Colleges and Schools. This goal was achieved as a result of three years of intensive work by faculty, students, and community. This consisted of a published self-study, careful evaluation, current and long range planning and beginning the implementation of these plans.

Once again there is excitement in the Community as our Trustees Blank Peoples, Homer Tate, and James Cope along with Rollin Gates, Principal, meet with the Madison County Board of Education to draw up plans for a school to house what is now referred to as the middle school. This time we are talking about a school that serves three hundred families or approximately 630 students in grades one through nine with twenty-seven teachers and several teacher aids.

Plans are being drawn up for a school that will accommodate the students and teachers comfortably as well as have adequate space so that diversified living and learning experiences may result.

The old two story building was vacated December 15th, 1972, to make way for a demolition crew to clear the site for the new school. When this building was vacated students were moved into the library, lunchroom, gymnasium, and portable classrooms to continue their studies for the remainder of the school year.

Many people were happy to learn that the bell had been removed from the tower and will be housed inside the new school.

SCHOLASTIC ACHIEVEMENTS

The scholastic record of Riverton has been good. Many of its graduates have made excellent records in college and the professional world.

In speaking contests, Riverton has been outstanding. Over a period of twenty years in which such contests were most numerous, Riverton won over one third of the first places in the County System of eight to ten high schools.

During this period, Riverton won first, six times in the County, two years it won first in the State; and one year won the International Essay Contest.

The Vocational Department won more than its share of County and State contests in speaking, music and cattle judging contests. The F.F.A. Chapter kept an active program in operation and entered many state and national sponsored contests - winning 93 county, 71 district, 63 state, 3 livestock judging awards, and 8 Gold Emblem awards.

The F.H.A. Chapter didn't sit back and let the boys win all the honors. This chapter can boast of having 11 F.H.A. queens, 4 state F.H.A. presidents, as well as many various offices in state F.H.A.

Mr. and Mrs. J. D. Wigley will long be remembered for their work in this area.

Athletics has also brought Riverton its share of honors. They have had several basketball and football championships, but better than winning scores, they have always shown sportsmanship of the highest quality.

Many students as well as proud parents, will remember the football teams that won thirty-one straight games. The Wolves coached by Glen Watson and Richard Spencer launched this winning streak in 1968. They were undefeated and won the County title three years running — 1969, 70 and 71, led by Coach Spencer.

This was some record for an effort that had started back in 1966 when the Booster Club raised one thousand, seven hundred and fifty-five dollars and forty-two cents to buy uniforms and equipment to start a football program at Riverton. Richard Spencer, with the help of Steve Murray, began the program with many boys who had never played football before.

One interesting fact that might be added along with this list of teachers is that during the depression when the money allotted by the State Board of Education ran out, every teacher and principal taught 3½ months for twenty dollars per month. The teachers did this in order for the students to complete their work and not have to repeat their grade. The last year of the depression they taught this 3½ months for nothing because the banks went broke and they had to take script for which they did not receive money for a long time.
