

How the Ladies Auxiliary to Wild West Post Number 91, Veterans of Foreign Wars, stationed at Tacoma, Washington State, got involved in a Community Service project in *The Heart of Dixte,* in Alabama, may require: an explanation. Sister Dimme Louise Roby has retained her Wild West membership since she joined the Junior Unit in July, 1952.

Her mother, Sister Jeanne Sellers Roby, was employed at Mount Rainier Ordnance Depot (GS-03 Clerk-Typist) when phase-out procedures started the MacNamara "money-saving" merry-go-round that put her into Tooele (Two Ella) Ordnance Depot around 30 niles south and west of Salt Lake City, Utah, in November, 1961. Sister Dianne followed her in June, 1962, after graduation from Aquinas Academy with a Certificate of Completion. In September, she entered Tooele City High School to pick up her "bone-heads" for a high school diploma.

During that school year, the Latter Day Saint (Mormon) teachers taught her to enjoy studying, and, due to her own pedigree, hit a responsive chord in genealogical research.

In 1964, Mr. MacNamara had another attack of the money-saving syndrome and Department of Defense Civilians once more found themselves on his merry-go-round. In November of that year, Sister Jeanne (GS-03 Clerk-Typist) was moved with the rest of the Stock Control types--**transferred with function.* Sister Jeanne's first choice had been U. S. Army Missile Command, Redstone Arsenal, Alabama. She and Sister Diannewere now in the Deep South with their home at Huntsville, Alabama.

They heard of plantation cemeteries; that there were several on the Arsenal, one of which was at the intersection of Martin and Mills Roads. One lovely autumn day in 1965 they went out to look. They took pictures. They were impressed by a fantastic contrast: Here were people (they later found out, slaves and children of slaves) peacefully sleeping while out across the Arsenal were test stands for engines of unbelievable destruction, and for the fantastic project of putting a man on the moon.

When a local historian saw the pictures, she asked about who was buried out there. The names. How I wish you knew the names. So, Sister Dianne got the names; then, the names on other such grave; ards. Then, a friend died and she took a notion to visit his grave. Charity Cemetery. After months of cemetery hunting, the Robys found the Charity Missionary Saptist Church Cemetery, about halfway between Hazel Green (see map, Front Cover) and Lickskillet.

This was a big one with over twelve hundred marked graves. Sister Dianne had to figure out some sort of a system. She already "walked in and started cataloging from left to right, and down the page," but this required something more. The old sexton wanted to know what she was doing, then made suggestions. In time, she discovered that he was illiterate and needed a way to find graves to save his job. Between them they worked out her "row system" whereby he could locate any grave in the cemetery by a typewritten list. (Illiterates usually can read numbers.)

Sister Diamne had completed Charity and was debating on which one she would do next. The paster of New Sharon Church of God, west of Charity, half-way to Lickskillet, had invited her to do theirs. Several families had invited her to do cemeteries on their land. She was debating which to do when a local historian said, "Do Maple Hill, Dianne. Please do Maple Hill."

The Bobys had visited Maple Hill once in November of 1965. The latter Day Saints are surveying cemeteries, west to east, across Alabams and will in time come to Maple
