





Jefferson and the Election of 1992

I have been for some time used as the property of the newspapers, a fair mark for every man's dirt. Some, too, have indulged themselves in this exercise who would not have done it, had they known me otherwise than through these impure and injurious channels.

Although he lived until 1826, Thomas Jefferson was always an eighteenth-century American. A creature of the Enlightenment, he embodied its values of balance and harmony. Cautiously hopeful about human potential and progress, he watched with remarkable serenity as the infant republic was transformed during the years preceeding his death--which fatefully occurred on the fiftieth anniversary of the Declaration of Independence. How would the American philosophe see the adult nation in this election year, two centuries after his ideas were formed?

For all of his brilliance, Jefferson would find some things about the modern world too bewildering to assess. We know that he loved the country and feared cities, ugly "sores" upon earth's face. How could he begin to classify the grassy suburbs that now stretch across the American landscape? In some of his most-quoted passages, he labeled farmers "God's chosen people," and he warned that manufacturing would breed a dependent population too servile to sustain the republic. What would he make of modern labor unions whose assertive leaders are courted by presidential candidates?
