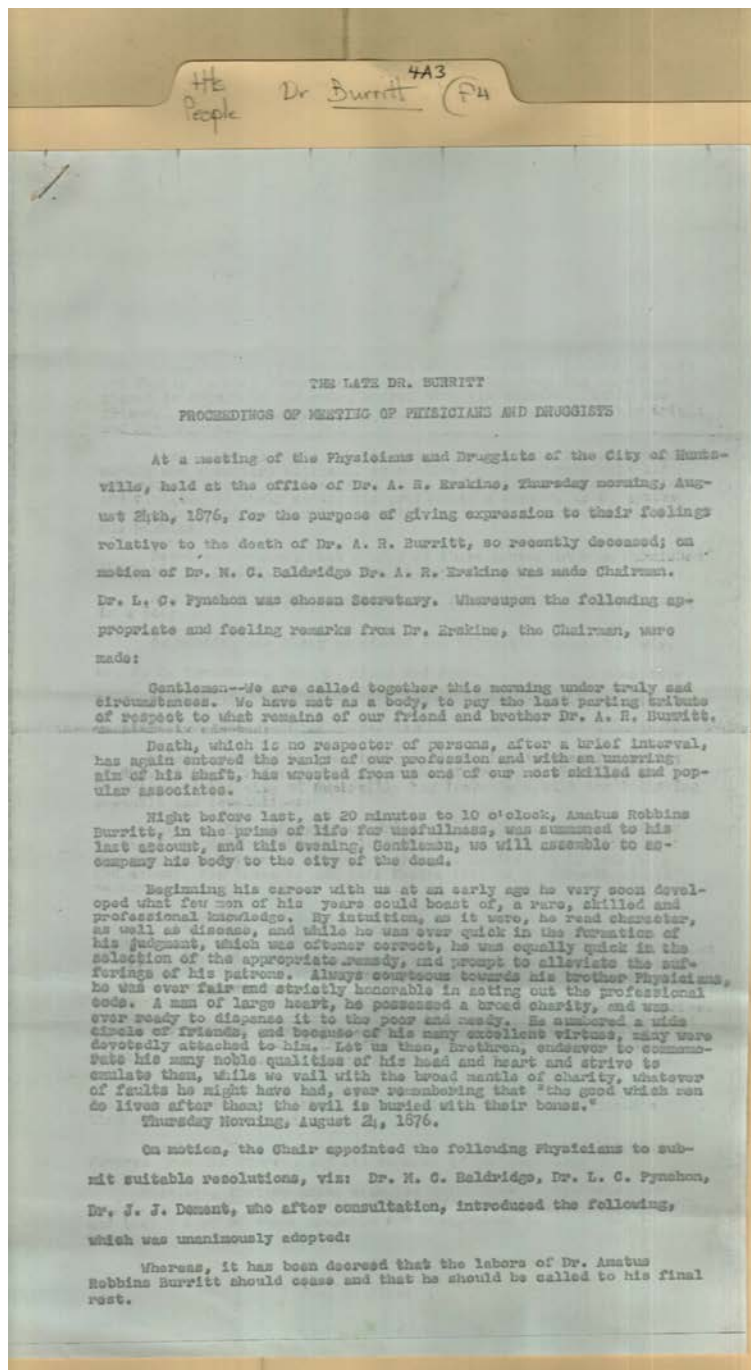

Therefore be it Resolved, That while we deeply sympathize with his family in this their sorrow we are thankful that his life was spared to return to his home, where, with his endeared family and friends, he could pass away, in the midst of the scenes of his trials and his triumphs.

Also, That in his death the community has lost one of its most worthy and exemplary citizens, ever alive to its improvements and progress; the poor a friend ever ready to alleviate their sufferings and minister to their wants; the profession a member, able, active and zealous; and his family a devoted, kind and considerate father and husband.

Resolved further, That a copy of these proceedings be furnished the bereaved family, also the city papers for publication.

Resolved, That the Physicians and Druggists attend his funeral in a body.

On motion, the Chair appointed the following Druggists, viz:
Dr. J. C. Spotswood, Jno. L. Rison and James L. Cooper, a Committee to draft suitable resolutions, who submitted the following, which was unanimously adopted:

Endorsing fully the resolutions of the Physicians of the city of Huntsville in reference to the death of Dr. A. R. Burritt, the Druggists of the city of Huntsville beg leave to submit the following preamble and resolutions:

Whereas, The sad and mournful intelligence has been announced to us of the death of Dr. A. R. Burritt, and fully participating in the deep expressions of sorrow every where manifested in this city and county, beg leave to add this feeble tribute of respect to his memory.

For twenty-two years Dr. Burritt has practiced his profession in our city, and by his skill, indomitable will and energy, over-leaped almost every barrier of prejudice, and attained high distinction in his profession. He was remarkable for his promptitude in attending to all of his duties--ever present when and where his presence was needed--in summer's heat or winter's cold--in sunshine or in storm, or in promoting the prosperity and advancement of every public enterprise. The death of such a man is indeed a public calamity, and how profound indeed must be the grief of the whole community. Pains be to his ashes, and may the God of infinite love and of all comfort give consolation to his bereaved family and friends.

Resolved, That in the death of Dr. Burritt the community has lost a meritorious Physician, and the sick, poor, and afflicted a kind and generous friend.

Resolved, That we attend with the Physicians of the city his funeral from the Church, and his remains to the cemetery.

Resolved, That we unite with the Physicians in tendering our condolence and sympathies to the family and relations of the deceased, and that a copy of these preamble and resolutions be presented to them.

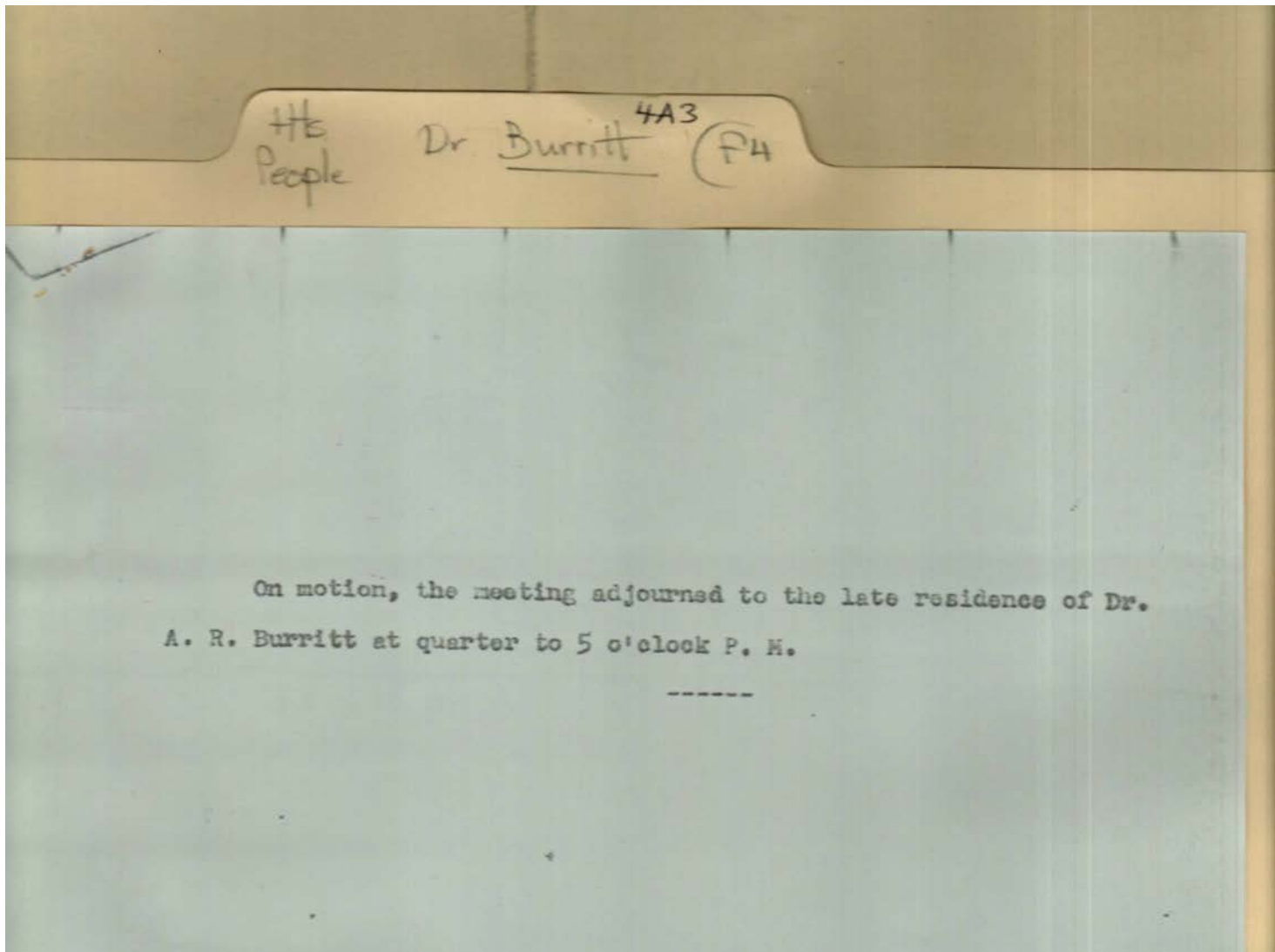

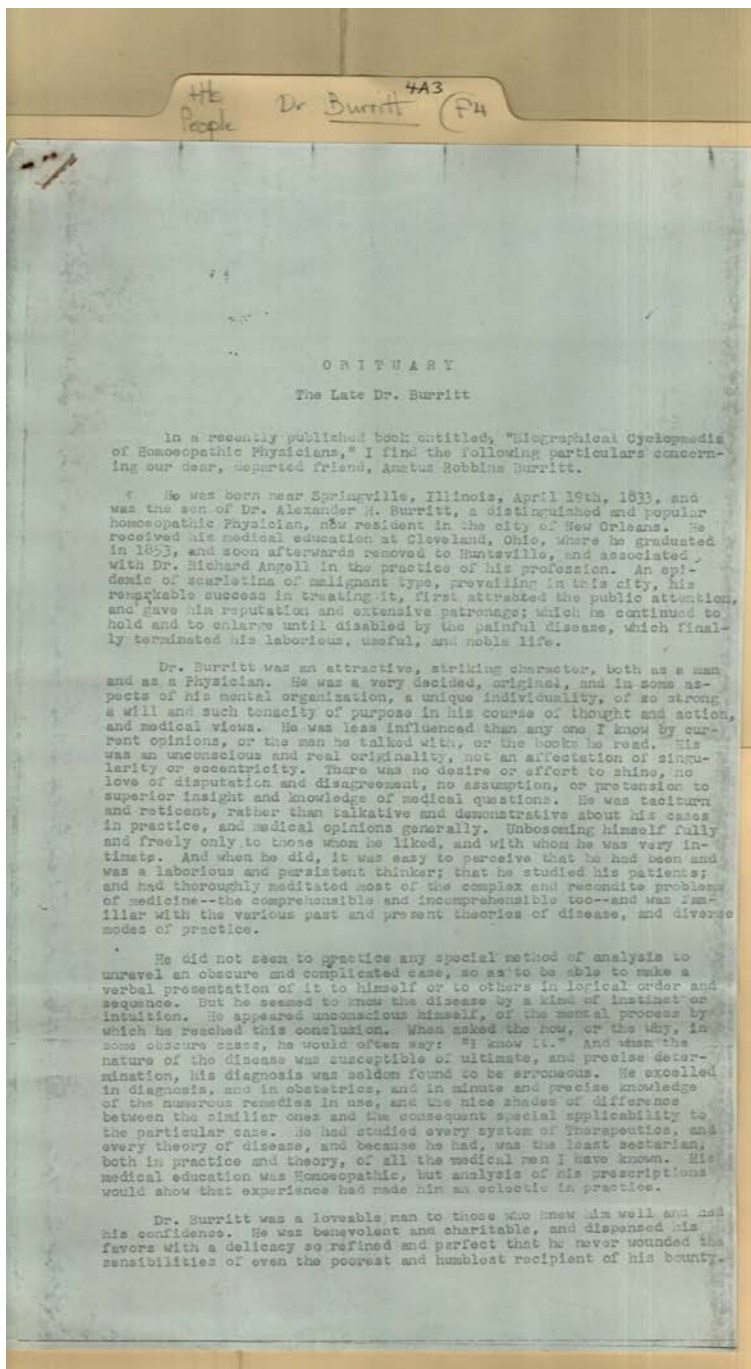

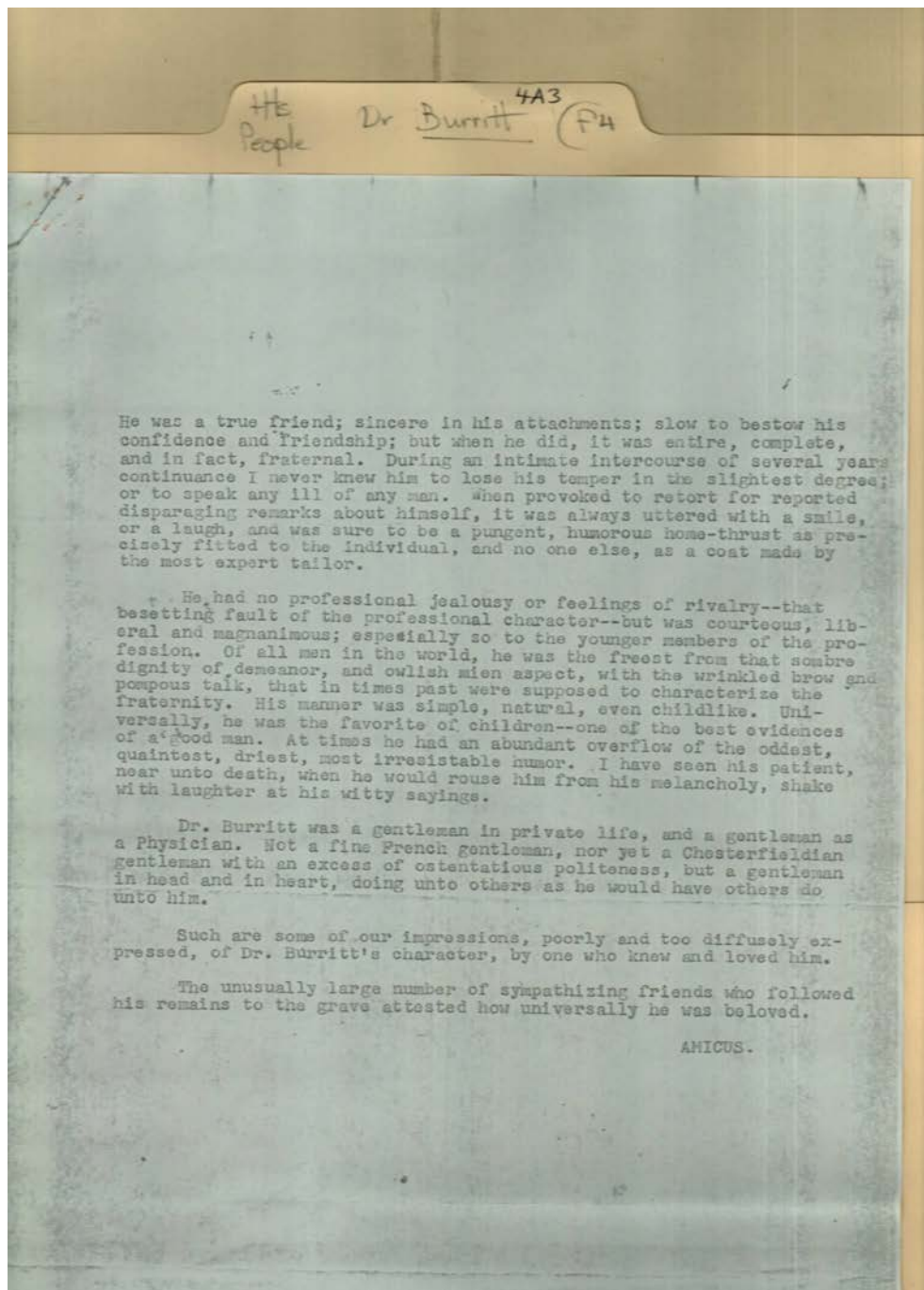
