



(TE INFO INTERCOM CEMEA - ANOTHER FIRST FOR ALABAMA The Alabama Center for Higher Education, a consortium of eight predominently Black colleges in Alabama and the Alabama A. & M. College are sponsoring a Conference for the Evaluation of Materials about Black Americans, April 20 -25, 1969, on the A. & M. campus. General sessions will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Monday through Wednesday in Bibb Graves Auditorium. Members of the faculty and staff are urged to attend and hear outstanding consultants in the fields of Children's Literature, History and the Humanities. Monday's speaker will be Mrs. Dharathula Millender, author, lecturer and librarian in the Cary, Indiana, school system. She will talk about children's literature. On <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>Lerone Bennett</u>, senior editor of EHONY Magazine and presently on the

faculty of Northwestern University, will be the featured speaker. And on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>Seunders Redding</u>, the eminent literary critic, historian and Professor of Creative Writing at Hampton Institute, will lecture. Mr. Redding is currently a special consultant to the Chairman, National Endowment to the Humanities.

The goals of the Conference are: to provide direction to the ACHE colleges as to how they might best proceed in helping responsible agencies and individuals to achieve integration in the textbooks which are used in the public mchools; to consider the matter of providing suggestions for substitution of present texts for texts that more nearly "tell it like it is" with regard to the Black minority; to consider the matter of providing supplementary units for use in selected classes; and to make suggestions to publishers, writers and others as to some specific ways in which they might amend their present materials to include realistically the Black Man's contribution.






