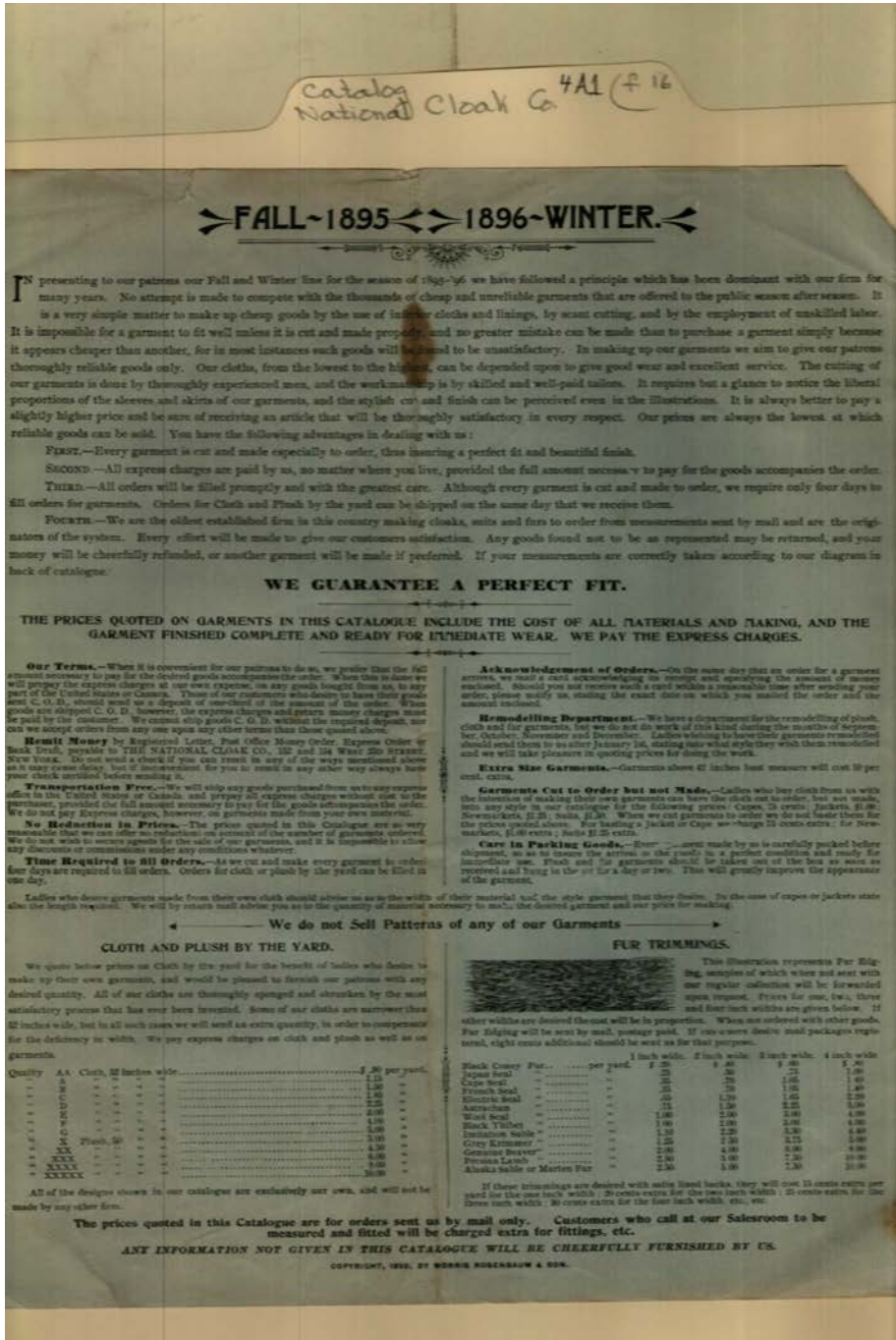

No. 803.—This illustration represents an exceedingly elegant tailor-made suit, consisting of a jacket 22 inches long in back, and a wide skirt. The jacket has a removable and throat. All edges are finished with silk and the collar is faced with velvet. The jacket closes down the front by means of a fly and buttons, and the suit is ornamented on the front of jacket and on the front of skirt with white stripes of the same cloth. The skirt is lined throughout with canvas, stiffened up back and around bottom of front with wire cloth, and finished at bottom with fine velvet binding.

No. 804.—We here picture an exclusive novelty in a tailor made suit consisting of a light fitting jacket 22 inches long and a wide skirt. The jacket is finished on all edges with four rows of silk stitching, is ornamented with two large buttons, and closes down front by means of a fly and buttons. The jacket is illustrated with a cord back, but if a ripple back is desired as shown on No. 805 or 806, it can be had without extra charge. The skirt is lined throughout with canvas, stiffened up back and around bottom of front with wire cloth, and finished at bottom with fine velvet binding.

No. 805.—A very heavy tailor made suit, consisting of a light fitting jacket 22 inches long and a wide skirt in back shown. The jacket has medium sized revers and is finished on all edges with several rows of silk stitching. It has cord back as shown in illustration, but if preferred, a ripple back is desired as shown on No. 804 or 806, it can be had without extra charge. The skirt is lined throughout with canvas, stiffened up back and around bottom of front with wire cloth, and finished at bottom with fine velvet binding.

The jacket is made double-breasted and is attached on all edges with silk. The skirt is lined throughout with cashmere, gathered up back and around bottom of front with wire cloth, and finished at bottom with fine velvet binding.

No. 807.—Both the back and front view of an attractive tailor-made suit is pictured above. This suit consists of a double-breasted, tight fitting jacket 22 inches long with a velvet collar, and a wide skirt. The skirt is lined throughout with cashmere, gathered up back and around bottom of front with wire cloth, and finished at bottom with fine velvet binding.

No. 808.—This drawing represents a very pleasing design in a tailor-made suit, consisting of a jacket 22 inches long with removable silk lined collar and a velvet collar. The jacket is single-breasted and has a loose front closed by means of a fly and buttons. 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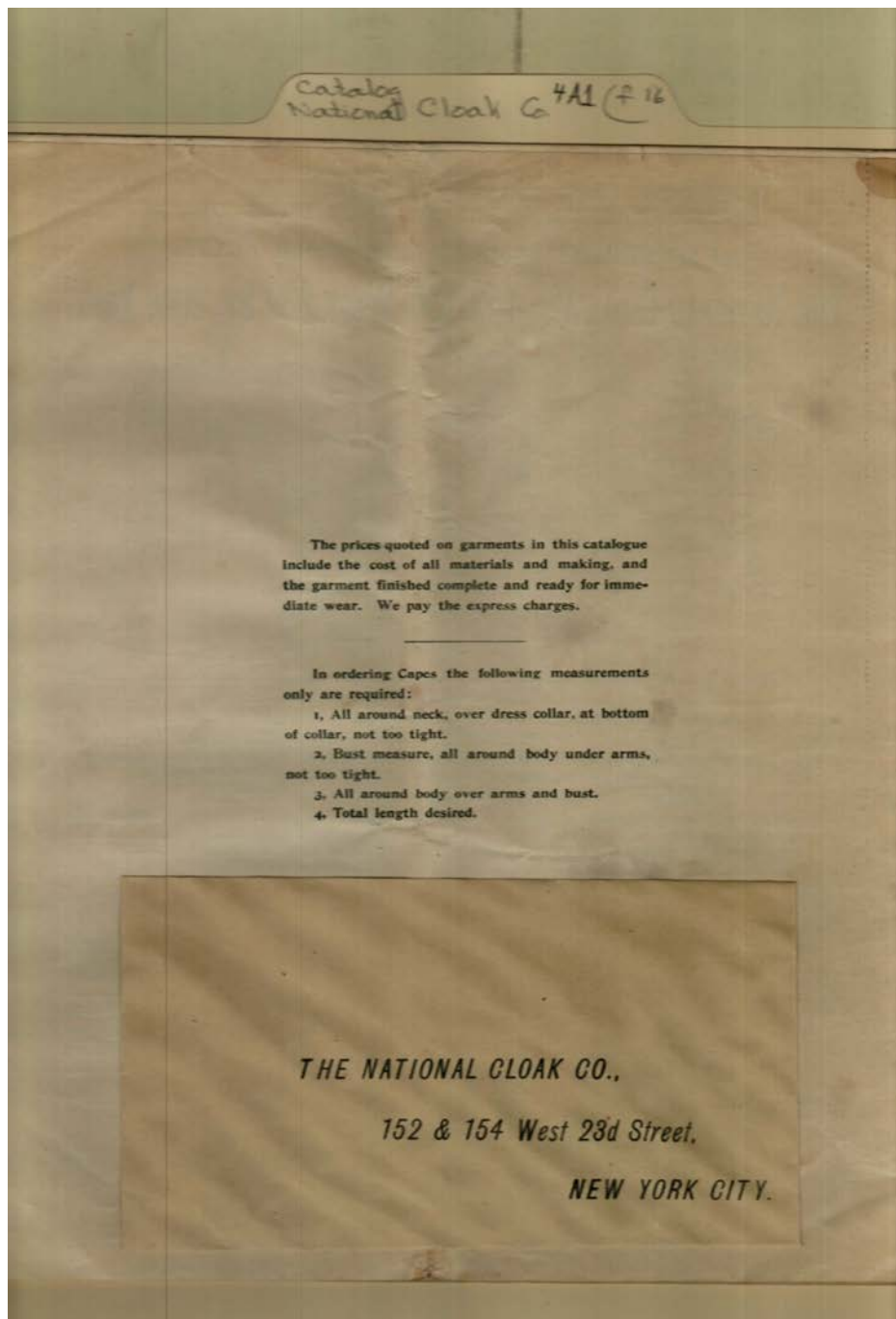
