James Record was Chairman of the Madison County Commission for 20 years, 1962-1981. He was appointed to that office in March 1962, by Governor John Patterson, to fill the unexpired term of Roy Landess Stone, deceased. He was elected to a full four (4) year term in 1964, without opposition. He was elected to a four (4) year term again in 1968, without opposition in the Democratic primary. He received the largest vote of <u>ANY</u> person in Madison County history in the general election, to that time, swamping Republican and Conservative party candidates. He was elected again in 1972, and again in 1976. His last term expired January 21, 1981. At age 63, he elected to retire, saying that he was making way for a younger person to fill the spot that he had held for 20 years.
