Special activities, such as dances, parties and other social affairs meet the desires of older boys for association with girls.

PREVENTING DELINQUENCY

The Huntsville Boys' Club program for preventing juvenile delinquency is a positive one called "Design for Juvenile Decency" of which the "Behavior and Attitude Guidance Program" is a part. Its purpose is to develop character and good citizenship in the boys who participate in Club activities. In an atmosphere of decency the Club's leaders guide the boys toward right thinking and good behavior.

VOCATIONAL AND HOBBY SKILLS

The Boys' Club arts and crafts classes, their musical groups, their dramatics and other similar activities are designed to give boys, who are willing to use their free time for self-improvement, the opportunity to develop vocational and hobby skills. In these classes and groups boys discuss aptitudes and ambitions which often lead to choice of vocations and successful, happy lives.
