**A New Fellowship Is Formed**

The Locust Grove Baptist Church of Route 2, New Market, Alabama, was formed May 25, 1867, by 24 members of the New Market Baptist Church. Their primary purpose in establishing the new church in a rapidly settling farm community was, apparently, for convenience—to lessen the time spent in traveling by horse and foot the distance of five or six miles to the New Market church. The Locust Grove Church continues to meet today, 109 years later, in a building no more than 100 yards from the site of its organization.

The church was organized as "The Baptist Church of Christ at Locust Grove," according to the Articles of Faith and Rules of Decorum which were adopted at the organizing meeting. As late as 1931, the church continued to be referred to occasionally as the Locust Grove Baptist Church of Christ, although that title was used interchangeably with the more simple "Locust Grove Baptist Church," by which it has been known exclusively for the past 43 years.

The earthly founder and first pastor of Locust Grove was G. W. Carmichael, an elder in the New Market church.

The church was organized in a log building in the approximate location of the present Searcy Lawler home, about 100 yards from the handsome sandstone and brick church of this day. For several years the small membership met in the log building, which housed the Locust Grove School.

Following are the complete minutes of the first meeting of the church:

**ARTICLES OF FAITH AND RULES OF DECORUM**

Whereas part of the members of New Market Church, being given us for constituting a Baptist Church, invited a presbytery composed of the following Brethren, Elders T. T. Henderson and G. W. Carmichael, who attended for the purpose and were received as such on the 4th Saturday in May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven. And after due examination in faith of our fitness for constitution did constitute and announced us a Baptist Church of Christ by the name of Locust Grove.

The Brethren and Sisters thus constituted are named as follows (viz.) Joseph W. Ghormley, John Lambert, James J. Erwin, A. B. Erwin, Wm. B. Freeman, George W. Freeman, Fleming J. Rigney, Rachael P. Ghormley, Jane Erwin, Sarah A. Ghormley, Margaret Sims, Mary Miller, Nancy Freeman, L. A. Laughinghouse, Martha F. Petty, Lucretia Petty, Martha J. Freeman, Francis L. Teague, Elizabeth Freeman, Martha T. Freeman, Zilpha Dalton, Martha J. McAdams, Senith Hill, Harriet Taylor, in number 24.

The following are the principles upon which we the said Church were constituted. 1st. We believe in one only true and living God and that there is a trinity of three persons in the Godhead yet not three Gods but one only. And that the Scriptures of the old and new testaments are the word of God and the only rule of faith and practice.

2nd. We believe in the fall of Adam and in the imputation of sin to all his posterity and that sinners are justified in the sight of God only by the righteousness of Christ imputed to them and good works the fruits of faith follows after justification. 3rd. We believe that the saints will persevere in grace and that none of them will be finally lost and that there will be a resurrection of the dead and universal judgement and that the happiness of the righteous and the punishment of the wicked will be eternal. 4th. We believe that the visible church of Christ, a congregation of faithful persons who have obtained fellowship with each other and have given themselves to the Lord and each other, having agreed to keep up a gospel discipline and that Jesus Christ is the great head of the church and that the government thereof is with the body. 5th. We believe that baptism by immersion and the Lord's Supper are ordinances of the Lord and should be continued in his Church until his second coming and that true believers are the only fit subjects of baptism. 6th. We believe that we have no gospel authority to admit any but regular baptized members to commune with us and the Lord's day

ought to be set apart for his worship and that no work or temporal business should be done thereon, works of piety, mercy and necessity only excepted, and further in the fear of God as we hope to give ourselves to the Lord and each other.

• • • • •

A frame church building was erected about 1873 on a lot adjoining the community school. Available church records do not indicate the year of construction—records for 1873 and much of 1873 cannot be located—but the 1936 annual report of the Madison-Liberty Association reveals that the church was built in 1873. This date is not incompatible with what is known; the impression of the oldest present members is that the school house served as a church meeting place for several years, and the Locust Grove Church building was known to be in existence in 1878.

The Locust Grove School and the Locust Grove Baptist Church got their names from the Locust Grove Inn, which was located at the site of the old Bayless-Lawler home (where the home of Mr. and Mrs. Glenn Hulsey now stands). The Locust Grove Inn, built about 1810 or earlier, was surrounded by a heavy growth of locust trees, hence the name. The inn was surrounded by a heavy growth of locust trees, and converted to a residence by Thomas H. Bayless, a charter member of Locust Grove Church.

**An Account of Church Building Projects**

The Locust Grove fellowship apparently built its first building in 1873, having worshipped for the first five years in the school house. That building served as the meeting house until the late 1940's, when the sanctuary part of the present structure was constructed.

There is no indication in the records as to how the original building was financed, who constructed it, or any other details. Mr. Frank Lawler recalls that it was a frame structure with dimensions of 30 by 40 feet. Mr. Harry Lawler recalls hearing some details of the construction (see "An Interview with Mr. Harry"). It was a plain building, plainly furnished and heated by a wood heater. The earliest mention of the building in existing minutes is an entry dated May 1878: "A committee was appointed to make arrangements to get laths preparatory to plastering the church. Committee was Bros. J. R. Latham, T. H. Bayless, J. H. Giles, and R. M. Miller." So the finishing touches, at least on the interior, seemingly were not applied until much after the building was occupied.

The one acre lot that the building was placed on was deeded to the church March 1, 1873, by Thomas H. Bayless and Martha A. Bayless, grandparents of Bros. Harry and Frank Lawler and Mrs. Lucy Blackburn, present members. The sum paid for the land was \$15, and the deed was made to Jas. J. Erwin, J. H. Giles and Robert A. Petty, trustees of the Locust Grove Baptist Church. (Note that the present-day name was used, not the Locust Grove Baptist Church of Christ.)

One point of interest and puzzlement, in the legal description of the church lot: One corner was described as being "about 100 yards east of the old church." This

And, as one might expect in a church body that is totally autonomous and democratic, and peopled by souls of strong will and independence, there have been instances of dissension in the church which resulted in unhappiness on the part of some members, and their subsequent departure. The minutes, with one exception, do not record these events, insofar as can be now determined, but within memory of present members such occurrences are known. For the most part, these more-or-less minor breaches in the fellowship were brought on by events and practices that may, in the present light, seem inconsequential: the method of calling a pastor, the serving of food in the meeting house, disenchantment with a particular pastor, financial considerations, etc. The one major exception occurred in the fall of 1874 in which a dispute arose which resulted in the dismissal of the pastor, Bro. O. R. Gregg. Bro. Gregg and his family and 37 other members withdrew and formed the Pleasant Springs Baptist Church in northeast Huntsville. The Locust Grove membership, while regretting the unhappiness caused by this unfortunate event, rebuilt and entered a bright new day of harmonious fellowship and service to Christ in the community.

### Historical Highlights

This section presents highlights of Locust Grove's history in chronological order. The material presented here will, in the main, omit occurrences that are recorded in the preceding articles; thus this section will not stand alone and should be read in concert with the other material. The information presented here has, with few exceptions, been digested from the official church minutes. In some cases amplification or explanation has been added. The information selectively printed here was chosen not only to give highlights of the church's development, but also to reflect the "flavor" and spirit of the times through which the Locust Grove fellowship has come.

July 1867, 4th Sabbath—Mary A. Miller came forward and gave evidence of faith in Christ by a relation of her experience and was received into fellowship. Thus Mary Miller became the first new member to join the fellowship, which had been formed a month earlier. It was customary at that time to offer the opportunity for membership in a formal business meeting called for that purpose after the worship service was over. It was handled in a business-like manner; they did not have imploring invitations incorporated into the worship as we do today. They would then "meet at the water" for baptism, immediately following the acceptance of Christ or following the next service.

In the early years, baptisms were normally conducted in the Flint River at one of two places, near the present home of Mr. and Mrs. Carl Hale (Eddins Ford) or a mile or so up the river (behind Backhorn). Later, the small creek that flows through the Maurice Lawler pasture, a few hundred yards west of the church, was used—a little pool that some members still fondly refer to as "the Lawler hole."

August 1867, 4th Sabbath—Locust Grove approved a petitionary letter applying for membership in the Liberty Baptist Association.

September 1867, 4th Sabbath—The church's first "protracted meeting" (revival) was begun; it lasted until the next Sabbath. Fourteen were added to the church, four by letter and 10 by "experience" (profession of faith and baptism).

September, 1869, 4th Sabbath—Bro. J. W. Ghermley was liberated by the church to exercise in public (licensed to preach). Bro. G. W. Carmichael, the founding pastor, resigned because of ill health. He was succeeded by Bro. G. A. Moring.

August, 1870—"The church through her deacons procured the services of Bro. Moring as pastor for the year ending the 4th Sabbath in September, 1871." (The

practice was to call a pastor for one year only, that year ending "with our September meeting." An undated note in 1871 indicated that "Bro. Moring agrees to preach for the church from August '71 up to Jan. 1872 to make up time lost during sickness in his family.")

March 1872—The church "voted to participate no further in suppers or other amusements" to raise money for church purposes. (In 1873 subscriptions were solicited for pastoral services—the pastor's salary. Eleven people pledged a total of \$45 and \$40 was actually paid. The amount of the annual salary that year is not given, but Bro. Moring accepted the pastorate on the promise of \$100 a year in 1872.)

Church Letter of 1873—Membership was listed as: Number of Whites, 75; blacks, none.

November 1874—Locust Grove unanimously called Bro. R. Wallace Officer to act as pastor for the ensuing year.

(No meetings were held in December, January and February of the winter, for unstated reasons.)

September 1875—The founding pastor, Bro. G. W. Carmichael, was recalled to the pastorate, unanimously. The membership reported on Sept. 12, 1875, was 73.

April 1876—The church agreed to "set apart Saturday before the 2nd Sabbath in May as a day of fasting and prayer; it being the time of her Sacramental Meeting." (The Lord's Supper was apparently served once a year.)

June 1876—The clerk reported an unexpended fund of six dollars and forty-five cents in the treasury. The church authorized the treasurer to furnish the house with light and other necessities. (The treasurer reported the next month that he spent \$1.20 for oil and chimneys.)

September 1876—Bro. Carmichael declined to take charge as pastor of the church for the ensuing year because of health. Moring was subscribed to sustain a pastor. Bro. J. Whit Hilliard was nominated and unanimously elected.

June 1876—An "arm" (mission) was established at Ragsdale School House and Bro. Rigney was asked to take charge of it and report to the church quarterly.

July 1877—The church refused to give "publicity" to the appointment of R. W. Officer as a Baptist—"the church at Temperance Oak having withdrawn from him on account of his departure from Baptist doctrine."

September 1877—A total of 94 members was reported in the associational letter.

December 1877—Bro. Hilliard resigned as pastor. (In April of the following year, Bro. W. J. Couch became pastor.)

April 1878—Bro. Rigney made a report from the arm at Ragsdale School House. One person was received for baptism.

May 1878—A committee composed of Bros. J. R. Latham, T. H. Bayless, J. H. Giles and R. M. Miller was named to get laths preparatory to plastering the church.

December 1878—The church voted to set aside a Sabbath for fasting and prayer as requested by the association.

July 1879—The church clerk was requested to see and correspond with delinquent members and learn if possible the cause of their nonattendance. The clerk was asked to write a letter of thanks for the church as follows: Honorable William Richardson, Judge of Probate, Madison County, will please accept thanks of Locust Grove Church for your kindness in recording deed to our church lot free of charge.

August 1879—As revealed by an entry at this date, the church at least on occasion would follow the Saturday afternoon service with a return to the meeting house "at early candlelight" for prayer service. (The normal monthly meeting was actually two services. Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning, with the early candlelight prayer service also mentioned at times.)

September 1879—Total membership, according to the associational letter, was 96. The first record of "Sabbath School Scholars" was given, with 74 enrolled. The address of the church was noted as "Hays Store, Ala."

July 1880—Bro. G. A. Moring asked the use of the church building to debate with Rev. George Farris of the Campbellite order, which was declined.

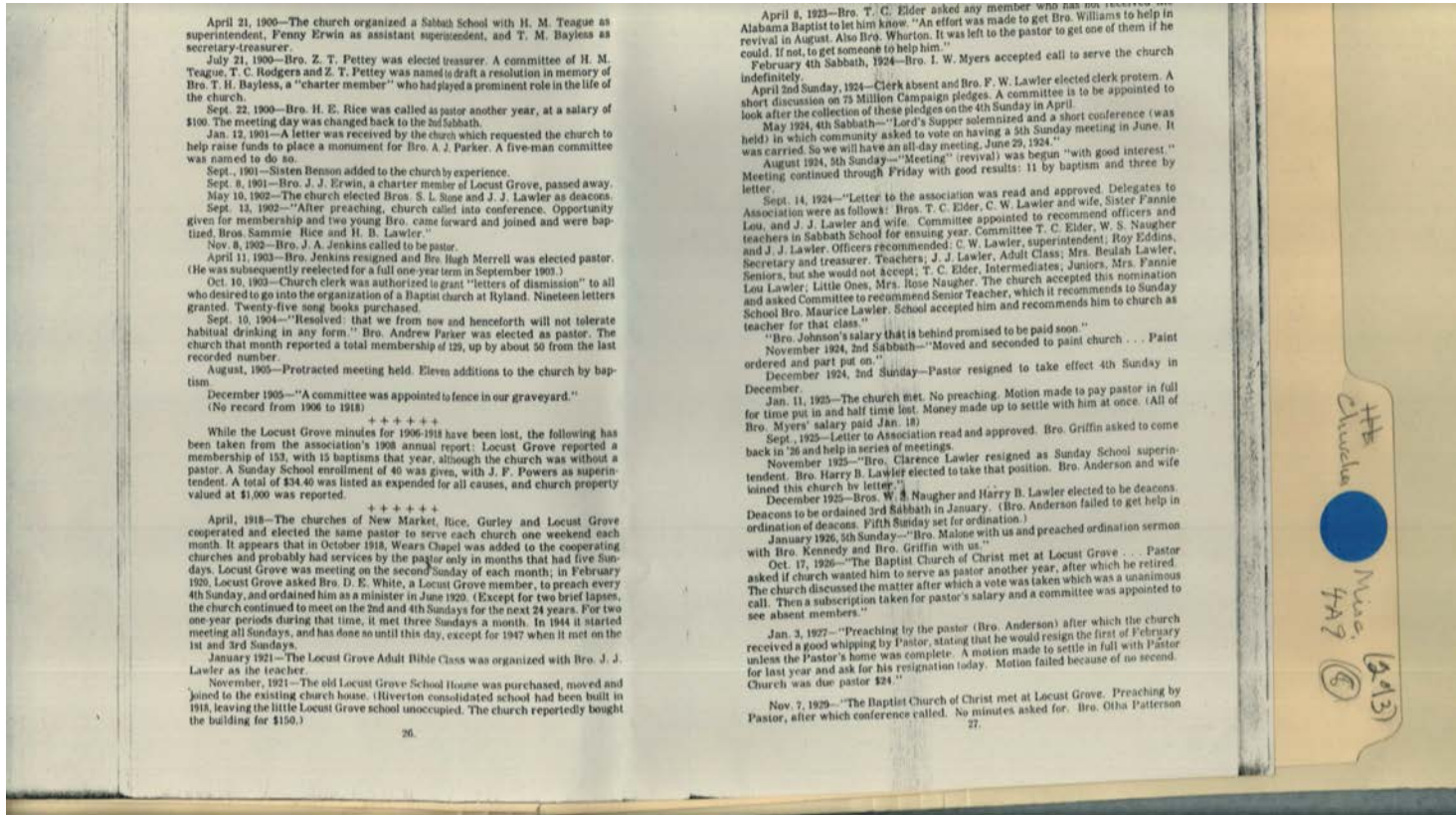

December 1953—Bro. Hooks resigned as pastor.  
 February 1954—The church called Bro. Carl Spraggins to serve as pastor for an indefinite period.  
 August 1954—The church voted to start a building fund to build a new pastorium.  
 January 1955—The church started paying \$5 per month of the pastor's gasoline bill "for hauling people to and from the church services." Also the church started providing packages of envelopes to each person to be used for their offering each Sunday.  
 February 1955—Money was budgeted to subscribe to the Alabama Baptist for each church family desiring this service. A Homecoming Day was planned for the 2nd Sunday in August. The church authorized the pastor to attend the Southern Baptist Convention. It was decided to build a nursery in the corner of the basement.  
 March 1955—Finance and Building committees were formed to plan, finance and construct the new pastorium. A building plan was presented and approved.  
 July 1955—The church requested the WMU president to purchase flowers for the funeral of any resident church member, with the church bearing the expense, not to exceed \$7.50.  
 December 1955—The Brotherhood financed \$105 of a well casing to serve the church and pastorium. Church agreed to finance the balance if the Brotherhood would pay the money back into the church treasury.  
 March 1956—Bro. Robert C. Hornbuckle called as pastor, replacing Bro. Spraggins who had resigned in January.  
 May 1956—The trustees were given the responsibility of maintaining the cemetery and granting lots to anyone wanting a burial plot.  
 September 1956—A new well pump was bought.  
 October 1956—The pastor and Bro. Harry Lawler were asked to put out some trees on the church ground. Bro. Squires of First Baptist Church, Huntsville, it was agreed, should be asked to conduct a music school at Locust Grove.  
 January 1957—The church voted to give \$59.50 to Madison-Liberty Association toward the purchase of four acres in Fleming Meadows, south of Huntsville, as a church site.  
 June 1957—Pastor's salary was raised by \$240 to \$3,440 per year.  
 October 1957—Insurance on the pastorium, which was still under construction, was obtained in the amount of \$2,500.  
 December 1957—Locust Grove voted to go through the necessary procedure to incorporate the church.  
 April 1958—A bid of \$550 for the old pastorium building was accepted.  
 July 1958—The church voted to level off the ground behind the church and construct recreational facilities.  
 August 1958—The church instituted a system of rotating deacons. The following were named to serve as the nominating committee for the coming year: Floyd Green, Laymon Blackburn, Leo Lawler, Charles Patterson, Albert Sharp, Mrs. Pettey Wells and Mrs. Tom Cornelison.  
 Sept. 10, 1958—It was decided that the playground be closed on Sundays, that all wear modest apparel on the playground and that a sign be erected setting forth the rules of the playground. It was specified that modest apparel would mean that the body be fully clothed, short or long-sleeved outer garment and lower limbs covered to the knee or below. "The church voted to buy 150 pounds of pork and 50 pounds of chicken and have it barbecued for the day the church entertains the association."  
 February 1959—The church voted to require everyone with a relative or friend buried in the cemetery to place a permanent marker at the grave. It was also decided to post a sign asking to refrain from mowing the cemetery on Sunday, as the Lord has commanded: "Remember the Sabbath Day to keep it holy."  
 Aug. 16, 1959—Locust Grove called Bro. Virgil Jones as pastor, at a salary of \$3,600 per annum, replacing Bro. Hornbuckle who had resigned in May.  
 September, 1960—It was agreed that the church would pay the full pastor retirement plan instead of having the pastor pay a portion. The painting of the pastorium was completed and a concrete floor was poured for the carpet.  
 January 1961—Water was piped from the church to the pastorium.  
 December 1960—Bro. Charles Maples was called as pastor.  
 February 1961—Nursery in basement enlarged. Church bulletins purchased with a picture of the church on them. Baptismal services were held in the New Market Baptist Church.  
 February 1962—Church auditorium was replastered. (The auditorium floor was sanded and refinished the next month, with carpet installed in April.)  
 August 1962—Bro. F. Marion Hill was called to the pastorate, succeeding Bro. Maples who resigned in July.  
 September 1962—Locust Grove voted to enter a bond program to finance construction of a new education building. The program consisted of a \$25,000 bond issue creating an indebtedness for 14 1/2 years.  
 Nov. 7, 1962—A building committee (C. M. Green, Homer Fears and Jim Gaines) was elected to plan and oversee the construction of the education building. A baptistry which had been bought by the First Baptist Church, Huntsville, and scrapped without use was bought by Locust Grove for installation in its sanctuary.  
 December 1962—An amplifier system was installed making it possible for the nursery workers to hear the services.  
 Sept. 8, 1963—Baptismal service was held in the Locust Grove church for the first time in its 96 years. The two baptized on this first occasion were Donna Brown Dunham, a present member, and Judy Brewer. (For several years prior to that time, the church had given up creek baptismal services and had used the baptistries of other churches, notably the Second Baptist and Huntsville Park in Huntsville, and New Market Baptist.)  
 April 1964—The church organ was originally bought (in 1961) on a time payment plan by the Young Men's Sunday School Class. After they paid about \$1,200, the church agreed to pay the remaining \$384.
