HISTORY OF ST. BARTLEY P. B. CHURCH

The first house of worship for Negroes in Alabama stood in the southeast part of the city of Huntsville, Alabama. This section was called the Old Georgia Grave Yard. A sanctuary in a grave yard. Colored people, before the war, who were not free, could not own any property, and for this reason had no place to call their own in which to build, except the grave yard.

The church yard was filled with lovely trees of all kinds. Many having been placed at the head of the graves by the loving hands of surviving friends and relatives.

This silent city of the dead with its church for the living, being outside of the city limits of Huntsville, had very little preaching at night. Instead of preaching, a wail could be heard the mournful sound of the whip-poor-will and owl. Here stood the lone church, which later, like a refused stone in Solomon's Temple, became the headstone of the Primitive Baptist in Alabama.

The original congregation was called the Huntsville African Baptist Church. Elder William Harris was the founder, organizer, and the first preacher in 1820. The church was admitted by a petitionary letter into the white Flint River Primitive Baptist Association of North Alabama in 1821. At its time St. Bartley had seventy six members. The white and colored remained united in this association until the war broke out in 1861. During the war both white and colored became scattered. In 1865, all slaves were declared free by Abraham Lincoln. The colored Baptists desired to continue in the same association with the white people formerly. They later concluded that they were free and could form an association of their own. In September, 1870, four Negro Primitive Baptist churches were called together in union and organized. Elder William Hays was elected to be the first moderator.

In 1911 the St. Bartley P. B. Church was relocated on Oak Avenue, on Calhoun Street, southwest side of Huntsville. This grey concrete brick building, with gothic windows of ornamental glass was the largest Negro church in Alabama. The church remained on this site for 23 years. The last service was held on the 3rd Sunday night in December 1934.

The members were without a real church home for approximately one year while a new structure was being erected. Many church activities were conducted in the homes of the members. Regular worship services were continued in the auditorium of Calvary Hill Elementary School.

The St. Bartley P. B. Church now stands at 3020 Belafonte Avenue NW. Even though the building was not complete, the first services were held on the 1st Sunday, in December 1965. The church was formally dedicated on Sunday, April 9, 1967.

During the 148 years of history of the church, only six (6) ministers have served. Elder William Harris, Elder Bartley Harris, Elder Felix Jordan, Elder Eli Patton and Elder Richard Moore, all whom are deceased. The present pastor, Elder Amos Robinson, has served the church since 1950.
