OUTLINE FOR PAGEANT DATA - CITY

PROLOGUE..... Need no data

INDIANA..... Names of tribes, wars, conflicts, where located, famous chief or leader, some incident regarding early white settler, trader, or missionary, and when Indians left territory. Dates - any outstanding event that took place regarding the Indians, rivers, creeks and any lakes.

EARLY SETTLERS..... Names, date of arrival of first settler and where settled, hardships of settlers regarding Indians or gaining territory. Nationality of settlers and if possible, what cause they had for coming to territory, where they came from.

CHURCHES..... Names of churches - when first church was organized and where. Other denominations and dates of formation - early ministers. If there was any persecution of different sects - what they were and cause.

EDUCATION..... First schools - where taught - first schoolhouse - first teacher - first advocate of education in public schools. When school laws were passed, colleges or universities located in the city - when first chartered and by whom they were founded. Early teachers of education. Relationship between religion and education.

REVOLUTION..... (If territory took part.) When and where did battles take place. Reaction of populace to oppression - heroics of people during period. Patriots - what part did people have in the forming of the government of the United States.

INDUSTRY AND INVENTION..... Any early inventories. What industry first located in town and vicinity and where. Description of early trade. Transportation. Its effect on growth of town.

NEW TOWN..... When town was chartered; boundaries marked; instigator of new town; for whom it was named; name of settlement; early officers of city.

WARS..... Effect of any wars on the community; heroes; dates of wars; etc.

WAR BETWEEN STATES..... Any data regarding this period, if war had any effect on town.

FIRST RAILROAD..... When railroad was run into town or county; builder; name of company; effect on industry, transportation and growth of town and county. Any interesting incidents regarding building of railroad.

FAMOUS PEOPLE..... Character sketches of any outstanding citizens of city or vicinity.

GAY90'S..... Early fire department - mode of living - entertainments - growth of schools, colleges and churches.

CIVIC PROGRESS..... Founding of hospitals - radio stations - industries, etc.

..... Any outstanding incidents, humorous or otherwise, that you wish incorporated into scenario. Any person's history in town or county, whether famous or not to outsiders, who has had a hand in guiding the growth of the community, writers, musicians, artists, or any person of note from town or county should have a character sketch that can be dramatized.

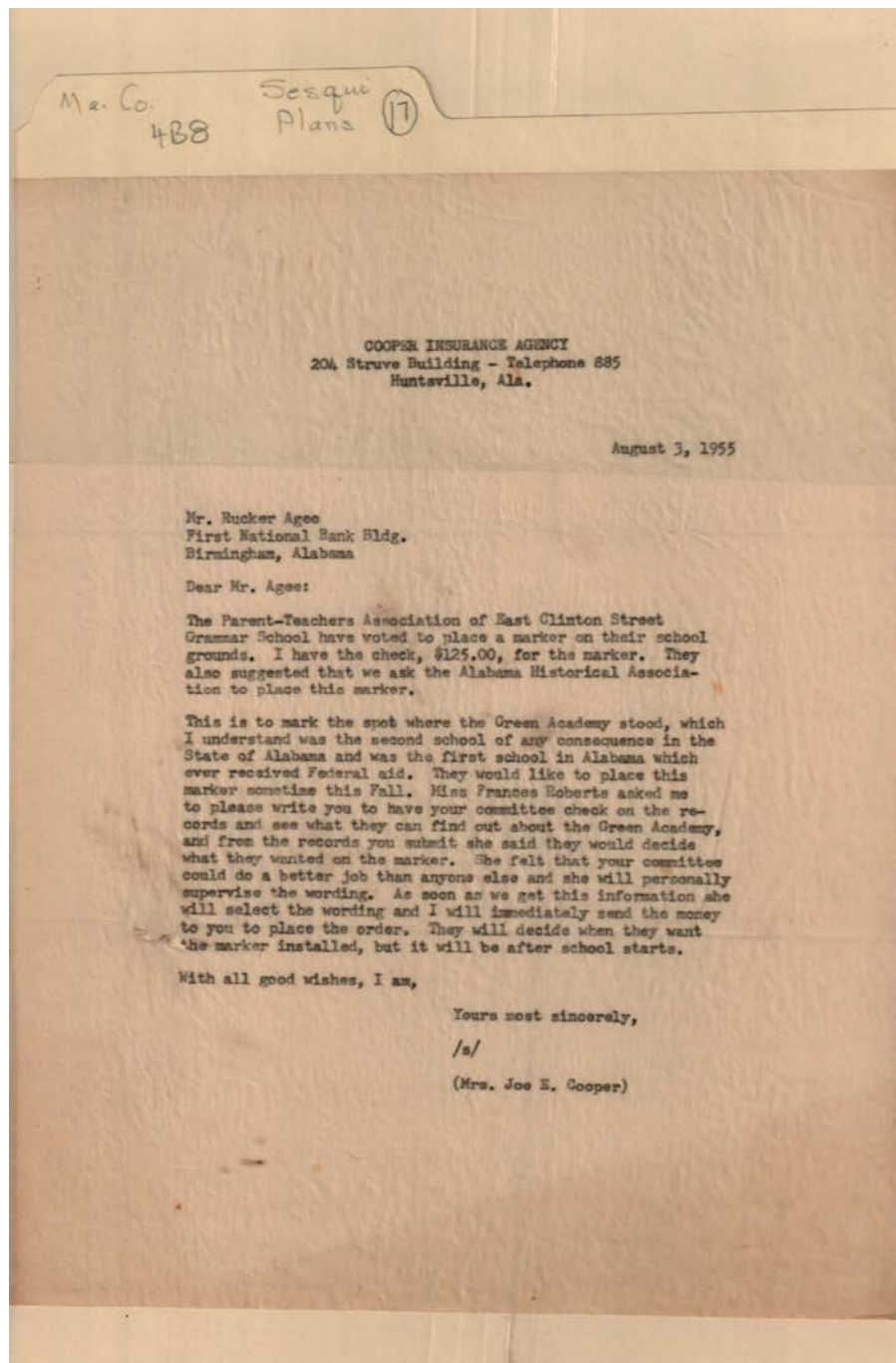
