INTRODUCTION

This booklet is a reproduction, with the permission of Dr. Peter A. Brannon, Director of the State Department of Archives and History, Montgomery, Alabama, from the Spring Issue, 1961 (Vol. 23 No. 1 and 2), of the *Alabama Historical Quarterly* which is published by the State Department of Archives and History.

The map in this article, on which military incidents are located within their present-day county boundaries, and the printed material accompanying it are exceedingly important to all those who would understand the clash of arms in the state during the Civil War.

A great variety of military events in the state are classified in accordance with the *Army Regulations and Rules of War of the Confederacy*. Each event is listed according to its classification in a tabulation showing the place and county in which it occurred together with the date. A *chronology* of events in each county can be easily established from these tabulations.

The map in this booklet can profitably be studied along with the *Civil War Centennial Map*, published in January, 1961, by the Alabama Highway Department. The latter map, which contains various kinds of instructive information, delineates the course of each military raid in the state during the war. It was constructed out of information furnished by the State Department of Archives and History and was endorsed by the Alabama Civil War Centennial Commission.

This article and the two maps provide a priceless overview of military actions in Alabama during the Civil War. Not only can more than 300 military events, including Naval operations, now be identified and located, but they can be related in a meaningful way to Federal raids or campaigns in the state.
