In 1864, President Pollard reported a net income of \$353,282.57. The Board declared a dividend of ten per cent, payable on September 15, 1864, and of twenty per cent, payable on the first day of March. The last had to be provided for in part from the "Reserved Fund" of past years. The Board was influenced in making the last dividend so large, in order to enable the stockholders to pay taxes on their stock. They had tax problems in those days too, and in connection with the tax, the Board had this to say:
