Natchez Tract

I was duly favoured with yours of 9th instant and was preparing to go to the Chickasaw nation when George Colbert and another Chief came to this place on private business. I had, by riding out with them one day, two days conference mostly on the subject of the purchase and sale of their lands on the north side of the Tennessee river, and I go so much encouragement of success that I will pledge myself that there will be no difficulty in gaining all their clame north of the river Tennessee as high as the mouth of Duck river and all north of Duck river and the south branches of Duck as fare as the present road leading from this place to Natchez. This he says will carey us within 20 miles of his ferry.

There is two small rivers that falls into Duck on the south side below the rode swan until about 30 miles above the mouth of Duck which the road heads. And Bullelan[Buffalo?] emties very near the mouth of Duck, much larger than the other. The road crosses several forks of that river, And I suppose it must be near 40 miles from the road to the mouth. I likewise suppose it is 50 miles with the road from Duck to the southward branches of Buffalo.

Colbert and the other Chief asked me what I thought the commisioners would give them for that bounds. I told them I would form no judgment, onley as my own opinion; that I know the Commissioners did not fail in their conferrances with the Cherokees to inform them that the Chickasaws stood amongst the most favourite nation of red people with the United States. And that I thought they might get for the land mentioned, \$10,000 and \$2000 annually which was more like renting land than seling.

I am apprehensive that their claim on the north of the Tennessee River may be got for about \$12,500 and \$2500 annually. This I did not think prudent to mention But said that I knew the Commissioners wished to get the Chickesaw claim on the north side of Tennessee river to prevent any dispute or discord between the two [Indian] nations.

They want the treaty to be early if Provisions could be sent down Tennessee river in March or April They think the treaty needs not be very expensive; that one of the commisioners might go into the Nation and give notice of the time and have men appointed and authorised to meat the commisioners at Colberts ferry; & there make the contract. As they will expect money to pay their debts the Marchant of Mobeal have recommended to them to sell lands as they have in a measure refused to credit those traders, the traders not being able to make remittance for the goods already had by falure of recovering their debts.

So you will discover this to be a favourable time for a treaty with Chickasaws. The Merchants recommended lands about the Chicksaw bluffs to be sold but the Chicksaws are greatly opposed to selling lands as yet on the south side of Tennessee river. If the purchase could be made at [from] the Chicksaws it will give us about 100 miles of the north bank of Tennessee river. I informed Major Colbert and the other Chickesaw chief that I was no further authorised to speak to them on the sale of lands than requested by yourself

I have lost two horses supposed to be Stolen by either Creeks or Cherokees. They were taken in July last with one belonging to Colonel Thompson, my neighbor, which made his escape the same night & returned home with a Rope around his neck.

I have, by recommendation, thought proper [to notify] you with a hope they may be discovered in the nation of which you have the superintendency.

I will thank you must kindly to make the necessary enquiries respecting them of the Indian Chiefs &c—and do me the honor of writing to me. Directed to the Post Office in Nashville & you will Oblige.

N. B.

One black horse, 15 hands high, 15 years Old, natural pacer, one hind foot white, a Small Star in his forehead, branded on the near Shoulder WL, had been hurt on his back with a pack saddle.

A Sorrel Horse 14 hands 3 Inches high, 2 white feet, a small star in his forehead—was branded lightly "L,ell," on his near shoulder, 9 years old, trots very short. Each had a Bell on. By placing your hand on his Back he will Tremble.

South West Point, 28 Dec. 1802

Sir:

The above is a copy of a letter from Mr. Lytle which he wished me to communicate to you.

I embrace this opportunity to ask your opinion on the last clause of the 9th Article of the treaty at Tellico in 1798 with respect to the oblivion of Aggressions on each side before that time—in settling the claims for Stolen horses &c on both sides.

I have always called to my assistance several respectable citizens & when the claims were damages received previous to the date of that treaty we have considered the claimant on both sides barred by that article—and as there will probably be other claims of that description brought forward, I wish to be more fully satisfied whether any latitude can be admitted in a retrospective sense & if any, how far.

In July last, there was a Cherokee Indian killed by a white man at Wares Cove. I fully believe that there was no malicious or ill will in either of the parties except what appeared for the moment as the parties were both Intoxicated &, as I am informed, in that situation quarreled. However, this did not prevent some bad Indians from seeking what they call Satisfaction & they killed a young man, a son to the white man who killed the Indian.

On the 8th of September last, I was then and for sometime after, absent from this place on a survey of the line between the Cherokee & North Carolina. I have made a demand of the murderers and the Chiefs have agreed to deliver them up. It is not yet done—their reluctance to do this, if they have any, arises from the number of their people that have been killed by the whites & for which no punishment has ever taken place. This is an unhappiness that you are sensible we labor under in every instance. Agriculture & manufactures, and with them civilization, progress as fast as can be ex-
