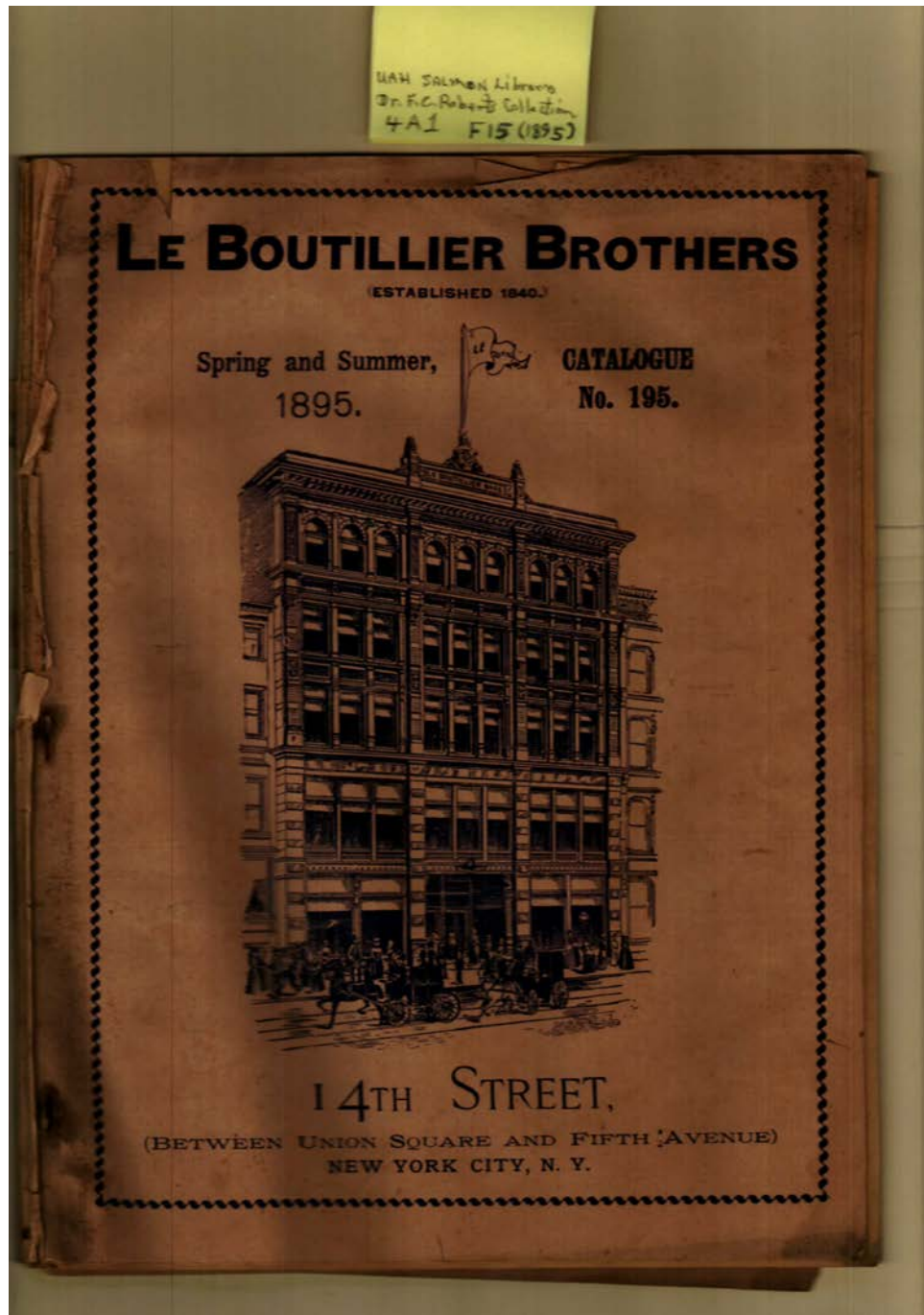

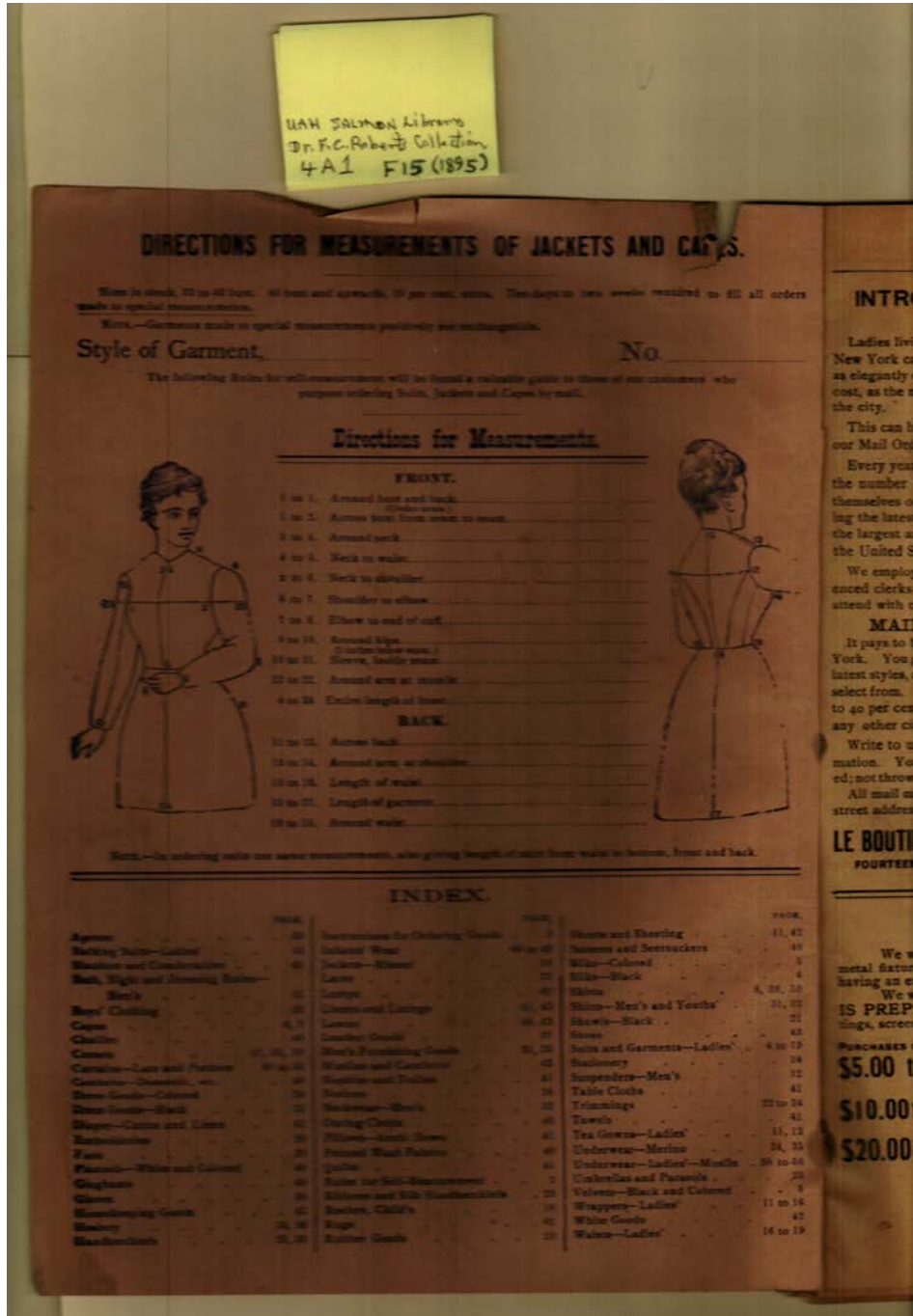

If remittances do not include amount of postage, goods will be forwarded by express. If you order goods sent by *Express*, give name of nearest office; if by *Freight*, the line.

When goods are sent by Mail, our responsibility ceases upon delivery of goods at the New York Post Office.
