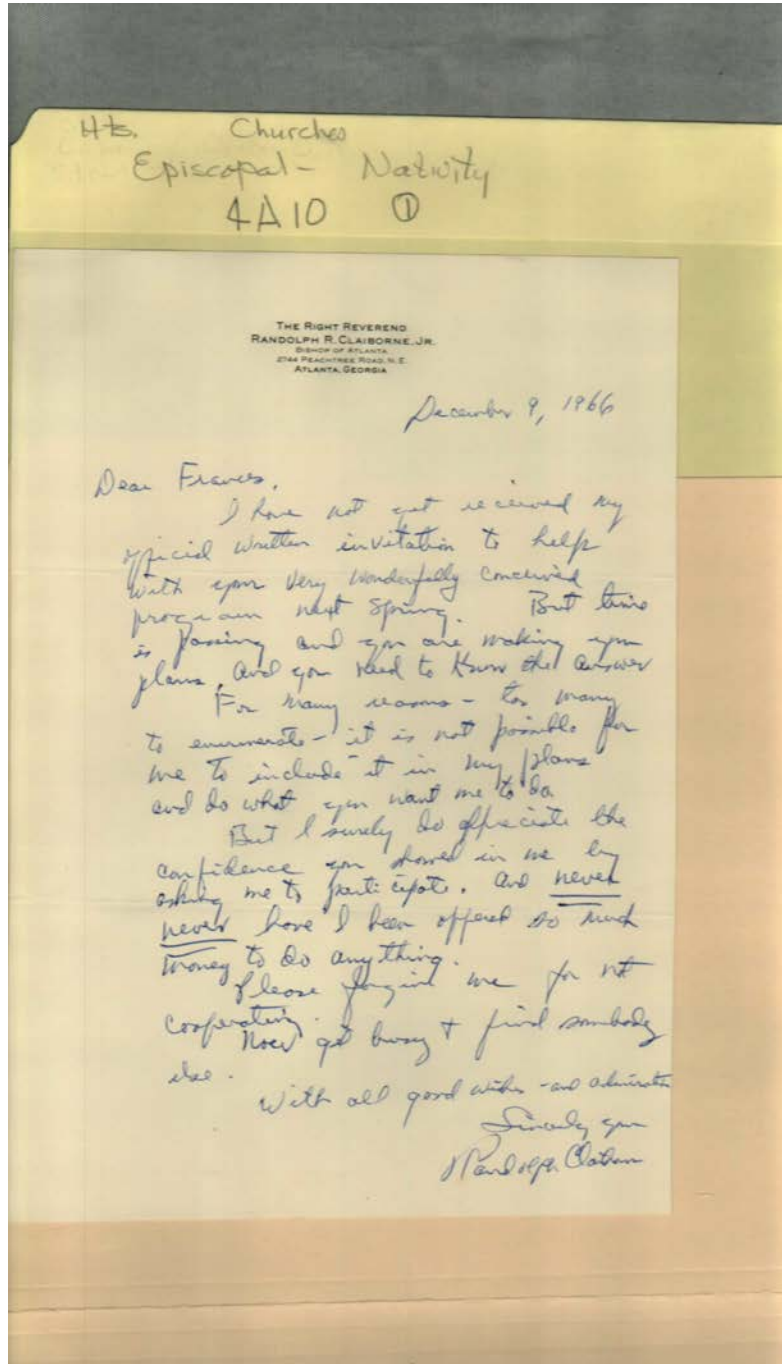

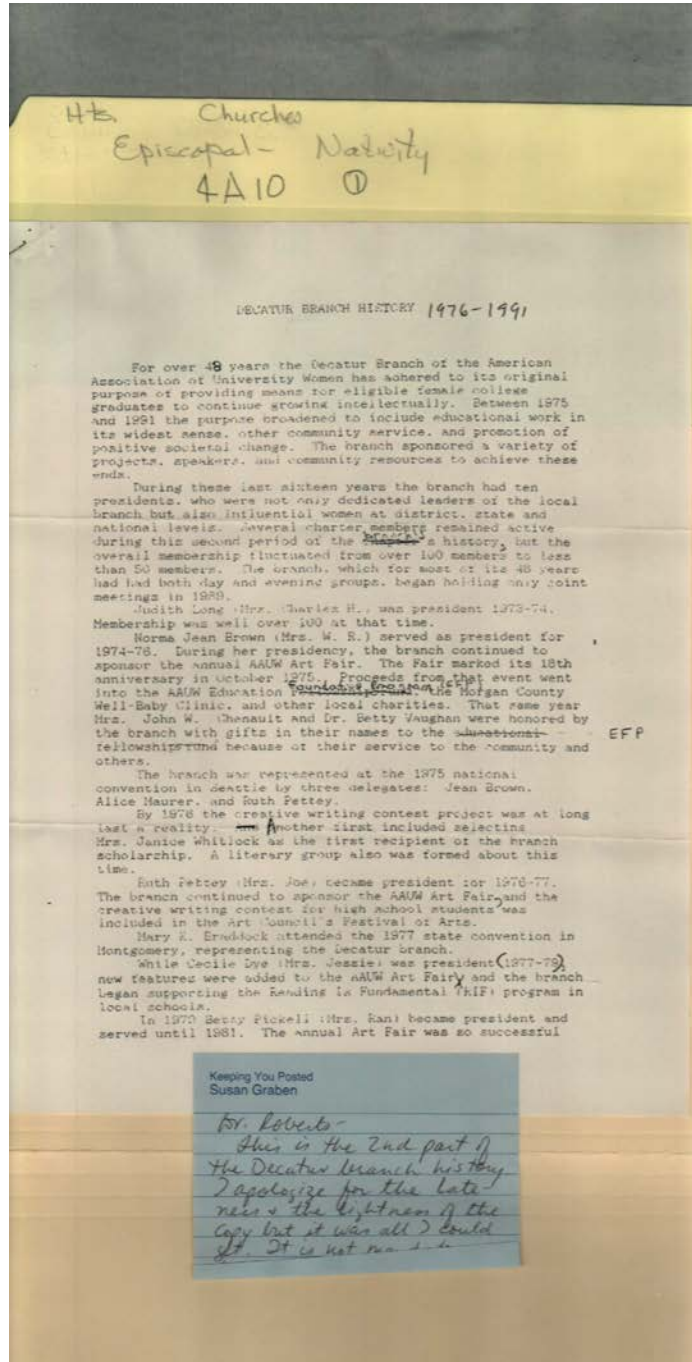

DECATUR BRANCH HISTORY 1976-1991

For over 48 years the Decatur Branch of the American Association of University Women has adhered to its original purpose of providing means for eligible female college graduates to continue growing intellectually. Between 1975 and 1991 the purpose broadened to include educational work in its widest sense, other community service, and promotion of positive societal change. The branch sponsored a variety of projects, speakers, and community resources to achieve these ends.

During these last sixteen years the branch had ten presidents, who were not only dedicated leaders of the local branch but also influential women at district, state and national levels. Several charter members remained active during this second period of the branch's history, but the overall membership fluctuated from over 100 members to less than 50 members. The branch, which for most of its 48 years had had both day and evening groups, began holding only joint meetings in 1980.

Judith Long (Mrs. Charles H.) was president 1973-74. Membership was well over 100 at that time.

Norma Jean Brown (Mrs. W. E.) served as president for 1974-78. During her presidency, the branch continued to sponsor the annual AAUW Art Fair. The Fair marked its 18th anniversary in October 1975. Proceeds from that event went into the AAUW Education Foundation, located at the Morgan County Well-Baby Clinic, and other local charities. That same year Mrs. John W. Chenault and Dr. Betty Vaughan were honored by the branch with gifts in their names to the same-scholarship-fellowship fund because of their service to the community and others.

EFP

The branch was represented at the 1975 national convention in Seattle by three delegates: Jean Brown, Alice Maurer, and Ruth Pettey.

By 1978 the creative writing contest project was at long last a reality. Mrs. Janice Whitlock as the first recipient of the branch scholarship. A literary group also was formed about this time.

Ruth Pettey (Mrs. Joe) became president for 1976-77. The branch continued to sponsor the AAUW Art Fair, and the creative writing contest for high school students was included in the Art Council's Festival of Arts.

Mary E. Eraddock attended the 1977 state convention in Montgomery, representing the Decatur branch.

While Cecile Dye (Mrs. Jessie) was president (1977-79), new features were added to the AAUW Art Fair and the branch began supporting the Reading is Fundamental (RIF) program in local schools.

In 1979 Betty Pickell (Mrs. Ran) became president and served until 1981. The Annual Art Fair was so successful

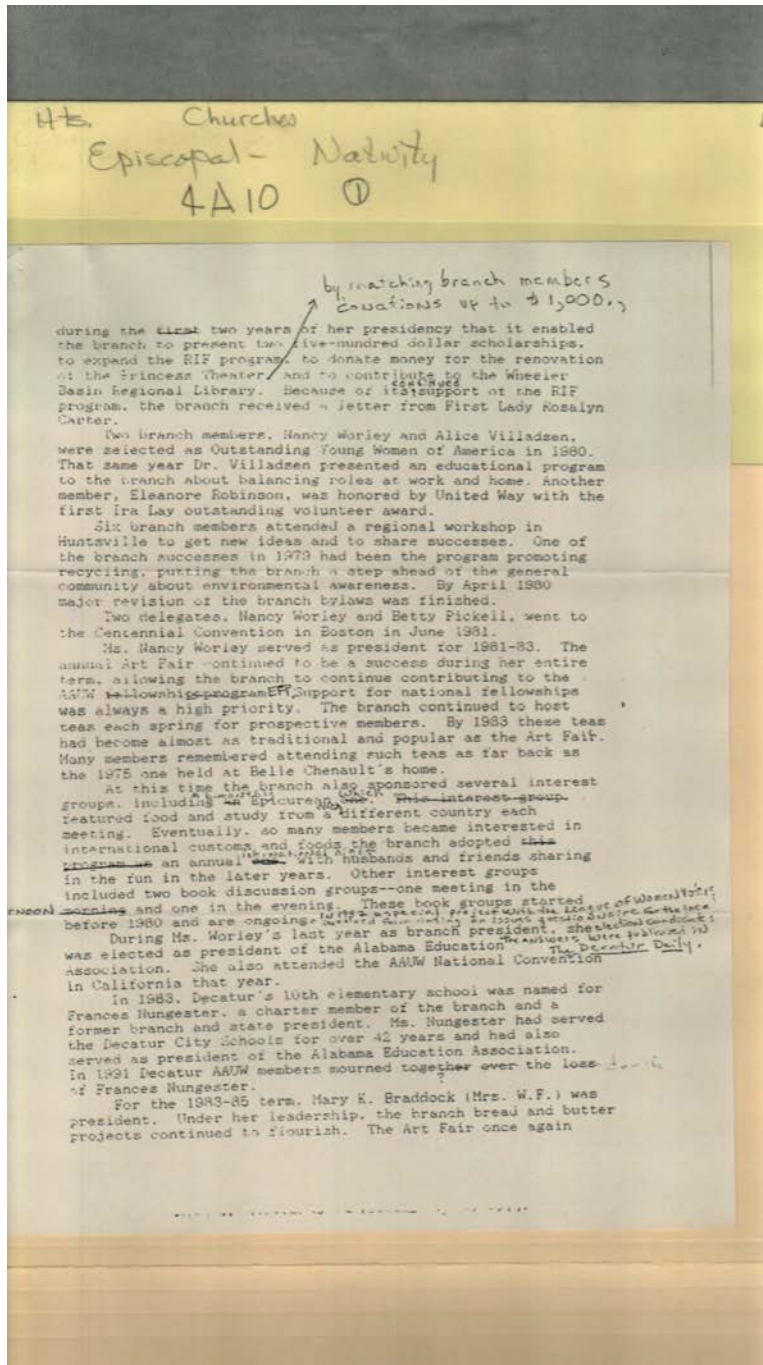

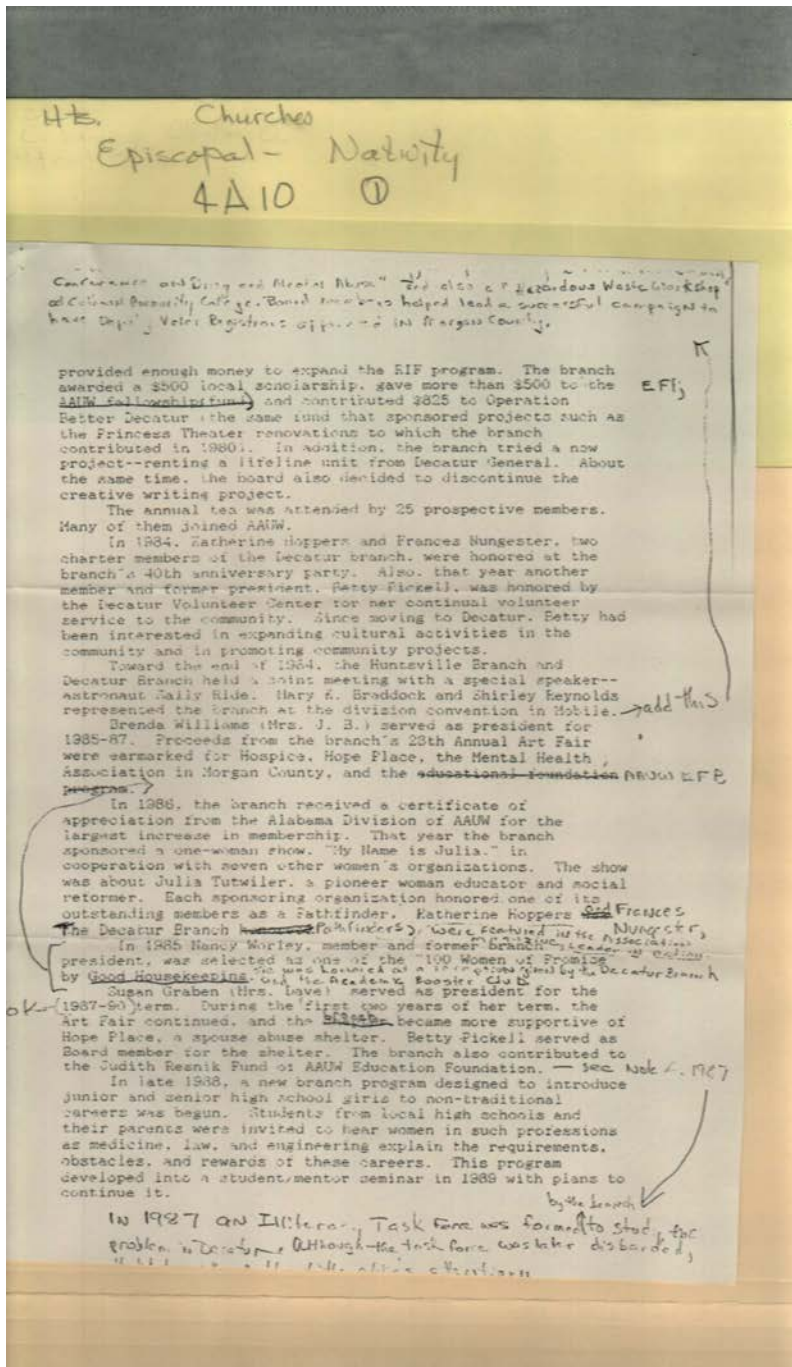

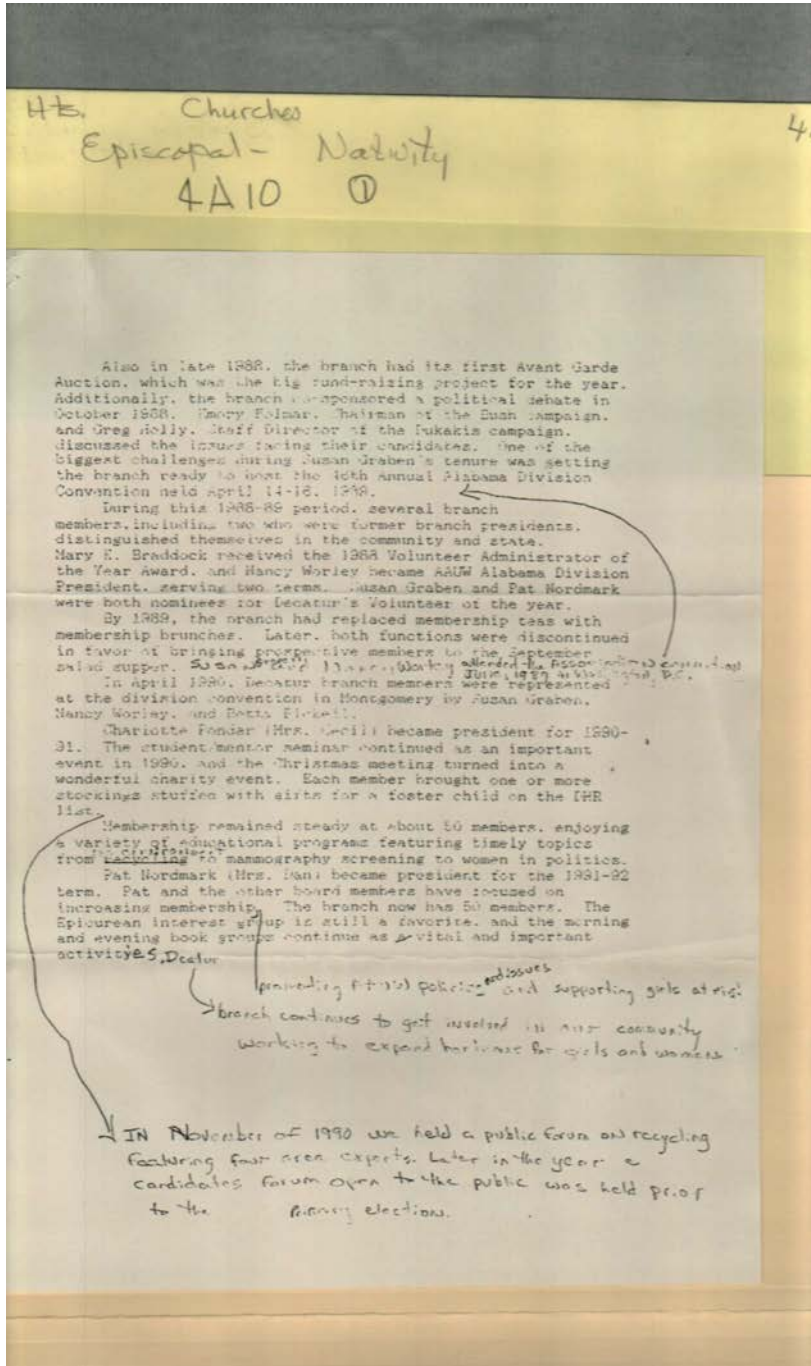
