The Trustees were as follows: M. P. Roberts, M. D. Hambrick, W. F. Whitman, S. G. Berry and J. T. Jones.

The Baptist Church was used as school building after the Civil War. Then the next school building was erected a little South of where the Payne home now stands. Some of the teachers were Messrs. Sneed, Flannigan, Gabbard, Gregory, Goodrich, Handley, Terrill and others.

Even though New Market has never had more than five or six hundred inhabitants, it has for many years supported three churches. The Baptists building is one of the oldest in the county. On the lot where the Presbyterian Church now stands there have been three churches. The first was built before the war and burned down. The next was a three story brick building owned by the Methodists and Cumberland Presbyterians. The Masons and Sons of Temperance bought a half interest in this building and used the third story. In 1883 the Methodists sold their interest to the Presbyterians. In 1885 this building was completely demolished by a cyclone.

END OF HISTORY BY DR. NORRIS AND DR. RICE

ADDITION TO THE HISTORY OF NEW MARKET BY MEMBERS OF THE NEW MARKET PRESBYTERIANS

It is the desire of a committee of members of the New Market Presbyterian Church U. S. A. to add to the history of New Market as compiled by Dr. George D. Norris and Dr. Francisco Rice.

Much information has been given by persons who lived then and are still living at this writing in April 1953. Among them are Mrs. Alice Cochran Gorman, J. W. Cochran, M. M. Cochran, Mrs. Mary Lipscomb Stone, E. L. Hereford, and A. C. Hambrick.

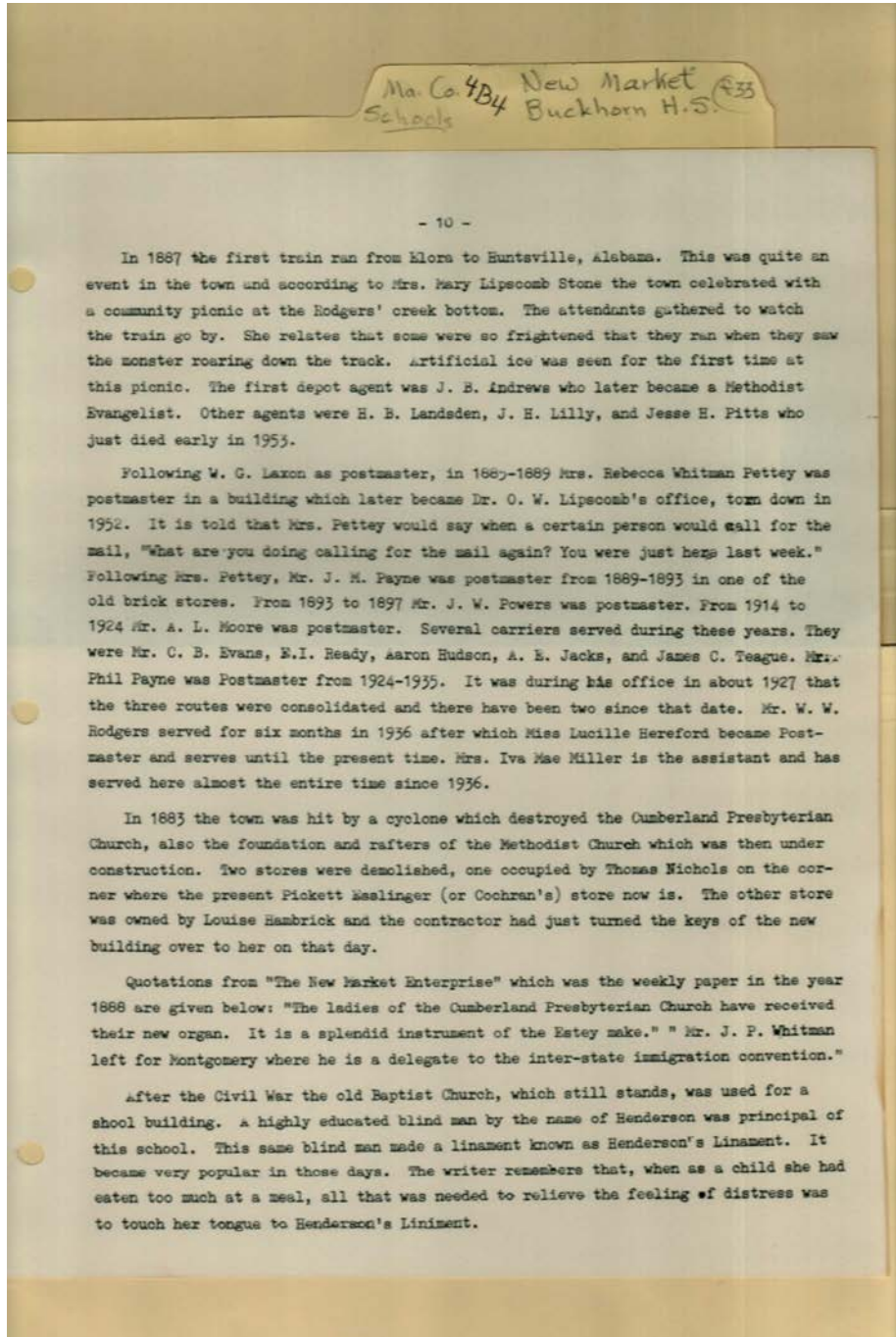
The part of the town described in Dr. Norris' history which comprised only a few stores was destroyed by fire. Mr. John W. Cochran, Sr. was the first to rebuild. He built a brick store which still stands along with two other brick stores which were built several years after Mr. Cochran's. These buildings are now dilapidated and one is used for a garage, the others not used. About 15 years later several stores were built and they existed until about 1925 or 1926. These stores were later to be referred to as "Old Town" when new stores were built in a different part of town.

The gun being deposited, as usual, in the store, Childress drew the shot, and Peter S. Baker cut off about two inches of Lewis's dog's tail, rammed it down the gun, and when Lewis fired the gun, Childress' hat, a new beaver, was smashed into smithereens. Lewis won the bet, but lost his dog's tail. This dog was a valuable squirrel and possum dog, and naturally fired up Lewis, who was for a time very bellicose.

The merchants went every fall to Baltimore on horse-back, purchased their winter, spring and fall goods, which were freighted by large wagons with six horses from Baltimore to New Market, in their purchase the merchants gave notes for twelve months, with interest on six months, and paid up in full when they purchased another stock. Sugar, coffee, dry goods, hardware, were all hauled in wagons from Baltimore.

Sugar sold for 12½ cts. per lb., coffee 25 cts., calico for 25 cts. etc.

Whiskey made in the neighborhood sold for 25 cts. per gal., corn 10 cts. per bushel, wheat 25 cts. per bushel and Irish potatoes and sweet potatoes were given away.

The country was full of game- bears, deer, turkeys were plentiful, and the woods were full of squirrels, opossums and raccoons, besides wolves, wild cats and panthers. The waters teemed with black bass, red-eye perch, also called goggle-eye, suckers and turtles, and other edible fish.

Just two miles, in a north-west direction from New Market, a village was established called Hillsboro, containing a few houses and two stores. One was kept by aquire John Angel, who was a merchant and justice of the peace. It is still marked on the old maps.

THE BEGINNING OF A NEW ERA IN AN OLD SETTLEMENT 6
to Joseph Rice.²⁷ Joseph Rice, great grandfather of Mr. Lee Rice, owned the land for just one year, for in the 1841 he deeded it to Jacob H. Pierce.²⁸ Mr. Pierce was in possession of the tract from 1841-1844, when he deed it to Benjamin Jolly.²⁹

Benjamin Jolly didn't even keep the land a year. In 1844 Jolly deeded it to John Hathcock, Junior.³⁰ Notice the John Heathcock, Senior and John Hathcock, Junior were probably father and son. The spelling of Heathcock changed.

John, Junior owned the land until his death, August 10, 1867. In his last Will and Testament, Hathcock gave Francisco Rice, son of Joseph, authority to see the Hathcock land if necessary to meet debts incurred by Mr. Hathcock.³¹

Now did the land shirk its duty during the Civil War. While still owned by Mr. Hathcock, the land served the Confederate troops for a night in the 1860's. At the time during the Civil War, Confederate General Roddy crossed the Tennessee River at a point in Marshall County. He led his troops into Madison County with Yankee troops in pursuit of him. General Roddy made camp on the Buckhorn School site. Later, some
