INTRODUCTION

In the year of 1978 I became interested in genealogy, (tracing family roots) and my work in this field eventually led to the compilation of this book. As my research in genealogy led me to many cemeteries in the areas of this county where my ancestors were buried I began to see their importance as a link to the past. As I uncovered more names connected to my family line I found myself going back to the same cemeteries several times to copy names and dates from stones. These frequent trips were becoming a problem because of the expense and the time required to make them. I soon decided to copy all the names and dates from each stone in a cemetery which I had to visit. What started out as a hobby soon developed into a full time project. I realized that other people who were tracing their family roots were also having the same problems that I was in trying to obtain names and dates from different cemeteries. I soon realized that a complete catalogue of the cemeteries in this county would be of great historical importance.

Most people fail to recognize the magnitude of the task which I undertook. At times, they even ridiculed my efforts to complete such a work. The job of cataloging the cemeteries of this county was so enormous that at times I thought it would be impossible for me to complete what I had started. Hundreds of miles were traveled back and forth across this county to its many cemeteries, and hundreds of hours were spent copying the names and dates from the tombstones. I did my best going from row to row, stone to stone, collecting the information. Many times information could not be obtained because the stone had been placed

on soft ground and had sunk. Frequently nothing was available except a name or a part of a date.

Many times the tombstones of family members, such as man and wife may not be found side by side in the book, even though they were buried side by side in the cemetery. At times the cemeteries were not laid off in neat straight rows and I would find myself zigzagging through the stones. I realize that there will be criticism and many mistakes will be found, but try to remember that I am only human and that man's work is not perfect. Any mistakes that were made, were unintentional, and I apologize for any disappointment to those who read the pages of this book.

Often the elements were against me and I wondered why I was doing such a thing. I spent many hours in the cemeteries during the winter months, when it was so cold that the ink would not flow from the ballpoint pen I used. I would carry several pens in my pocket to use when the one I was writing with would freeze up. During the summer months, some days the temperature would reach 100 degrees or more and the sweat, dripping from my brow, would smear the ink on my paper. The unexpected thunderstorms and summer showers also gave me many problems to deal with.

Sometimes as I was trying to obtain a name for a given cemetery, I found that some cemeteries may have been known by as many as three names. The names of cemeteries usually coincided with the groups of families who were interred there or the location of the cemetery. Names to be placed on each burial site were usually obtained from persons living nearby or from obituaries and funeral home records. When more than one name ap-

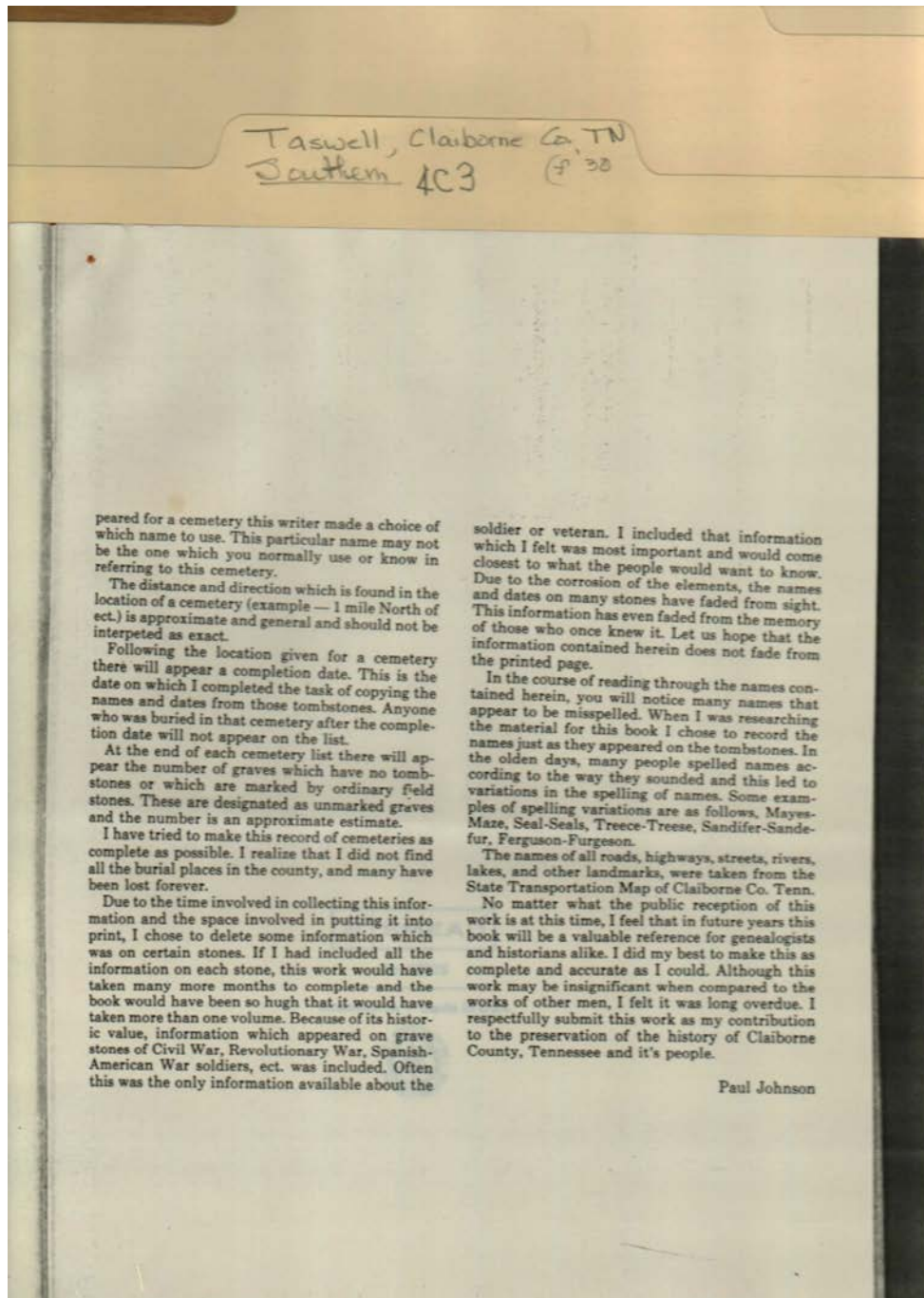

peared for a cemetery this writer made a choice of which name to use. This particular name may not be the one which you normally use or know in referring to this cemetery.

The distance and direction which is found in the location of a cemetery (example — 1 mile North of ect.) is approximate and general and should not be interpreted as exact.

Following the location given for a cemetery there will appear a completion date. This is the date on which I completed the task of copying the names and dates from those tombstones. Anyone who was buried in that cemetery after the completion date will not appear on the list.

At the end of each cemetery list there will appear the number of graves which have no tombstones or which are marked by ordinary field stones. These are designated as unmarked graves and the number is an approximate estimate.

I have tried to make this record of cemeteries as complete as possible. I realize that I did not find all the burial places in the county, and many have been lost forever.

Due to the time involved in collecting this information and the space involved in putting it into print, I chose to delete some information which was on certain stones. If I had included all the information on each stone, this work would have taken many more months to complete and the book would have been so hugh that it would have taken more than one volume. Because of its historic value, information which appeared on grave stones of Civil War, Revolutionary War, Spanish-American War soldiers, ect. was included. Often this was the only information available about the

soldier or veteran. I included that information which I felt was most important and would come closest to what the people would want to know. Due to the corrosion of the elements, the names and dates on many stones have faded from sight. This information has even faded from the memory of those who once knew it. Let us hope that the information contained herein does not fade from the printed page.

In the course of reading through the names contained herein, you will notice many names that appear to be misspelled. When I was researching the material for this book I chose to record the names just as they appeared on the tombstones. In the olden days, many people spelled names according to the way they sounded and this led to variations in the spelling of names. Some examples of spelling variations are as follows, Mayes-Maze, Seal-Seals, Treece-Treese, Sandifer-Sandefur, Ferguson-Furgeson.

The names of all roads, highways, streets, rivers, lakes, and other landmarks, were taken from the State Transportation Map of Claiborne Co. Tenn.

No matter what the public reception of this work is at this time, I feel that in future years this book will be a valuable reference for genealogists and historians alike. I did my best to make this as complete and accurate as I could. Although this work may be insignificant when compared to the works of other men, I felt it was long overdue. I respectfully submit this work as my contribution to the preservation of the history of Claiborne County, Tennessee and it's people.
