MID-SOUTH MEMOIRS—

Three Popes Who Left Their

By PAUL R. COPPOCK

Just before the Civil War, three remarkable members of the Pope family lived here and benefited the town.

The oldest and most prominent at the time was John Pope, a model farmer who had 500 acres on the Raleigh Road, which now is Jackson Avenue, in the area now known as Highland Heights, including the property on which Treadwell School is located.

His younger brother was Le Roy Pope, ante-bellum superintendent of schools, who has been better remembered in recent years because the school serving the Chelsea area was renamed to honor him.

MARY E. FOOTE, who married Le Roy Pope, was the founder of St. Mary's Episcopal School and a poet. She may be better remembered than the other two in modern Memphis because of the interest of St. Mary's girls in her life.

John and Le Roy were boys in the mansion at Huntsville, Ala., which continues to be the finest place among the numerous fine old colonial houses near the big spring. Their father was chief justice of the Superior Court of the district. Both boys were graduated at Yale, John in the class of 1815 and Le Roy in 1823.


John was in Memphis in 1832, and perhaps a bit earlier. That was several years before the former village began to grow into the major town of the region.

John had studied law two years and been a member of the Alabama legislature two years, but when he came to Memphis his chief interest was in farming. He built up cotton fields until they had a value of more than \$100,000, and he had a labor force of about 75. He added two other farms, one of them in Noncannah Bottoms, until he had about 900 acres.

EVEN THE SHORTEST summary of his career tells of his sending a bale of cotton to the world fair in London in 1851, where it won first prize among short-staple exhibits. He won other awards for his cotton and for his pedigreed livestock, including a silver medal in the New York exhibition of all nations in 1853.

He was a leader among farmers in organizing the Agricultural Society of Shelby County in 1854, and in sponsoring early fairs. He remained president for years and in 1857 the agricultural society, in a ceremony at the Fair Grounds, presented him with a pitcher formed by melting 100 silver dollars. The cotton merchants of Memphis had already, in 1853, celebrated his London prize by the presentation of a silver tray, a pair of silver candelabra, a mantle clock and a vase.

Pope worked at the science of farming. About 1856 he made a long tour of European agriculture, including crops in Greece. He kept detailed farm diaries for 1840 through 1866. There are four volumes of them. Choosing one of the

convention was held in Memphis in 1845, with John C. Calhoun presiding, John Pope was the speaker on agriculture. At that early date Pope called for diversified crops and for industrial pay rolls in a region afflicted by low cotton prices.

In the same year he became president of the Memphis and Somerville Plank Road Company. Later he became a board member of the Memphis and Ohio Railroad (now the Louisville and Nashville), which put a line of rails past his farm.

HE WAS PROMINENT in Whig politics. But he turned down a place in the constitutional convention that revised the state's charter in 1835, as well as a place in the legislature, and a nomination for the House of Representatives. He thought politics would take him away from his farm. But he accepted when he was named to speak for Shelby County when Zachary Taylor came through on his way to be inaugurated as president. When he became older he was induced to become a candidate for the legislature of 1851, and lost by 15 votes to Marcus Winchester, first mayor of Memphis.

As the war came on, he became chairman of a "union" convention at Nashville in 1861 to make a nomination for governor. As the Yankee fleet approached Memphis in 1862, the rebels took \$20,000 worth of cotton from the Pope farm and burned it, to keep it away from the federals. Later the federals raided the farm for slaves and corn. Before the war ended he had worked out share-cropping for some of his former slaves.

His son, Andrew Rembert Pope, served the Confederacy as a member of the Shelby Grays and after the war was a member of the Shelby County Court for more than 30 years.

JOHN POPE WAS a member of Calvary Episcopal Church, which he represented in diocesan and general conventions. He married Louisa Rembert about 1819. She died and he married Elizabeth Hemphill Jones in 1839. She died and he married Mrs. Adelia Peck Chambliss.
