HEREFORD

The family of HEREFORD, one of very great antiquity, derived its surname according to an old manuscript, from "the name of a city on the borders of the principality of Wales, formerly very well fortify'd and the ordinary residence of the ancient earls of Hereford. The ancestors of the family liv'd there a long while, to secure themselves from the incursions of ye people of that country, till at last that nation, falling under the government of the English in the time of Edward, the first (1284), and the ancient quarrels between the two nations being at an end, they came and liv'd in a land (aula) call'd Sufton Hall, or Sufton Castle, under the Lord Mordiford, three miles from Hereford towards the south; and their posterity remain there to this day, and are lords thereof, as of many other inheritances and lands situated in the provence."

Of the elder branch were the earls of Hereford, who were likewise high constables of England. Their line terminated in heiresses, daughters of Milo de Gloucester who became Earl of Hereford in 1141 and died in 1143. His eldest daughter, Margery, married Humphrey de Bohun (Earl of Hereford 1147-died 1220) and their son, Humphrey de Bohun, II became Earl of Hereford, and constable of England.

Contemporaneous with those potent feudal lords, there resided in the city of Hereford ROGER HEREFORD, "a famous philosopher (says the same manuscript), who published the books quoted by John Pitts. (2) This Roger, 'the philosopher', was born on the borders of Wales, and was probably a student of Cambridge, as most of his works, it is reported, were preserved a long time there. He was very much esteemed by the great men of his time, as well for his excellent qualities, as for the extraordinariness of his progress in all sorts of learning. He was of a sharp wit; and was so great a lover of the sciences that if one ask'd him, which were the things, whereof the desire is never satisfy'd in never so great plenty, he would answer, not as a covetous man, that they were riches, but as a philosopher, that it was learning. He never lost a moment, but always spent in study all the time cou'd be spar'd from his employment to which he was obliged to attend. His works were - A Book of Judiciary Astrology, Quoniam Regulas Artis Astronomiae; Of the Theory of Planets, Divers Astronomers; according to the Different Manuscripts of the Public Library at Oxford; A Book of Collections of the Years of Planets; A Book of the Setting and Rising of Constellations; A Book of the Horizon and the Circle; A Book of Metals."

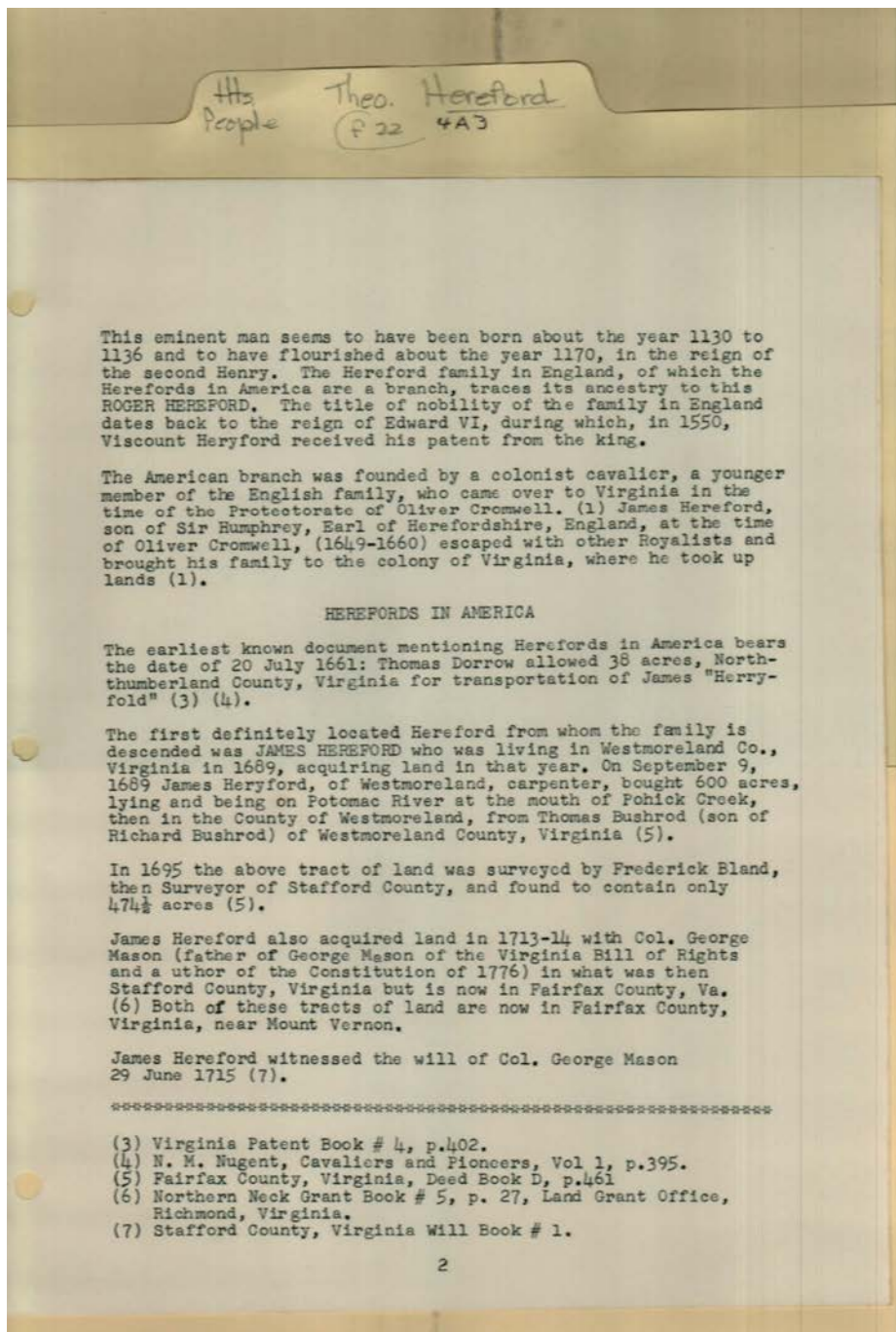

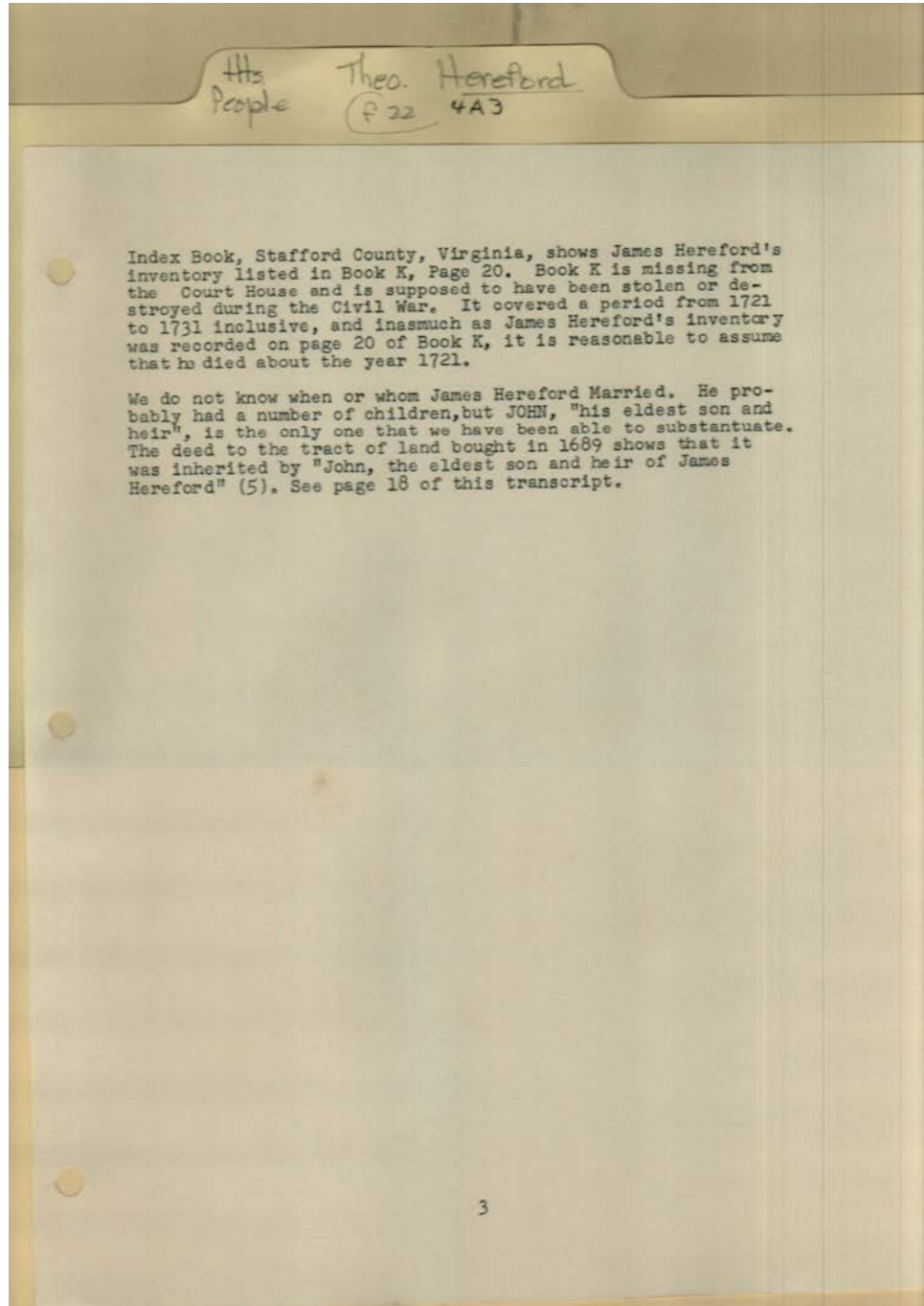

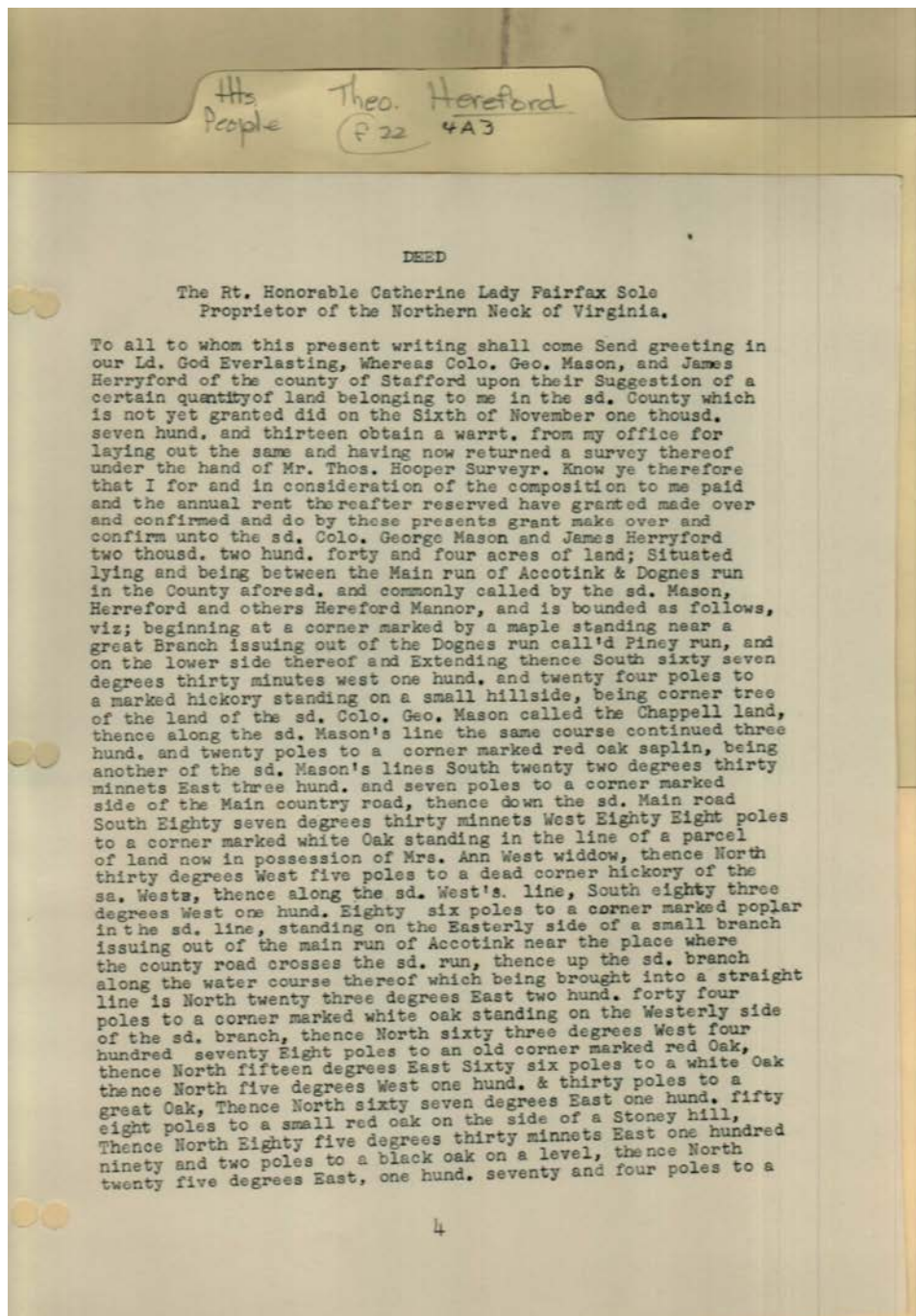

Northern Neck yearly & Every year on the feast of St. Michael the Arch Angel the free rent of one Shilling Sterling money for every fifty acres of land thereby granted and so proportionably for a greater or a lesser quantity Provided that if the sd. Geo. Mason and James Herreford and their heirs or assigns shall not pay the before reserved annual rent so that the same or any part thereof shall be behind or unpaid by the space of two whole years after the same shall become due if lawfully demanded, that then it shall and may be lawfull for me my heirs and assigns Proprietors of the Northern Neck aforesd. ours or either of our certain Attorneys or Agents into the above granted premises to reenter and hold the same so as if this grant had never passed. Given at my office in Westmoreland County within my sd. Proprietary under my seal. Witness my Agent and Attorney fully Authorized thereto. Dated the fourth day of January In the first year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George by the Grace of God of Great Britian &c. King Defender &c. Anno Dom. 1714/15.

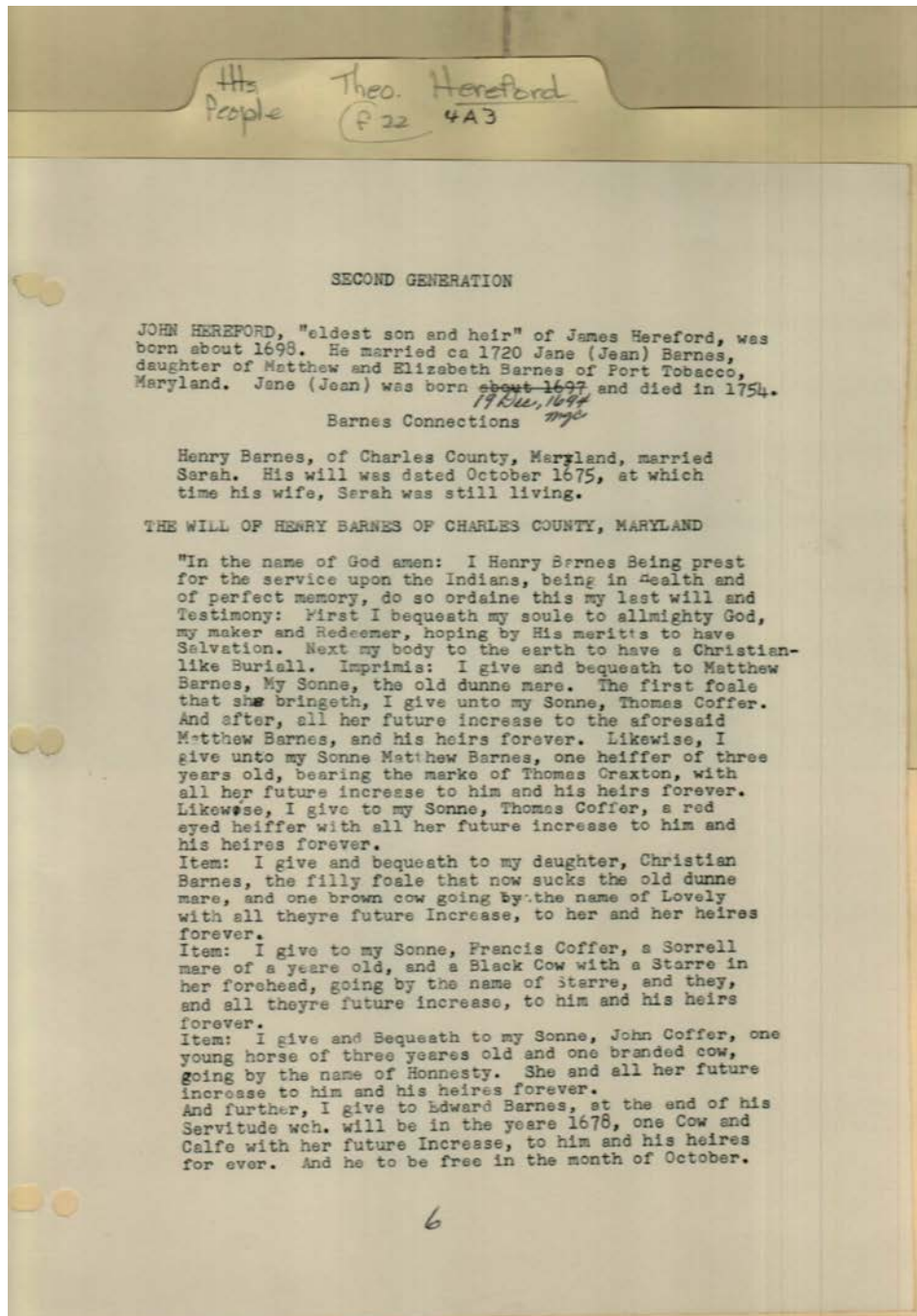

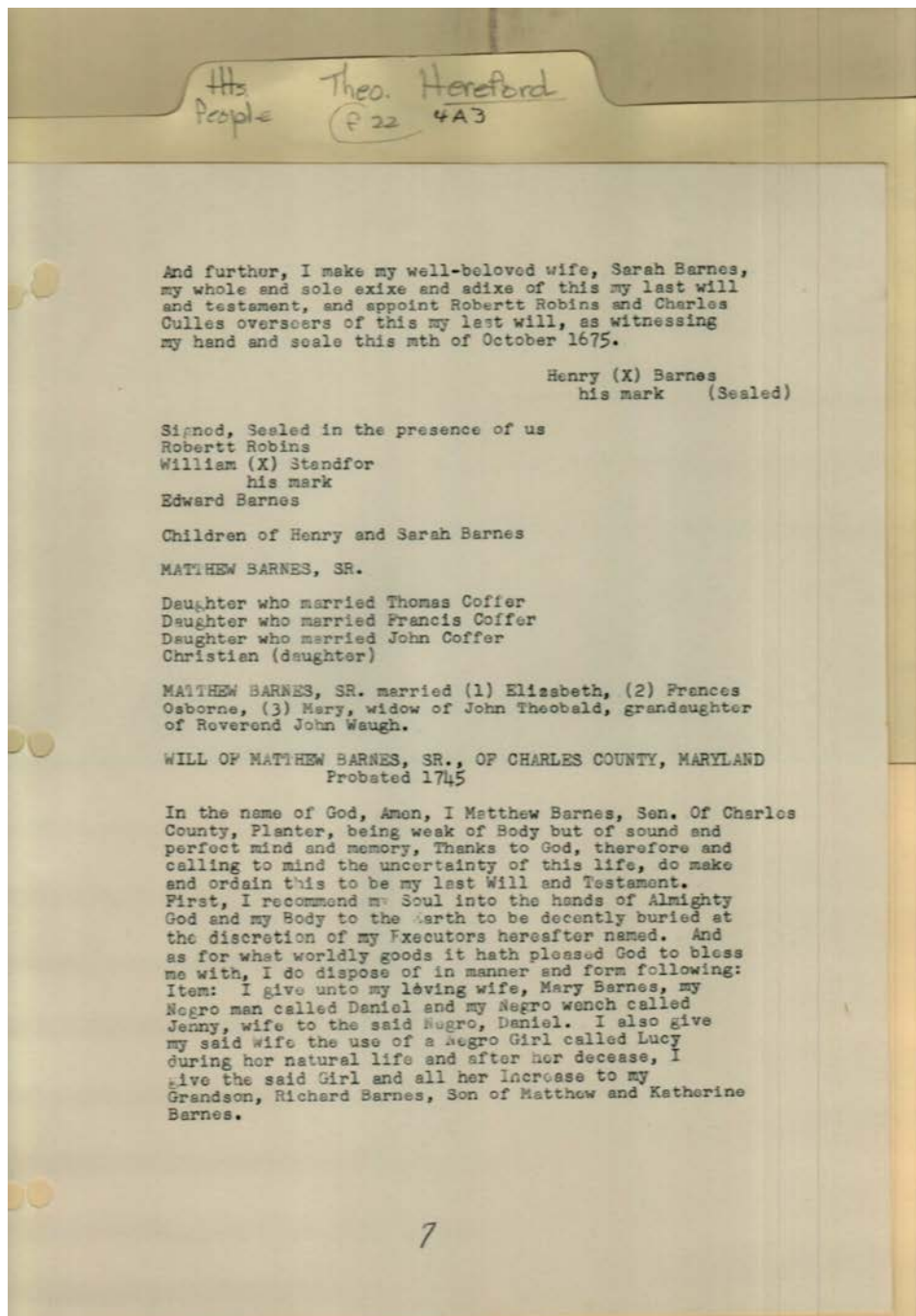

I also give and bequeath to my said Wife, one thousand pounds of Tobacco to be apply'd towards the building her a dwelling house upon her third of a tract of land left her by her former husband, John Theobald. Which said Tobacco, I desire may be paid out of my Estate by my Executor, Henry Barnes, after the said house be finished and my said Wife hath lived therein for the space of three months.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son Godshall Barnes my hand Mill and my Cell in full of his part of my Estate.

Item: I give and bequeath to my son Matthew Barnes all and every part of my wearing apparell. I also give my son, the said Matthew Barnes, one of the best Steers I am possessed of at the time of my death which legacys are in full of his part of my Personal Estate.

Item: I give and bequeath to my Son, Phillip Barnes, my Negro Man called Sambo and my Negro Boy called Osborne to him and his heirs forever.

Item: I give and bequeath to my Son, Henry Barnes, one Negro Man called Willey and my Negro wench called Goonal, wife of the same Negro Walley to him and his heirs forever.

Item: I give and bequeath to my four daughters, Jane Hereford, Elizabeth Courts, Ann Harrison and Frances Harrison, a gold Ring of Ten shillings Sterling value each of them in full of their part of my Personal Estate

Item: I give and bequeath all the remaining part of my personal Estate after my just debts are paid and the several legacys aforementioned are taken out to be equally divided among my Wife, Mery Barnes, and my two sons, Phillip and Henry Barnes.

Lastly, I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my said loving wife, Mery Barnes, and my Son, Henry Barnes, to be my whole Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and making null and void all former and other Will or Wills by me heretofore made, Ratifying and confirming this and this only to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof, I have herunto set my hand and affix'd my seal this ---- day of June Anno Dom 1745.

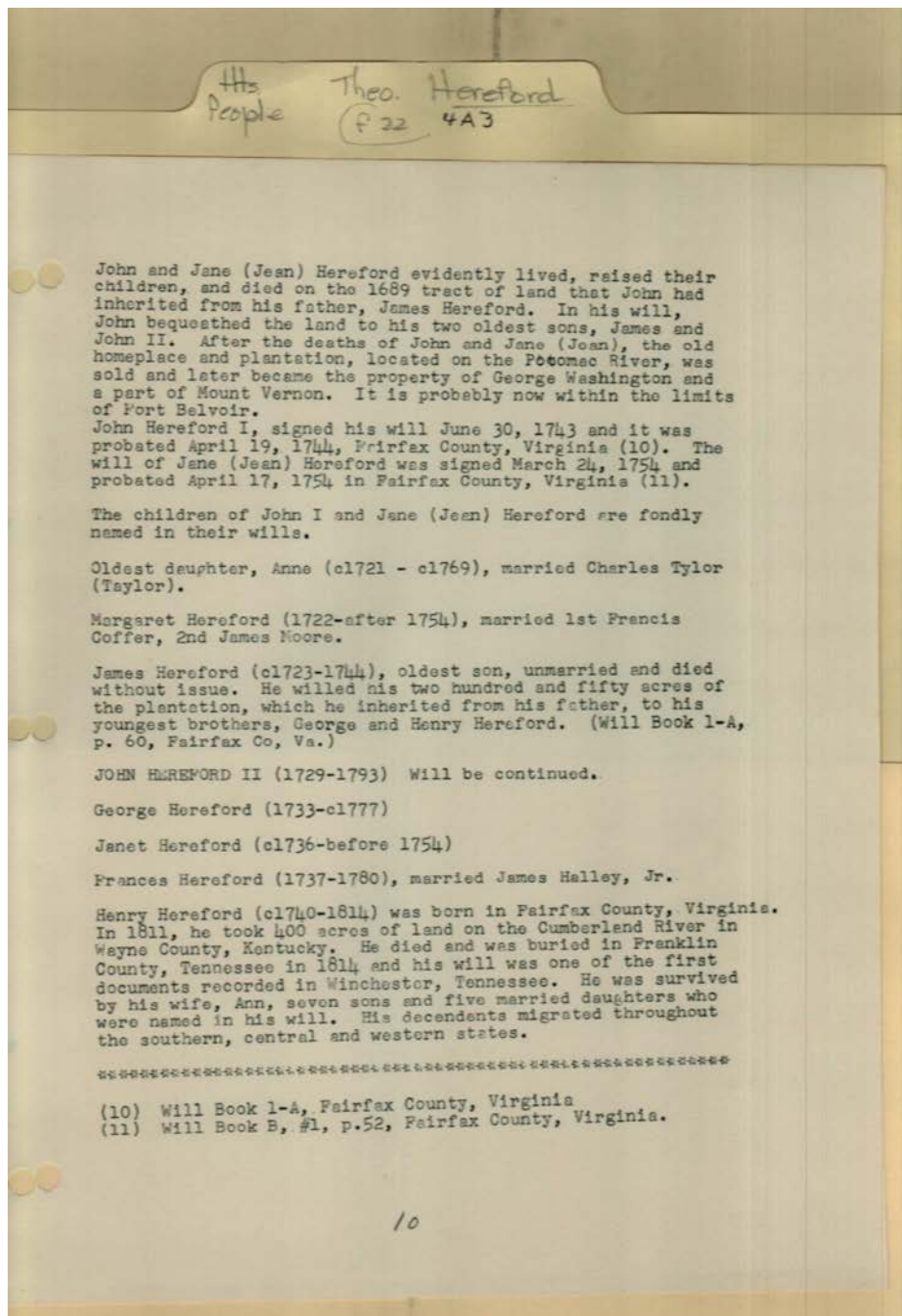

John and Jane (Jean) Hereford evidently lived, raised their children, and died on the 1689 tract of land that John had inherited from his father, James Hereford. In his will, John bequeathed the land to his two oldest sons, James and John II. After the deaths of John and Jane (Jean), the old homeplace and plantation, located on the Potomac River, was sold and later became the property of George Washington and a part of Mount Vernon. It is probably now within the limits of Fort Belvoir.

John Hereford I, signed his will June 30, 1743 and it was probated April 19, 1744, Fairfax County, Virginia (10). The will of Jane (Jean) Hereford was signed March 24, 1754 and probated April 17, 1754 in Fairfax County, Virginia (11).

The children of John I and Jane (Jean) Hereford are fondly named in their wills.

Oldest daughter, Anne (c1721 - c1769), married Charles Tylor (Taylor).

Margaret Hereford (1722-after 1754), married 1st Francis Coffey, 2nd James Moore.

James Hereford (c1723-1744), oldest son, unmarried and died without issue. He willed his two hundred and fifty acres of the plantation, which he inherited from his father, to his youngest brothers, George and Henry Hereford. (Will Book 1-A, p. 60, Fairfax Co, Va.)

Frances Hereford (1737-1780), married James Halley, Jr.

Henry Hereford (c1740-1814) was born in Fairfax County, Virginia. In 1811, he took 400 acres of land on the Cumberland River in Wayne County, Kentucky. He died and was buried in Franklin County, Tennessee in 1814 and his will was one of the first documents recorded in Winchester, Tennessee. He was survived by his wife, Ann, seven sons and five married daughters who were named in his will. His descendants migrated throughout the southern, central and western states.

Champ and her children with the exception of her daughter (Sarah who was willed and devised to my wife during her life) which slave I will and devise to my beloved granddaughter Margaret S. Hereford at the death of my said wife over and above her share with brothers and sisters.

I do hereby give and bequeath to my slave Alfred Hoe his freedom and do hereby direct that he shall enjoy the same. I do hereby direct my Executors to pay said Alfred one hundred dollars provided he and his wife shall leave the State in twelve months after my death. I give and bequeath to my son, Theodorick M. Hereford and his heirs forever all the residue of my property both real and personal not hereinbefore disposed of or named and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Theodorick M. Hereford and Thomas Fred of Loudoun County, State of Virginia, my Executors, and it is my wish and desire that the Court may not require of my said son Theodorick any security as Executor to my said Estate. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this --- in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight hundred and forty.

At a Court held for Loudoun County January 11th, 1841. This paper purporting to be the last Will and testament of Thomas A. Hereford, dec'd, was this day presented to the Court proved by the oaths of James Meegeath (?) and John B. Hereford two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be Recorded. And on the motion of Thomas Fred one of the Executors therein named who qualified as such and with William Chamblin and John B. Hereford his securities who testified, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twelve thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form and liberty is reserved the other Executor therein named to qualify whenever he shall think fit.

Mr. Burwell also stated in this letter that Humphrey and Susan Sale lived at "Edmundsburg" which was later known as the old "Judge Pendleton House". It is my understanding that "Edmundsburg", no longer standing, was the family home of the Sale family.

The earliest documentation pertaining to the Sale family that I have found so far in this locale is in Essex County (a part of Caroline County was formed from a part of Essex County) and is as follows:
"1704/5 Surveyor's report on land differences between N. Franklin and Richard Goode-----the line beginning at Main Run of Occupation Creek adjoining the plantation of Cornelius Sayle,-----"

There are other records through 1727 pertaining to Cornelius Sale including the fact that he lived in St. Ann's Parish on S.W. Bank of Occupation Creek.

The Dudley Sale, whose plantation adjoined that of Theodorick M. Hereford, Sr. in Madison County, Alabama, and who witnessed the second marriage of Theodorick to Mrs. Lucy Grantland Powell in 1836, was descended from
John Sale, born 1729 Essex Co., Va. died 1815 Amherst Co., Va. Revolutionary Army Captain and Surgeon, was the father of Cornelius Sale and other children all accounted for.
Cornelius Sale born in Amherst Co., Va., moved to Elbert Co., Ga. after 1787 where he died.

Judith Sale, wife of Leroy Pope, came to Madison County, Alabama by 1814 and
Dudley Sale, born 1781 in Amherst Co., Va., to Georgia with parents, to Madison County, Alabama, died here in 1867.

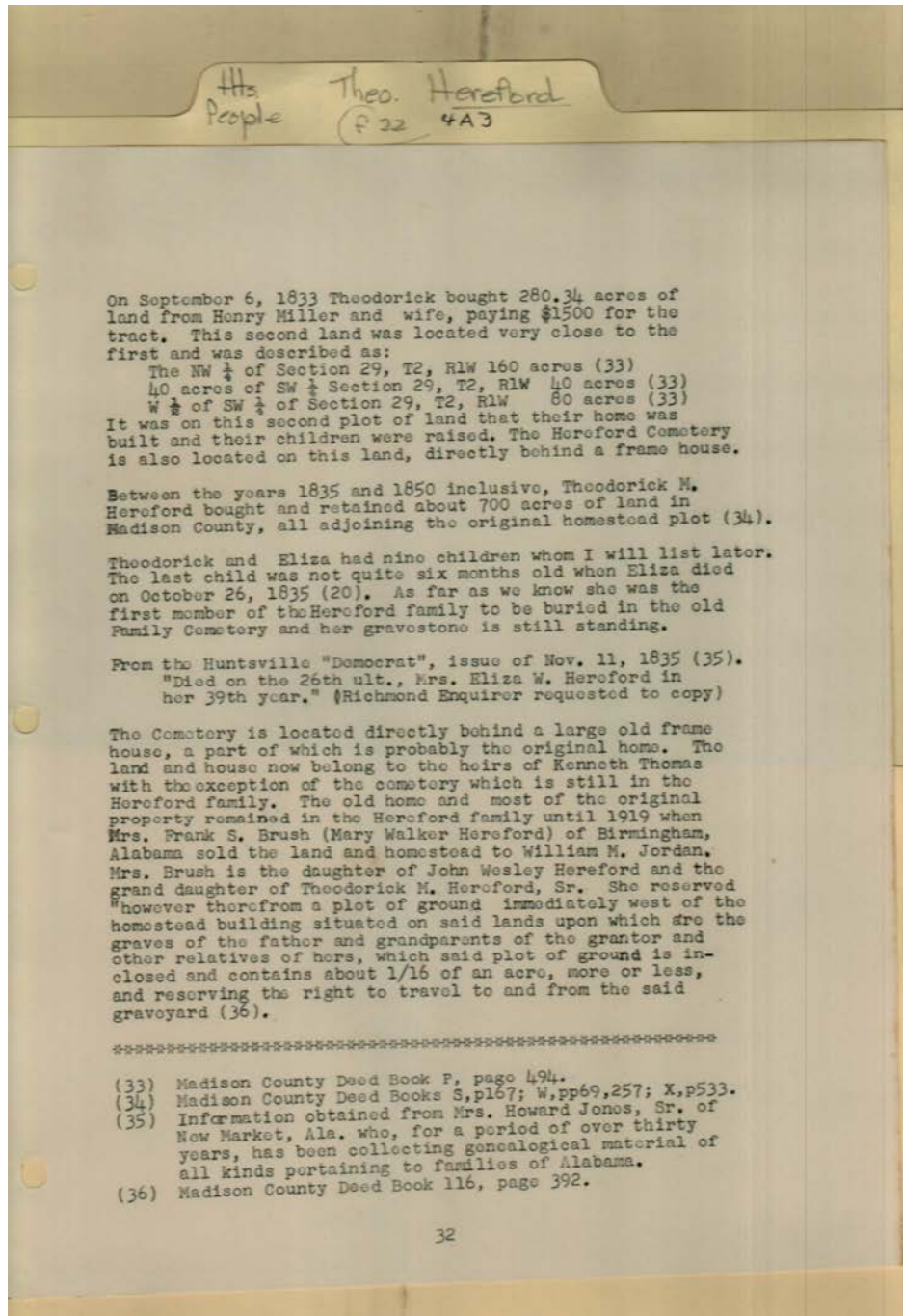

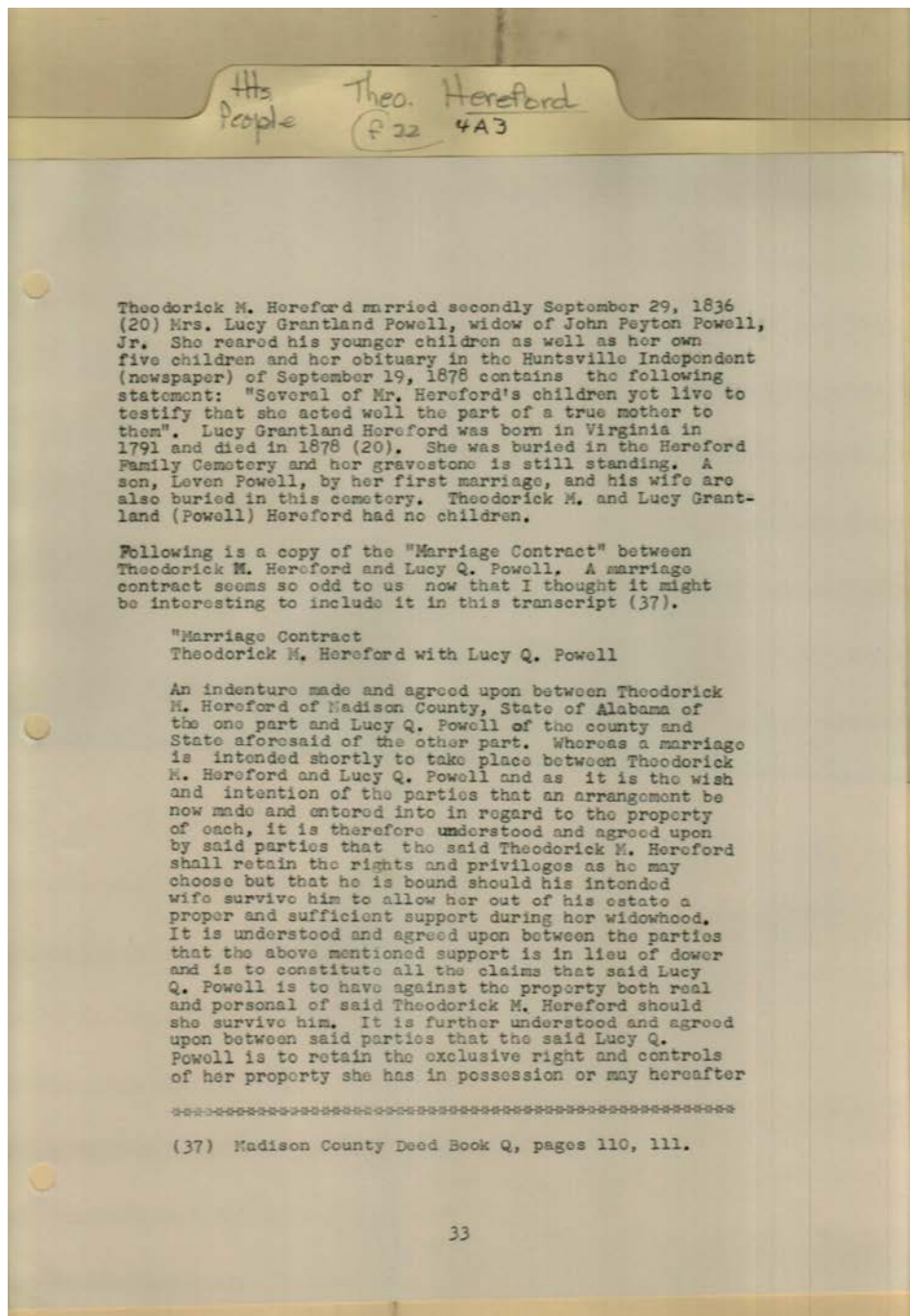

Theodorick M. Hereford married secondly September 29, 1836 (20) Mrs. Lucy Grantland Powell, widow of John Peyton Powell, Jr. She reared his younger children as well as her own five children and her obituary in the Huntsville Independent (newspaper) of September 19, 1878 contains the following statement: "Several of Mr. Hereford's children yet live to testify that she acted well the part of a true mother to them". Lucy Grantland Hereford was born in Virginia in 1791 and died in 1878 (20). She was buried in the Hereford Family Cemetery and her gravestone is still standing. A son, Leven Powell, by her first marriage, and his wife are also buried in this cemetery. Theodorick M. and Lucy Grantland (Powell) Hereford had no children.

Following is a copy of the "Marriage Contract" between Theodorick M. Hereford and Lucy Q. Powell. A marriage contract seems so odd to us now that I thought it might be interesting to include it in this transcript (37).

"Marriage Contract
Theodorick M. Hereford with Lucy Q. Powell

An indenture made and agreed upon between Theodorick M. Hereford of Madison County, State of Alabama of the one part and Lucy Q. Powell of the county and State aforesaid of the other part. Whereas a marriage is intended shortly to take place between Theodorick M. Hereford and Lucy Q. Powell and as it is the wish and intention of the parties that an arrangement be now made and entered into in regard to the property of each, it is therefore understood and agreed upon by said parties that the said Theodorick M. Hereford shall retain the rights and privileges as he may choose but that he is bound should his intended wife survive him to allow her out of his estate a proper and sufficient support during her widowhood. It is understood and agreed upon between the parties that the above mentioned support is in lieu of dower and is to constitute all the claims that said Lucy Q. Powell is to have against the property both real and personal of said Theodorick M. Hereford should she survive him. It is further understood and agreed upon between said parties that the said Lucy Q. Powell is to retain the exclusive right and controls of her property she has in possession or may hereafter

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ship was formed while Ann Eliza was either attending school under Dr. Price or with Mrs. Price. Ann Eliza educated her two daughters herself and they were well educated, for my grandmother, Martha Jane Hereford Geron, was called on many times to write various items for our newspaper and for other worthwhile projects and activities.

On the 3rd of January, 1866, we find Ann Eliza back in Madison County. Levin Powell, Administrator of the Estate of Dr. Hereford, had died in December of 1865, and Ann Eliza was appointed the new Administrator by the court. Bond was set at \$4,000 and William Stewart and William M. Derrick were named as bondsmen. (51-H)

In March of 1866, Ann Eliza bought two plots of land in Maysville, selling them the same day. (52-H)

The land out from Gurley that was sold to William McBroom et al at Public Auction in 1860, was again ordered sold by the Registrar in Chancery Court in 1868, because of failure to meet payments on the part of the purchaser. The land was sold at public auction from the steps of the Madison County Court House; Ann Eliza was allowed to bid, and the land was "struck off" to Mrs. Ann Eliza Hereford, Executor of the Estate of Dr. Hereford. This property was sold by the Estate in 1874 to Samuel R. Stewart. (53-H)

Martha Jane Hereford married Preston Yeatman Geron in 1872 and Preston Yeatman Geron became the guardian of Theodora Lucile Hereford. (54-H)

Theodora Lucile Hereford married Henry Sheffy Bradford in 1878.

It was not until both daughters had married that Ann Eliza again thought of herself. She married John Lawler in Madison County, May 5, 1883. Her grandchildren called her "Grandma Lawler" and some of their fondest childhood memories were the happy visits to "Grandma Lawler". (55-H)

Ann Eliza died on the 14th of June, 1902 and was buried in Maple Hill Cemetery in Huntsville, Ala. She was buried in the same lot that her two daughters were later buried in. (gravestone)

The following is her obituary from the Huntsville "Mercury"; issue of June 18, 1902 (35).
